**NOTICE TO THE CANDIDATES FOR THE PHASE-II WEB-BASED COUNSELING FOR
ADMISSION INTO BDS COURSE UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA SEATS
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26**

In continuation to this office notification dated.08-10-2025, the following is herewith notified in connection with Phase-II web-based counseling for admission into BDS course under Competent Authority Quota seats for the academic year 2025-26 for information of the candidates who have exercised one-time options.

1. The details of seats available for Phase-II of counseling:-

(*) NOTE: Allotments under NCC and Sports & Games Categories will be released after receipt of Grace Marks under NCC Category and Final Priority List under Sports & Games Category from the Competent Authority concerned.

2. **ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES FOR PHASE-II** (As per the one-time options already exercised).
- Candidates who have exercised onetime options but could not get seat allotment in Phase-I of counselling.
 - Candidates who have reported in Phase-I counseling (except the candidates who availed retain option and opted to exit from the reported seats) will be considered for the available vacancies in the Phase-II counselling for upgradation / sliding to other college basing on the **ONETIME OPTIONS ALREADY EXERCISED BY THE CANDIDATES** and will be considered as a part of Phase-II and same rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-II of counselling.
 - As already notified, the candidates who have already opted to retain in the allotted seat of Phase-I (by submitting self-declaration) and did not opt for free exit will not be considered for up-gradation in next phase of counselling (as per the onetime options already exercised), but will be retained in the existing seat and will be considered as a part of Phase-II (except for default sliding in the same college) and same rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-II of counselling.

3. **NOT ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES FOR PHASE-II OF COUNSELING:**

The candidates who did not join in the allotted college in Phase-I counseling and who have opted to Exit from the reported seat of Phase - I will not be considered for Phase-II counseling.

4. The selections will be made strictly as per the G.O.Rt.No.550, dated.30.07.2001 as amended vide G.O.Rt.No.111, dated.13.08.2019 and G.O.Rt.No.159, Higher Education (E.C) Department, Dated.13.11.2020.

5. Only Muslim minority candidates will be considered for Competent Authority Quota seats in Un-aided Private Minority Dental college.

6. **General Instructions**

Allotments under Special Categories: The unfilled special category seats due to non-availability of eligible candidates under respective special categories during this Phase-II counseling, if any, will also be converted and will be filled in this Phase-II counselling as per rules, since the seats under special categories are Horizontal Reservation.

7. The Phase-I seat vacated because of the up-gradation (as per the ONETIME OPTIONS ALREADY EXERCISED) during the course of Phase-II counselling will be added and allotted simultaneously to the next eligible candidates as per the merit and rules. The candidates upgraded in Phase-II of counselling should compulsorily report at the upgraded college.

8. Candidates will receive the message on their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if seat is allotted. The candidates are also instructed to visit the Website: <https://dntr.uhsap.in> for status of allotment.

9. **University Fee:** Candidate can download the provisional allotment order on payment of University Fee Rs.10,600/- through payment gateway. The students can view the college-wise list of selected candidates in the website. Candidates who allotted in the Phase-I and paid university fee need not pay again.

10. **Fresh allotment during Phase-II:** Candidates who have been allotted a seat shall report at the allotted college within the reporting schedule by downloading the allotment order on payment of University fee of Rs.10,600/- along with all original certificates and pay the tuition fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will forfeit the admission.

11. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

12. If the joined candidate of Phase-I slides to other college during Phase-II of counselling, the original certificates will be sent to the newly allotted college by the previous college after closure of admissions. The candidate has to report at the re-allotted college with downloaded allotment order and custodian certificate issued by the previous college under Dr. NTRUHS and to pay the tuition fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will forfeit the admission.

13. Verification of original certificates will be conducted at the college during admission and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated as per University regulations.
14. As per G.O.Ms.No.72, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.15-07-2019, if any candidate wants to withdraw from the course **after the closure of admissions in the middle of the course** such candidate has to submit his/her request through the Principal of the college concerned along with **course discontinuation fee of Rs.1,00,000/- for BDS course plus GST as applicable** to the University by way of demand draft drawn in favour of the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, payable at Vijayawada.
- NOTE:** The requests received directly from the candidates for withdrawal from BDS course will not be entertained under any circumstances. Any request shall be routed through Principal concerned only as per the G.O.Ms.No.72, HM & FW (C1) Dept, dated. 15-07-2019.
15. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences does not entertain or support seat blocking/ cancellation of BDS seats.
16. In case any student is found involved in seat blocking, legal action will be initiated against such candidate.
