#### PROSPECTUS/REGULATIONS FOR ADMISSION INTO BHMS & BAMS COURSES UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA FOR THE YEAR 2024-25.

#### 1. REGULATIONS:

- i) The following are the Regulations for admission of students into BHMS & BAMS Courses under Management Quota in Private Un Aided Non Minority Colleges in Andhra Pradesh for the year 2024-25.
- ii) The candidates shall appear and secure Rank in the NEET UG 2024 exam.
- iii) The Rank in NEET UG 2024 shall be the basis for the selection into BAMS & BHMS Courses subject to these regulations.
- iv) The admissions into the colleges are subject to the permission by the Government of India and affiliation to the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences for the academic year 2024-25.

#### 2. Eligibility:

THE CANDIDATES WHO SECURED THE CUT OFF MARKS AND MORE IN THE NEET UG - 2024 CONDUCTED BY NATIONAL TESTING AGENCY AND FULFILL THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA ARE ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION INTO **BAMS & BHMS** COURSES. THEY HAVE TO SUBMIT THEIR ONLINE APPLICATION BY PAYING THE NON-REFUNDABLE APPLICATION AND PROCESSING FEE THROUGH ONLINE AND UPLOAD THE SCANED CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR **MANAGEMENT** QUOTA SEATS.

#### Minimum cutoff score in NEET UG - 2024.

**3.** <u>Candidates who got registered as Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)/Overseas</u> <u>Citizen of India (OCI) Cardholders on or after 04.03.2021 are eligible for</u> <u>admission only against any Non-Resident Indian seat or any supernumerary</u> <u>seat; and shall not be eligible for admission against any seat reserved</u> <u>exclusively for Indian Citizens.</u>

#### a) Minimum Age and other conditions: -

- a) Candidates should have completed the age of 17 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2024.
- b) Candidates who do not complete 17 years as on 31.12.2024 are not eligible.
- c) Age shall be calculated on the basis of date of birth as Indicated in the Board of Secondary School Certificate Examination (SSC) or Equivalent Examination.
- d) There is No upper age limit.
- e) English is compulsory subject.
- f) Students shall be admitted once in a year.
- g) Students shall be medically fit.

#### **b) EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:**

Passing marks for eligibility in admission to ASU&H-UG courses should be as per the ASU&H-UG regulations and should be followed strictly. The details of qualifications for different categories are as follows:

- a) <u>For Ayurveda BAMS:</u> Candidate must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the 10+2 or equivalent examination in the case of General category and 40% Marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes.
- b) For Homeopathy BHMS: Candidate must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology at the 10+2 or equivalent examination in the case of general category and 40% Marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes.
- c) In respect of persons with disability candidate specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination are as follows: a) In Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be 45% in the case of General Category. b) 40% in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes. (for PWD candidates only).
- d) \*Lower percentile of marks for SC / ST / BC / PwD is only for eligibility purpose and will not be applicable for reservation as there are no reservation quotas for these categories. Caste certificate issued by other state Governments will be considered for determining their eligibility for cut-off scores.
- Candidates possessing qualification of the University/Board of an institution outside the AP State should submit Eligibility/Equivalence certificate from the Board of Intermediate Education of Andhra Pradesh, to the effect that the qualification possessed is equivalent to or higher than Intermediate examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education of Andhra Pradesh at the time of admission into the college
- Candidates possessing qualification of the University/Board of an institution outside INDIA should submit Eligibility/Equivalence certificate issued by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi and Eligibility/Equivalence certificate issued from the Board of Intermediate Education of Andhra Pradesh to the effect that the qualification possessed is equivalent to or higher than Intermediate examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education of Andhra Pradesh at the time of admission into the college.
- The number of seats available for the academic year 2024-25 in BHMS & BAMS Courses under Management Quota in Private Un-Aided Non-Minority AYUSH colleges will be in accordance with the orders of the Ministry of AYUSH/NCISM/NCH/Govt. of A.P.
- <u>Note:</u> If a candidate is found to have submitted false information or concealed any relevant information regarding this matter, such candidate is liable to be disqualified for admission and in case already admitted, the admission will be cancelled. Further disciplinary action against him/her will be taken by the University.

#### 2. University Fee:

All the selected candidates have to pay the University fee of **Rs.20,100/-** at the time of downloading allotment order through Online. <u>University Fee</u> once paid shall not be refunded and adjusted to a future date under any circumstances.

The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after going through the Prospectus by keeping all the Certificates ready to enter his/her correct data.

#### 7. VERIFICATION OF CERTIFICATES:

- a) The eligibility of a candidate will be verified basing on the uploaded copies of scanned Certificates / documents.
- b) The Selected candidates have to download the allotment order from the website after payment of University Fee by payment gateway.
- c) The candidate should submit the printout of the filled in online application form, provisional allotment order and original certificates along with one set of attested copies to the Principal of the allotted college at the time of joining for final verification. In case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled.

