REGULATIONS:

The following are the Regulations for admission into BNYS Course in Bachelor of Naturopathy and Yogic Sciences Colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR UHS Vijayawada under Competent Authority Quota seats in Private Un-aided Non-Minority Bachelor of Naturopathy and Yogic Sciences (BNYS) Medical Colleges in the state of Andhra Pradesh for the academic year 2025-2026.

1. NUMBER OF SEATS IN BNYS COURSE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26: -

1.1 CATEGORIZATION OF SEATS IS AS FOLLOWS:

- > 50% of total seats are meant for Competent Authority Quota.
- > Remaining 50% of seats are meant for Management Quota.

2. 2.1 Eligibility: -

Provided that the candidates who got registered as Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) /Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Card holders on or after 04.03.2021 are eligible for admission only against any Non-Resident Indian seat or any super numerary seat; and shall not be eligible for admission against any seat reserved exclusively for Indian Citizens.

2.2 Minimum Age:-

- a) Candidates should have completed the age of 17 years as on the 31st December 2025.
- b) Candidates who do not complete 17 years as on31.12.2025 are not eligible.
- c) Age shall be calculated on the basis of date of birth as Indicated in the Board of Secondary School Certificate Examination (SSC) or Equivalent Examination.
- d) No upper age limit

2.3Educational Qualification:

(or) Intermediate Vocational with Bridge Course in Biological and Physical Sciences of Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh.		
> OC candidates: -	Should have secured 50% aggregate of marks in Science Subjects.		
> SC, ST, BC and PwD candidates:	Should have secured 40% aggregate of marks in Science Subjects.		
OC-PwD candidates: -	Should have secured 45% aggregate of marks in Science Subjects.		
English is compulsory subject.			
> Students shall be medically fit.

2.4 DURATION OF COURSE: The duration of BNYS course is 5 ½ academic Years including 1 (one) year Compulsory Rotatory Internship.

2.5 ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS IN RESPECT OF CANDIDATES WHOSE DOMICILE IS ANDHRAPRADESH:

The candidate shall satisfy Local / Non-local status as per G.O.P.No.646, Education (W1) Dept., dated 10-07-1979 and Presidential order. The procedure indicated in the above G.O. for Selection of candidates as amended in G.O.Ms.No.42, Higher Education (EC2) Dept., dated 18-05-2009 shall be followed.

The Andhra Pradesh Non-local (APNL) candidates are eligible for 15% Unreserved seats only. The Local candidates are eligible for both 15% Unreserved seats and 85% respective Local Area seats.

3. RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES:

Admission to 85% of the available seats shall be reserved in favour of the Local candidates in relation to the local area as provided in A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974 as given in Annexure-III of G.O. (P) No. 646, Edu. (W1) Department, dt.10-7-1979 and as per G.O.Ms.Nos.80, 81 & 82 of HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated.22-07-2025.

3.1 LOCAL AREA:

- **a. Andhra University Area:** The part of the State comprising the erstwhile districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam shall be regarded as the Local Area for the purpose of admission to the Andhra Pradesh Government / Un-aided Non-Minority / Minority Professional Institutions i.e., Undergraduate Medical and Dental Professional courses and to any other educational institutions (other than a state-wide university or statewide educational institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.
- **b. Sri Venkateswara University Area:** The part of the State comprising the erstwhile districts of Anantapur, Kurnool, Chittoor, Cuddapah and Nellore shall be regarded as the Local Area for the purpose of admission to the Andhra Pradesh Government / Un-aided Non-Minority / Minority Professional Institutions i.e. Undergraduate Medical and Dental Professional courses and to any other educational institutions (other than a statewide university or state-wide educational institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

3.2 LOCAL CANDIDATES:

The Local Candidate means:

- (A) A candidate for admission shall be regarded as a local candidate in relation to a local area.
 - (a) If he/she has studied in educational Institution or educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less than four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be, first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination, or
 - (b) Where, during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in any educational Institutions, if he/she has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared.
- (B) A candidate for admission to the Course who is not regarded as local candidate under clause (A) in relation to any local area shall,-
 - (a) If he/she has studied in educational Institutions in the State for a period of not less than seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as a local candidate in relation to, -
 - (i) Such local area where he/she has studied for the maximum period out of said period of seven years, or
 - (ii) Where the period of his/her study in two local areas are equal, such local area, where he/she has studied last in such equal period, or

