Notification is issued by direction, for conducting of MD (Ay) Part-I & Part- II Theory Examinations Scheduled to be commence from **24th April,2025** and **cut-off date for uploading the data through MEdHAS portal details is as follows and time table is enclosed:**

1	Last date for uploading the attendance and examination fee payment details without fine and freezing data on MEdHAS portal:	27.03.2025
2	Last date for Submission for examination material in the University:	02.04.2025

NOTE: - College has to fix an earlier date for collection of exam fee and complete the payment of fee on the MEdHAS Portal before the above last date and arrange to send the exam material to reach the University before the last date given above.

Mode of Payment

1. The Examination Fee payment shall strictly be through online mode by college only.
2. No Demand Drafts will be accepted.
3. Mention the remarks for which payment was done in the remark's column.
4. After completion of the online payment the transaction receipt should submit to the University along with the material without fail.
5. The payments paid after the due date shall not be accepted under any circumstances.

Eligibility criteria for appearing in MD (Ay) Part-I examinations:

1. The following candidates are eligible to write Part- I MD (Ay) Examinations in April, 2025 Examinations affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health sciences, vja:

a	The candidates admitted for the academic year 2023-24 (Regular) are eligible.
b	The failed candidates who have appeared for Part-I MD (Ay) Examinations held in Nov/Dec, 2024(Supplementary) and earlier are eligible.

2. The candidates should have minimum 75% of attendance

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Eligibility criteria for appearing in MD (Ay) Part-II examinations:

1. The following candidates are eligible to write Part- II MD (Ay) Examinations in April, 2025 Examinations affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health sciences, vja:

a	The candidates who will complete their Three (03) years (36 Months) study period by 31.03.2025 and passed all the subjects of MD (Ay) Part-I are eligible to apply. Hence, the Principals are directed to verify the cutoff date before upload the data in MEDHAS Portal and not to forward the application of ineligible candidates to the University.
b	Those who failed to pass the part-II examinations held during earlier examinations are eligible to appear for these examinations.
c	Only the candidate whose dissertation got approved by the examiners shall be allowed to appear for the Part II examination.
d	There shall be minimum of 75% attendance to become eligible for appearing in M.D.(Ay) Part-II examination.

The maximum duration for completion of the course shall not exceed beyond the period of six years from the date of admission to the course.

Note: Hall Tickets to the candidates for MD(Ay) Part- II will be issued only if their dissertations are approved.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS

1. Final year candidates are required to pay the provisional pass certificate fee along with the examination fee.
2. All the candidates have to pay marks memo fee along with the examination fee.
3. If any candidate, though eligible under normal circumstances, but fails to register for any reason or detained, it will be counted as an Attempted.
4. The attested copy of BAMS Degree certificate has to submit by the candidate.
5. Provided that the candidate, whose dissertation has not been approved should resubmit the same with in a period of 6 months not more than One year after rejection.
6. If a Candidate fails in Part-I examination, he/she shall have to pass before appearing in the final examination
7. The candidates who are from outside the state appearing for the University examination for the first time should submit their migration certificate.
- 8. In view of introduction of Digital Valuation, a single 68 pages OMR answer book with 64 writable pages will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer book of 64 writable pages only.**

MATERNITY LEAVE

1. The Post graduate students can avail Maternity leave up to 120 days only once in a PG course of study and the study period will be extended to extent of the Maternity leave availed. The candidate shall not be eligible to appear in the University examination till the completion of study period as per Dr. NTR UHS Regulations.
2. The duration of the study period of candidates is extendable in case of availment of medical leave/Maternity Leave /Any other Leave/absence beyond 30 days in each year.

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GUIDELINES TO THE PRINCIPALS

1. The principals of the colleges are required to furnish attendance certificate of all the candidates by calculating minimum 75% of attendance.
2. The principals of the colleges are required to compulsorily furnish the hard copies which were uploaded online in the University website with Principal signature and seal.
3. The principal should verify the eligibility of students before filling uploading data on MEDHAS Portal and submit the hard copies to the University on or before the specified dates. The principal will be held solely responsible if ineligible candidates are permitted to write examinations.
4. The principals are requested to furnish the number of practical answer books required and stock of answer books, if any, already available in the college and advance amount required, in the enclosed proforma. **(IF PREVIOUS ADVANCE IS NOT SETTLED, FRESH ADVANCE WILL NOT BE SANCTIONED).**
5. All the communications issued by the university especially, examination notification, fee structure, time table etc., prominently on the notice boards of the institutions for the benefit of the students.
6. The principal is hereby instructed to circulate the notification to all the students and staff concerned.
7. The following certificates are to enclosed with the exam material:
 - a) The principals of the colleges are required to furnish testimonials from two faculty members.
 - b) A certificate from the Principal or Head of the Institution/College (where course is imparted) about the completion of the course of studies in the subject in which the candidate seeks admission to the examination.
 - c) The principals of the colleges should collect the exam fee from each eligible candidate by fixing earlier date and arrange to send a statement showing the details of Name of the candidates, register numbers, subject appearing etc., to reach in the University before the cut-off date fixed.
 - d) The attested copy of BAMS Degree certificate has to submit.
 - e) If a Candidate fails in Part-I examination, he/she shall have to pass before appearing in the final examination.
 - f) The candidates who are from outside the state appearing for the University examination for the first time should submit their migration certificate.

The Principal, S.V. Ayurvedic College, Tirupathi is requested to take options from the students of Shalya Tantra Specialty in IVth Paper specialty based on student's research area as per CCIM Regulations Ref. No. 4-90/2016(PG Regulations) dated: 05.01.2018 and the same may be informed to the University.
