#### ORDER:

In pursuance of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 12-8-2005 in Appeal (civil) No. 5041 of 2005 filed by P.A. Inamdar Vs. State of Maharashtra (AIR 2005 SC 3226), the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, dated 09.05.2017 in Dar-us-Salam Educational Trust and Ors (Writ Petition(s) (Civil) No(s) 267/2017) and also discussions held with the Private Unaided Non-Minority Medical / Dental Colleges in the State for the Under Graduate Courses i.e., MBBS and BDS, a consensual arrangement has been arrived in adopting the admission policy and seat matrix for the competent authority seats/ National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) based Management seats / NRI/ NRI sponsored seats in Unaided Non-Minority Medical / Dental Colleges in the State.

- 2. Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 3 and 15 of the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (A.P. Act No. 5 of 1983) and in partial modification of the Andhra Pradesh Un-aided Non-Minority Professional Institutions (Regulations of Admissions into Under Graduate Medical and Dental Professional Courses) Rules 2007, issued in G.O.Ms.No.136, HM&FW (E1) Department, dated: 30.04.2007, as subsequently amended vide G.O.s 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> read above, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendments to the Rules for admission into the Under Graduate Professional Courses in Medical and Dental in Un-aided Non-Minority Professional Institutions in the State:-
- 3. The Government after careful examination have decided to amend the Andhra Pradesh Un-aided Non-Minority Professional Institutions (Regulations of Admissions into Under Graduate Medical and Dental Professional Courses) Rules 2007 issued in G.O.Ms.No.136, HM&FW(E1) Department, Dated: 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2007, and as amended subsequently.
- 4. Accordingly, the following notification shall be published in the Extraordinary issue of the Andhra Pradesh Gazette, Dated:27.07.2017:-

#### **NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 3 and 15 of the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (A.P. Act No. 5 of 1983) the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendments to the Andhra Pradesh Unaided Non-Minority Professional Institutions (Regulations of Admissions into Under Graduate Medical and Dental Professional Courses) Rules, 2007 issued in G.O.Ms.No.136, HM&FW.(E1) Department, Dated: 30 April, 2007 and published in the Rules supplement to Part-I, A.P. Gazette No. 30, dated the 2, May 2007.

## AMENDMENTS

In the said rules,

- 1. In rule 1 (II), the word "EAMCET" shall be substituted with "National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET)-UG".
- 2. In rule 2 (1) (iv), the words "EAMCET and Common Entrance Test-Association of colleges (CET-AC)" shall be substituted with "National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET)-UG".
- 3. In rule 2 (1) (vi), the word "EAMCET" shall be substituted with "NEET-UG".
- 4. In rule 2, sub clause (xiii) under clause (1) the following shall be substituted:-
  - "Qualified Candidates" in respect of Management Seats shall be the candidate who has appeared for the NEET-UG examination for admission into the Under Graduate Courses and secured cut off percentile prescribed for that category.
- **5.** In clause (b) of rule 3, the words "filled by the Management" shall be deleted.
- 6. For Rule 6 (A), the following shall be substituted :-
  - (A) To fill up Competent Authority Seats:

Category - A seats (50% of the sanctioned intake of the seats)

- (i) Committee for admissions shall be constituted by the Competent Authority under these rules.
- (ii) The Competent Authority shall issue a notification for calling of a single application form in the prescribed form from the eligible qualified candidates who have secured minimum percentile prescribed for that category in the NEET-UG, seeking admission in Government Professional Colleges and Private Un-aided Non-Minority Professional Colleges in respect of seats to be filled by the Competent Authority.
- (iii) The candidates who are qualified securing minimum percentile prescribed in the Common Entrance Test and desires of seeking admission into Private Un-aided Non-Minority Colleges shall make application to the Competent Authority in response to their notification.
- (iv) The candidates have to get their certificates verified as per schedule notified by the Committee for Admissions.

- (v) The merit order will be displayed by Competent Authority after verification of all original certificates.
- (vi) The selection of candidates and allotment of course / institution in respect of the seats shall be solely on the basis of merit as adjudged in the Entrance Test subject to the condition that the candidate should have passed the qualifying examination with the minimum marks prescribed.
- (vii) Mere appearance at the Entrance Test and obtaining high rank in the merit list does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission automatically into any course / institution unless he/she also satisfies the rules and regulations of admission prescribed by the concerned University / Government including marks to be obtained in the qualifying examination etc.
- (viii) The Committee of admissions shall select and allot candidates into various courses as per merit.
- (ix) Selections will be made through Web Options and allotments are also will be made by the Committee for Admissions appointed by the Competent Authority Selections are Course wise.
  - Allotments will be made in the Merit order.
  - Allotment made in the web counseling is final and cannot be altered under any circumstances.
- (x) Reservations shall also be University Area Wise. While allotting the candidates to the colleges, the percentage of reservations shall be maintained in each institution as far as possible.
- (xi) The 15% of unreserved Seats will be filled First, then the 85% of the local seats will be filled as per the G.O.Ms. No. 42, Higher Education (EC2) Dept., dated 18.05.2009.

If a candidate is eligible for a same type of seat in the same course and in same college both under the reserved categories of social status and under Army / NCC / PH / Sports & Games, he / she will be selected under the category of social status only. The candidates provisionally selected into one college will be considered for resultant vacancies in another college only. The allotment of college to the NCC and Sports & Games candidates shall be by rotation.

- (xii) Request for a change to any other category after display of final merit list shall not be considered.
- (xiii) The Committee for Admissions shall have the power to cancel the selection or admission of the candidates at any stage if it is detected either during selection or before closure of admissions that the selection or admission is against the regulation.
- (xiv) The Competent Authority / Committee for admissions shall prepare the final list of candidates, admitted course wise and to send the same to the University.

- The Competent Authority in consultation with Committee (xy)for admission shall fix the cut off dates for each stage of admission contemplated above.
- 7. In Rule 9, the (\*) Note: after sub sub rule (iii) of sub rule 3 (a) of G.O.Ms.No.136, HM&FW(E1) Department, Dated:30-4-2007, the following shall be substituted:

"(\*) Note: 3% Reservations to Physically challenged candidates: The reservations to Physically Challenged Candidates shall be implemented in each category on the total number of seats for that category in MBBS and BDS Courses separately.

> Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences shall constitute a Medical board comprising of Professors of Orthopedics and General Medicine Departments from Government Medical Colleges including SVIMS. The candidate should appear before the board constituted for assessment of percentage of disability as per the norms of the Government. The decision of the Medical board constituted by the University is final in all respects. The University will notify the list of eligible candidates on the website for exercising options. The candidate should fulfill the eligibility criteria as per Medical Council of India norms as follows:

> Reservation to Physically challenged candidates is applicable to locomotor disorders of lower limbs with disability between 50% to 70% as category-I and between 40% to 50% as category-II."