- (b) If, during the whole or any part of seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in the educational Institutions in any local area, but has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of seven years, be regarded as a local candidate in relation to, -
 - (i) Such local area where he/she has resided for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years, or
 - (ii) Where the periods of his/her residence in two local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has resided last in such equal periods.
- (C) <u>Local Status Certificate issued through online mode by MRO</u> for claiming as Andhra Pradesh local as per G.o.Ms.No.132 & 133, GA (SPF&MC) Department, dt.13,6.2016 and circular Memo.No.4136/SPF&MC/2015-5, Dated: 08-08-2016 & Memo.No.4136/SPF&MC/2015-9 dated 03-09-2016 and its amendments issued by the General Administration Dept., Govt of Andhra Pradesh.

3.3 The following categories of candidates are eligible to apply for admission under 15% of the available ANDHRA PRADESH UNRESERVED Seats.

- i. All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates of two local areas of State of Andhra Pradesh.
- ii. Candidates who have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of ten years excluding period of employment outside the State.
- iii. Candidates who are children of parents who are in employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions other similar quasi-Public Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- iv. Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, public sector corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or University or other Competent Authority and similar quasi-Government Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh."
- N.B.: The Scanned copies of relevant certificates must be uploaded for verification along with online application. In respect of residence certificate, the certificate should be obtained from the Revenue authorities clearly specifying the years.

4. RESERVATIONS:

A) Reservation for Scheduled Castes (S.C.) and Scheduled Tribes (S.T.):

i) Out of the seats available for admission under Competent Authority Quota, the following percentage of seats shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Schedule Tribes in each local area.

- ii) In the event that if any seats reserved for S.T. not being filled up, they will be open to the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and vice-versa.
- iii) In the event of the candidates from the SC and ST are not being available, these seats shall be allotted to the candidates under open competition.
- iv) Candidates of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes belonging to the State of Andhra Pradesh only which are specified by the Govt. of A.P. from time to time shall be considered.

B) RESERVATION FOR BACKWARD CLASSES:

i) 29% of the available seats for admission in each local area Under Dr. NTR UHS for BNYS course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Backward Classes as follows:-

- ii) As per the G.O.Ms.No.1793, Education, dt.23.09.1970 and G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Classes Welfare (C2), dt.07-07-2007 and G.O.Ms.No.231, Health Medical and Family Welfare (E1) Dept., dated 11-07-2007. (* Subject to further orders of the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh / High Court).
- iii) If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Class of particular group are not available, the leftover seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them, the leftover seats shall be treated as Open Competition seats and shall be filled up with candidates by merit.

^{*}Reservation under BC-E is subject to further orders from Government of A.P./High Court.

C) RESERVATION FOR WOMEN CANDIDATES: 33 1/3% of seats are reserved for women candidates which are horizontal reservation.

5. SOCIAL STATUS CERTIFICATE:

The candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall furnish a certificate in the prescribed proforma in support of their claims. The social status of Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes candidates shall be Scrutinized in terms of G.O.M.s.No.58, SW (J) Dept. Dt. 12-05-1997.

The candidates are informed that they will not be considered for the caste claimed by them unless they upload the latest <u>Integrated Community Certificate</u>, prescribed by the Government and issued by the Revenue Authorities (Vide G.O.Ms.No.58, Social Welfare (J) Department, dated. 12-05-1997) with barcode (Annexure-I).

- NOTE: 1. Keeping in view of exhaust of 10 years common admission process by 01-06-2024 as per State Reorganization Act, 2014, the Caste certificates issued by Govt. of A.P will only be considered for admissions (Govt. Memo No.2832690/C1/2025, Dt:21-07-2025 of Govt of Andhra Pradesh.
 - 2. The Social Reservation provided for BC's, SC's, ST's in the ratio of 29%, 15% and 6%respectively shall be vertical reservation.
- 6. RESERVATIONS UNDER THE SPECIAL CATEGORIES, PHYSICALLY with DISABILITY (PwD)FOR ADMISSION INTO AYUSH COURSES:

NOTE:

- a) The reservation of seats under above special category is subject to the availability of seats in each category as the number of available seats in the BNYS Course is very less.
- b) The Reservation for Special category mentioned above shall be provided on the basis of compartmentalized horizontal reservation for each category of OC, BC, SC and ST's.
- c) The guidelines of Govt. of India and Regulations of Ministry of AYUSH shall be observed in making admissions of Persons with Disabilities (PwD) candidates.
- The Medical Board constituted by the Competent Authority will examine and assess the percentage of disability of differently abled candidates, who have applied seeking admission under PwD quota. The report of the Medical Board is final for considering a candidate under PwD quota as per rules.