#### 9. ADMISSION COMMITTEE:

- a. The whole process of admission of candidates into UG AYUSH courses shall be under the general supervision and guidance of the Selection Committee, constituted by the Vice-Chancellor, Dr. NTR UHS., Vija..
- b. The Selection Committee shall select candidates in accordance with the provisions of these regulations.
- c. The Selection Committee shall have power to review its decision and can either admit or cancel the admission before the closure of admissions

#### 10. MERIT LIST:

The Provisional Merit Position of the candidates those who applied through online in response to the notification issued by Dr. NTR UHS for Management Quota seats into UG AYUSH shall be determined by NEET UG-2024 scores after verification of uploaded certificates by the University and officials of concerned departments as per eligibility rules/ regulations.

#### 11. THE UNIVERSITY WILL RELEASE FINAL MERIT POSITION OF ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES FOR EXERCISING WEB OPTIONS.

#### WEB COUNSELING:

The notification for exercising web options, procedure and applicable guidelines for admission into UG AYUSH courses will be issued separately from time to time.

#### 12. ADMISSION RULES:

- The Selected candidates have to download the allotment order from the website after payment of University Fee by payment gateway.
- The candidate should submit the printout of the filled in online application form, provisional allotment order and original certificates along with one set of attested copies to the Principal of the allotted college at the time of joining for final verification. In case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled.
- 13. <u>ANTI RAGGING ACT</u>: Placed on University Website for information.

#### 14. THE FOLLOWING RULES PRESCRIBED BY THE NCISM/NCH/MINISTRY OF AYUSH:

## 1. <u>BAMS course:</u> Eligibility and other conditions as laid down in respective NCISM (MSE-UG) Regulations 2022, dated 16. 02.2022

a) Duration of course 5  $\frac{1}{2}$  years as follows:

b) <u>Maximum duration to complete the course</u>: To become eligible for joining the Compulsory Rotatory Internship programme, all three professional examinations shall be passed and qualified in nine electives within a period of maximum ten years.

#### c) Migration of a student during the study:

- i) The students may be allowed to take the migration to continue their study to another college after passing the first professional examination, but failed students transfer and mid-term migration shall not be allowed.
- **ii)** For migration, the student shall have to obtain the mutual consent of both colleges and Universities and it shall be against the vacant seat.

#### d) <u>Migration during Internship:</u>

- i) Migration of internship shall be with the consent of both the colleges and university; in the case where migration is between the colleges of two different universities.
- (ii) If migration is only between colleges of the same university, the consent of both Colleges shall be required.
- (iii) Migration shall be accepted by the university on the production of the character certificate issued by the Institute or college and application forwarded by the college and university with a "No Objection Certificate" as case may be.

#### 2. <u>BHMS Course:</u> Eligibility and other conditions as laid down in respective NCH (Homoeopathy Graduate Degree course – Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery) Regulations 2022, dated 06.12.2022.

a) Duration of course 5 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> years as follows:

b) <u>Maximum duration to complete the course</u>: To become eligible for joining the Compulsory Rotatory Internship programme, a student must pass all four professional examinations and qualified in six electives and the entire course of Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (BHMS) including internship shall be completed within a period of maximum ten years.

#### c) Migration of a student during the study -

- (i) The student may be allowed to take migration to continue his study in another medical institution after passing the first professional examination, but the student who fails in such examination shall not be considered for transfer and mid-term migration.
- (ii) For migration, the students shall have to obtain the mutual consent of Both Medical Institution and University and it shall be against the vacant seat.
- (iii) Migration from one Medical Institution to other is not a right of a student.

- (iv) Migration of the students from the Medical Institution to another Medical Institution in India shall be considered by the Commission only in exceptional cases on compassionate ground. If following criteria are fulfilled and routine migration on other grounds shall not be allowed;
  - (a) Medical Institution at which the student is studying present and Medical

Institution to which migration is sought are recognized as per provision of Commission.

- (b) The applicant shall submit his application in the Form 3 for migration, complete in all respects, to the Medical Institution within a period of one month of passing (declaration of result) the first professional Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery examination.
- (c) The applicant shall submit an affidavit stating that he shall pursue twelve months of prescribed study before appearing at second professional Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery examination at the transferee college, which shall be duly certified by the Registrar of the concerned University in which he is seeking transfer and the transfer shall be effective only after receipt of the affidavit.
- (d) Migration during internship training shall be allowed on extreme compassionate grounds and the migration shall be allowed only with the mutual consent of the medical institution at which the student is studying at present and the medical institution one to which migration is sought are recognized as per provisions of Commission.
- (v) All applications for migration shall be transferred to the Commission by medical institution and no medical institution shall allow migration without the approved of the Commission.
- (vi) The Commission reserves the right not to entertain any application except under the following compassionate grounds, namely: -
  - (a) death of a supporting guardian;
  - (b) illness of candidate causing disability supported by medical grounds certified by a recognized hospital;
  - (c) disturbed conditions as declared by concerned Government in the area where the college is situated.