7. APPLICATIONS THROUGH ONLINE:

7.1 The on-line application form for determining merit position for Competent Authority Quota Seats will be available on the website https://apuhs-ugadmissions.aptonline.in/ugbnys/home/home from 11.00 A.M on 28.08.2025 to 03.00 PM. on 05.09.2025.

Note: The candidates are advised to take a print out of the Prospectus /Instructions from the website https://drntr.uhsap.in or from https://apuhs-ugadmissions.aptonline.in/ugbnys/home/home and verify the Eligibility under Local/ Non-local category for Competent Authority Quota Seats before proceeding to fill the application form.

7.2 The candidate should fill the online application form available in the Website with the data required-for and upload the scanned Certificates/Documents in support of their claim through internet. The online application form can be filled through any computer with internet connection (home/internet cafe/net center). The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after going through the Prospectus by keeping all the Certificates ready to enter the correct data and uploading of the scanned copies of certificates/documents, photo and signature after payment of fee through online.

The candidate should furnish correct information in the online application form and upload scanned original certificates with application. The applications with incorrect information, invisible documents will not be considered and automatically rejected. If it is found that the candidate has furnished incorrect information or uploaded fake or forged documents, the University takes action that deems fit as per rules against the candidate including cancellation of seat / admission without any notice.

PHOTOGRAPH IMAGE:

Please find below the guidelines for submitting a photograph of the student.

- ➤ Photograph must be a recent passport size color picture.
- > The photograph of the student should be taken in **Casual dress**.
- In full color and of high quality to avoid any visible pixels.
- A recent photo, taken within the last 6 months.
- ➤ Candidate's name, last name, and date on which photo was taken to be mentioned on the picture.
- ➤ Head positioned directly facing the camera, centered, should compose 80% of the image.
- > The photo should capture the candidate from slightly above the top of the hair to the middle of the chest.
- > Eyes open and looking at the camera. Glasses must not be tinted unless worn daily for medical purposes.
- ➤ A natural expression smile allowed.
- > Subject (candidate) is in clear focus and distinguishable from the background. Solid color backgrounds are best.
- > Full face must be visible.
- Scan the photograph and save it as a jpg file.
- ➤ Size of file should be upto 100 KB.

- > The fee can be paid through Debit card / Credit card or Net Banking.
- > The verification fee and registration fee paid by the applicants are not refundable and will not the adjusted to a future date under any circumstances.

The candidate <u>should sign at the declaration</u> area in the print out of the online application form and submit at the time of joining at the allotted college. **The candidates** <u>need not submit</u> Printout of Application by post/by hand to the University.

9. <u>VERIFICATION OF CERTIFICATES:</u>

The eligibility of a candidate will be verified basing on the uploaded copies of scanned certificates/ documents.

The candidates who are claiming reservation under Special Categories i.e. PwD, have to watch the university website for further notifications, if any, for scrutiny of original certificates of respective special category.

Note: The candidature of the applicant will not be considered for admission into BNYS course if not submitted the online application by uploading the scanned copies of required certificates/documents as per Regulations.

The eligibility and community verification will be done basing on the uploaded scanned original certificates.

10. MERIT LIST:

The Provisional Merit Position of the candidates those who applied through online in response to the notification issued by Dr. NTRUHS for Competent Authority Quota Seats into BNYS course shall be determined by qualifying examination after verification of uploaded certificates by the University and officials of concerned departments as per eligibility Rules/Regulations.

- 1. The Competent Authority shall scrutinize all the applications received from the candidates. After scrutiny, the Competent Authority shall prepare the merit list based on the percentage of marks obtained in Intermediate examination in the subjects of Biology, Physics & Chemistry (Excluding languages) as follows:
 - a. <u>Common Merit List:</u> Containing the names of all the candidates arranged in the order of merit ranking assigned to them in the qualifying examination.
 - b. <u>Category-wise Merit List</u>: Containing the names of the candidates belonging to the reserved categories arranged in the order of merit ranking assigned to them in the qualifying examination.

- C The candidates who qualify under compartmental system will be placed in the Merit List after the candidates who passed in a single attempt.
- d. In case of Equality of marks, age shall be taken into consideration and the older candidates shall be given higher place in the merit list.
- e. In case of Equality marks and age, the aggregate percentage of marks in all subjects of qualifying examination upto **2** decimal places shall be considered.
- 2. The merit order will be displayed by the Committee for Admissions after verification of all uploaded copies of relevant original certificates.
- **3.** The selection of candidates and allotment of course / institution in respect of the seats shall be solely on the basis of merit order prepared by the admissions committee as per the prescribed marks obtained in the qualifying examination.
- **4.** Mere appearance in the merit list does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission into the course / Institution unless he/she also satisfies the Rules and Regulations of admission.

11.WEB COUNSELLING:

The notification for exercising web options, procedure and applicable Guidelines For admission into BNYS course will be issued separately from time to time.

12.ADMISSION RULES:

- 12.1. The Selected candidates have to download the allotment order from the website after payment of University Fee by payment gateway.
- 12.2. The candidate should submit the printout of the filled in online application form, provisional allotment order and original certificates along with one set of attested copies to the Principal of the allotted college at the time of joining for final verification. In case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled.

13 PROCEDURE OF SELECTIONS:

- G.O. P. No.646 dt:10.7.1979 of Higher Education Dept.
- As per the G.O. Rt. No.550, dt: 30.7.2001, G.O. Ms. No. 42, dt:18.05.2009,
- G.O.Rt.No.111, dt. 13.8.2019&G.O. Ms. No. 159 dt:13.11.2020, of Higher Education Dept. respectively.
- As per the G.O.Ms.No.8, HM & FW(F2) Dept., dt.29.01.2021.

14. ADMISSION COMMITTEE:

14.1 The whole process of admission of candidates into BNYS course shall be under the general supervision and guidance of the Selection Committee, constituted by the Vice-Chancellor, Dr. NTR UHS., Vijayawada.

- **14.2** The Selection Committee shall select candidates in accordance with provisions of these Regulations.
- **14.3**The Selection Committee shall have power to review its decision and can either admit or cancel the admission before the closure of admissions.

15. VACANCIES:

Vacancies if any, caused due to failure to join or cancellation of admission or demise of the candidates etc., before the closure of admission shall be filled by the Selection Committee in accordance with the Regulations.

16. JOINING TIME:

The selected candidates shall join the institution concerned within the specified date. No request shall be entertained for extension of time under any circumstances. Failure to join the course in time shall automatically result in the cancellation of the seat.

17.CLOSURE OF ADMISSION:

The admission shall be closed as per the Regulations of Govt. of India and Ministry of AYUSH schedule. Any vacancy on the date of closure of admission or that arises after the closure of admissions shall not be filled.

18.VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS:

- **18.1.** The Head of concerned Institution to which the candidate is allotted for admission Shall verify the authenticity of the documents, if satisfied shall direct the candidate to pay the fees etc., immediately.
- **18.2.** All the candidates selected should undergo Medical Examination as directed by the Head of the Institution concerned. The admission of the candidates shall be subject to their fitness in the medical examination.
- **18.3.** All original documents and declarations shall be preserved in the safe custody of the concerned Head of the institution in order to facilitate any enquiry in future.

19. POWERS OF THE HEAD OF THE INSTITUTION:

- 19.1. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Regulations, the Head of the Institution may at any time, either Suo-moto or an application made by any person after due and proper enquiry, if satisfied that the candidate has furnished incorrect information or enclosed false certificates or fraudulently obtained admission may for the reasons to be recorded in writing, by order cancel his/her admission with University approval, provided that no such admission shall be cancelled without giving a reasonable opportunity for showing cause as to why his/her admission should not be cancelled.
- **19.2.** Against any such order of the Head of the Institution, an appeal shall lie with the Registrar, Dr. NTR University Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

20. POWERS OF THE UNIVERSITY:

The University may either Suo-moto or on an application made to them call for and examine the records relating to any selection or admission or cancellation thereof made by the concerned authority for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the correctness, legality or proprietary of such selection or admission or cancellation and pass such order in relation there to as they deem fit, including cancellation of the selection already published or admission already made, provided that the University may, before canceling such selection or admission, given an opportunity to the authority and to the person affected to show cause against such cancellation.