(vii) A student applying for transfer on compassionate ground shall apply in Form.

#### d) Migration during Internship: -

- a) Migration during internship shall be issued with the consent of both the medical institution and university; in the case where migration is between the medical institution of two different Universities.
- **b)** If migration is only between medical institution of the same university, the consent of

both the medical institution shall be required.

c) Migration shall be accepted by the University on the production of the character certificate issued by the institute or medical institution and the application forwarded by the medical institution and University with a "No Objection Certificate" as case may be.

#### 15. <u>OTHER ADMISSION RULES NOTIFIED BY THE NCISM, MINISTRY OF AYUSH,</u> <u>Dt. 22-08-2024.</u>

- **15.1** No Authority or Institution shall admit any candidate to the Undergraduate courses in contravention of the criteria or procedure in respect of admissions, any admissions made in contravention shall be cancelled by the NCISM/NCH.
- **15.2** Any admissions made beyond/over and above the intake capacity sanctioned/ permitted by MARBISM/NCISM/MARBH/NCH for the Said academic session shall not be approved.
- **15.3** There shall not be any institute-level counseling through any mode. Any admissions made at the institute level shall not be approved by the NCISM/NCH/Concerned University, and the institute shall be penalized as per the provision laid down under sub- section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of the NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020.
- **15.4** NCISM/NCH shall not approve admissions made without the original documents of the Candidates.
- **15.5** Admission made in violation of the NCISM / NCH directives will be treated as invalid, and action will be initiated under the NCISM Act, 2020 / NCH Act, 2020.
- **15.6** Institutes will be held responsible in case students face hardship due to admission irregularities such as offline admissions, admission without counseling, and admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity. In such case, students shall be discharged from the course and institution, and the institute will be subjected to face consequences as per the provision laid down under the sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020, and the person responsible will be prosecuted as per the section of IPC/BNS concerned. whichever is applicable.
- **15.7** Admissions shall not be approved by any means after the cut-off date and time for admission as specified by NCISM/NCH.
- **15.8** No authority has the power to extend or modify the cut-off date of admission specified by NCISM/NCH, and such admissions shall not be approved.
- **15.9** No authority has the power to modify the intake capacity for admission into UG Courses In ASU&H colleges sanctioned by MARBISM/NCISM/MARBH/NCH.
- **15.10** The colleges/institutes shall ensure the eligibility of the candidate as laid down in respective NCISM (MSE-UG) Regulations 2022 for Ayurveda, and Unani admissions and NCH (Homoeopathy Graduate Degree Course Bachelor of Homeopathic Medicine and Surgery (B.H.M.S). Regulations- 2022 for admissions in Homeopathy-UG courses by proper scrutiny of the relevant original certificates and documents at the time of admission.
- **15.11** AACCC, M/o Ayush will circulate the list of ineligible candidates to the State/UT Counseling Authority during the 3 & Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I & II) of AACCC-UG counseling to prevent them from participating in the counseling. Such candidates shall not be allotted any seat through any rounds of State counseling for admission in the said courses.
- **15.12** The colleges/institutes shall ensure the authenticity and correctness of the details of admitted students before completing the admission procedures. The colleges/institutes shall not allow admissions without original documents. No modifications/ corrections after the cut-off date and time of admission as specified by NCISM/NCH shall be entertained.

#### 16 CLOSURE OF ADMISSIONS:

#### As per MINISTRY OF AYUSH/ NCISM/NCH schedule.

Any vacancy on the date of closure of admissions or that arises after the closure of admissions shall not be filled.

#### **17. VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS:**

- a. The Head of concerned institution to which the candidate is allotted for admission shall verify the authenticity of the documents, if satisfied shall direct the candidate to pay the fees etc., immediately.
- b. All original documents and declarations shall be preserved in the safe custody of the concerned Head of the institution in order to facilitate any enquiry in future.

#### 18. POWERS OF THE HEAD OF THE INSTITUTION:

- a. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Regulations, the Head of the Institution may at any time, either Suo-moto or an application made by any person after due and proper enquiry, if satisfied that the candidate has furnished incorrect information or enclosed false certificates or fraudulently obtained admission may for the reasons to be recorded in writing, by order cancel her admission with University approval, provided that no such admission shall be cancelled without giving a reasonable opportunity for showing cause as to why his/her admission should not be cancelled.
- b. Against any such order of the Head of the Institution, an appeal shall lie with the Registrar, Dr. NTR University Health Sciences.

#### **19. POWERS OF THE UNIVERSITY:**

The University may either Suo-moto or on an application made to them call for and examine the records relating to any selection or admission or cancellation thereof made by the concerned authority for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the correctness, legality or proprietary of such selection or admission or cancellation and pass such order in relation there to as they deem fit, including cancellation of the selection already published or admission already made, provided that the University may, before canceling such selection or admission, given an opportunity to the authority and to the person affected to show cause against such cancellation.