21. UNIVERSITY IS THE FINAL AUTHORITY OF SELECTION PROCEDURE:

All selections made under these regulations shall be subject to such directions or orders as may be made by the University from time to time.

22. THE REGULATIONS FOR RE-ADMISSION AFTER BREAK OF STUDY FOR ALL THEUNDERGRADUATE COURSES OFFERED BY Dr. NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, VIJAYAWADA ARE AS PER ANNEXURE-III.

23.COURSE OF STUDY:

The candidate admitted into BNYS (Bachelor of Naturopathy and Yogic Sciences) Course shall pursue the course in accordance with syllabus prescribed by the University for the Respective Course.

24.EXAMINATION:

The candidate will have to appear for such examinations as are prescribed by the University from time to time.

THE REGULATIONS FOR RE-ADMISSION AFTER BREAK OF STUDY FOR ALL THE UNDER-GRADUATE AND POST-GRADUATE DEGREE / DIPLOMA COURSES IN MEDICAL, DENTAL, INDIAN MEDICINE AND HOMOEOPATHY AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES OFFERED BY DR. NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, VIJAYAWADA.

The regulation is subject to modification from time to time. In Annexure-II

DEFINITIONS:

- i. Break of study means any absence more than 3 months during the course of study.
- ii. 3 months for this purpose is a period of 90 days (ninety days) to be recorded from the date of absence irrespective of the number of days in one calendar month.
- iii. For all practical purpose only two types of break of study is allowed.
 - a. Less than 3 months of break (as per definition)
 - b. More than 3 months of break but less than the twice the number of years of study of a particular course.

Ex: For MBBS/BDS twice the number of years of study is 9 years

For B.Sc(Nursing) / Physiotherapy is 8 years.

- iv. If the candidate is on Break of study for two spells in an academic year of a particular course the candidate is deemed to have been discharged from the course of study.

 One cannot apply for condonation of the break.
- v. Only two spells of break of study for the entire duration of the course is permitted. During second spell of break of study, even if the break of study is less than 90 days, permission must be obtained from the university and that spell of Break shall also be counted as second spell of break.
- vi. For less than three months of break, the Principal/ Dean of the college can permit to rejoin in to the course under intimation to the University.
- vii. If the break of study is more than three months the candidate has to apply to the university through the Principal/Dean of the college. The University can give permission to the candidate to complete the course within **twice the years of the study** of the particular course.

PROCEDURE FOR REJOINING:

(i) The candidate having a break of study for more than three months but less than twice the years of the course shall apply for re-admission into the course in the prescribed form as in **Annexure –I& Annexure – II** by remitting the stipulated fee for condonation of Break of Study to the University request to readmission: -

The Principal shall forward the application with specific remarks about the absence period and with an undertaking from the student that he/she is not involved in criminal cases during the absence period.

If any candidate is permitted by the Dean / Principal of the college concerned without the prior permission from this university, the re-admission to the course after **the** break of study the period of such study shall not be considered as a recognized study and the candidate shall not be permitted to write the University examination based on such study Period.

When the candidate is readmitted into the course and shall after fulfillment of the Regulations of this University to the course concerned be admitted to the examinations.

- ii) The period of break of study of the candidate for rejoining into the course shall be calculated from the date of first discontinuance of the course.
- iii) Only two spells of break of study will be allowed for the entire duration of the course.
- iv) If the name of the candidate has been registered in this University on the particular course of study but the candidate has not appeared for the University examination and subsequently if the candidate has entered on Break of Study for more than two years the candidate shall start the course afresh as Dr. NTR UHS regulations.
- v) If the candidate has not completed the course beyond twice the year of duration of course of study shall be discharged from the course immediately. This is applicable for all the years of study of Under Graduate degree courses.
