Special Note to 2021-22 admitted batch onwards

In pursuance to the NMC, New Delhi circular dt.12--05-2023 & 11-12-2023 of the Secretary/Director, National Medical Commission, New Delhi, wherein it is circulated to allow one additional attempt (5th attempt) to such MBBS students who are admitted in Medical Colleges during the academic year 2019-20 & 2020-21 and could not pass their First Professional MBBS Examinations. *RELAXATION WAS ONLY FOR 2019-20 AND 2020-21 ADMITTED STUDENT., NO RELAXTION FOR 2021-22 ADMITTED BATCH ONWARDS.

As per the NMC, New Delhi, Regulations under Rule No.11.2.7 from 2019 Admitted Batch onwards, no more than four attempts shall be allowed for the candidate to pass FIRST PROFESSIONAL examinations. The total period for successful completion of First Professional course shall not exceed four (4) years. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt. A learner shall not be entitled to Graduate later than ten (10) years of her/he joining the First Professional MBBS course.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS

- 1. All the students of FIRST PROFESSIONAL MBBS shall abide by the Regulations of Competency Based Curriculum of the Medical Graduate Programme as prescribed by National Medical Commission, New Delhi. Vide its Gazette Notification dt.04-11-2019.
- 2. Passing in FIRST PROFESSIONAL is compulsory before proceeding to PHASE- II training. As prescribed in the Medical Council of India Regulations on Graduate Medical education, 1997, clause 8 passing in First Professional is compulsory before proceeding to Second MBBS training. It is to inform all the students that unless the students pass successfully in the First MBBS examination they will not be promoted to Second MBBS.

Moreover, if a candidate has failed to pass in the supplementary examination he/she will have to repeat the 1st MBBS course curriculum and appear for the University examination of 1st MBBS with the new batch.

3. As per the NMC, New Delhi, Regulations under Rule No.11.2.7 For 2019 & 2020 Admitted Batch onwards, no more than four attempts shall be allowed for the candidate to pass FIRST PROFESSIONAL examinations. The total period for successful completion of First Professional course shall not exceed four (4) years. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt. A learner shall not be entitled to Graduate later than ten (10) years of her/his joining the first MBBS course.

THEREFORE, STUDENTS ADMITTED DURING 2023-24 AND APPEARING FOR THE FOURTH TIME (FOUR PERMISSIBLE ATTEMPT), ARE HEREBY INFORMED THAT THIS WILL BE THEIR LAST CHANCE FOR COMPLETION/PASSING FIRST MBBS PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATIONS

- 4. All the students have to pay Marks memo fee along with the Examination Fee.
- 5. Candidates who pass this examination will be continued with the main batch. Failed candidates have to appear for examination with next regular batch (2025-26)



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PRINCIPALS

(Read all the Instructions carefully)

1. <u>Digital Valuation of MBBS Theory Answer Scripts is being implemented from July/August, 2017 Examination onwards</u>. For further details College Principals, faculty and students concerned are requested to <u>refer University Circular dated 27/07/2019</u> which is also available on the University website

- 2. Internal Assessment and Attendance particulars of all exam going students duly signed by Head of the Department and countersigned by the Principal along with scanned CD should be sent, so as to reach the University Office on or before the last date.
- 3. The Internal Assessment Marks and attendance once sent to this office shall be final and no changes will be entertained later. Hence, HODs and Principals are requested to verify the correctness while uploading ONLINE or bubbling the OMR Sheets as the case may be, before authorizing and forwarding the same to University Office.
- 4. Learners must secure at least 50% marks of the total marks (combined in theory and Practical/Clinical: not less than 40% marks in theory and Practical separately) assigned for internal assessment in a particular subject in order to be eligible for appearing at the Final University examination of that subject. Internal assessment marks will reflect as separate head of passing at the summative examination.
- 5. The student is not eligible to appear for the University exam if he/she does not appear for Internal assessment exams or if the Internal Assessment exam marks & Attendance percentage are not received in this Office on or before the last date prescribed in the Notification. In such case the candidate will be detained and no changes will be entertained later on.
- 6. Attendance requirements are 75% in Theory and 80% in Practical/Clinical for eligibility to appear for the examinations in that subject. In subjects that are taught in more than one phase the learner must have 75% Attendance in Theory and 80% in Practical in each phase of instruction in that subject.
- 7. The INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS received after the last date will not be considered for declaration of result for which the Principal will be solely held responsible.
- 8. The Principal should verify all the filled application forms eligibility of students and submit to the University on or before the specified dates. The Principal will be held solely responsible if any ineligible candidates are permitted to write examination.



- 9. The Principals of concerned colleges are requested to furnish the detailed information and remarks in respect of the candidates who filed writ Petition in the Court regarding their admissions etc. if any. (THE CANDIDATES WHOSE ADMISSIONS ARE NOT APPROVED WILL NOT BE ISSUED HALL TICKETS AND WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO APPEAR FOR THE EXAMS).
- 10. The Principals are advised to form a Committee with concerned Heads of Departments under Chairmanship of Principal/Vice-Principal who shall be responsible for forwarding examination applications and releasing hall tickets as per eligibility.
- 11. While uploading the candidates details the Principal has to take care to see that the scanning of the Photo & Signature of the candidate is done in the given space visibly. The Signature of the student should be visible and legible. The signature should be done with black ink pen in the given space and size of the box only, so as to avoid the delay or last minute issue of Hall Tickets.

- 12. The details entered in MEdHAS Portal by the Principal are final and Hall Tickets will be issued accordingly.
- 13. Competency Based Under Graduate Curriculum to be implemented from August, 2019 i.e., MBBS batch admitted in First year. Batches admitted and studying currently in MBBS shall continue with the existing Curriculum.
- 14. The Colleges should not collect Examination Fee from the Ineligible candidate such as who have failed in IA marks and who have shortage of attendance as per the Dr.NTR UHS/NMC Rules.
- 15. Please notify the contents of this Office Lr. No. 13742/E1/MBBS/2015, dt. 17-04-2021 of the Controller of Examinations, Dr.NTR UHS with regard to Question wise page allocation in the Answer booklets from 2019 batch onwards to all the students and staff concerned (enclosed).
- 16. The Colleges are instructed to have their own last dates at college level so as to strictly ensure that the Internal Assessment & Attendance, Provisional List of eligible candidates along with Examination fee reach the University office on or before the last date prescribed in the University Notification.
- 17. Before dispatching the payment details and confirmation galley to the University, a copy of the same to be sent through email: mbbsgeneralsection@gmail.com
- 18. **Online payment towards examination fee should be done by clicking the link** for entering the amount to be paid. Copy of the payment details should be enclosed.

It is to notify that as per the Judgement dated 04-11-2022 in Civil Appeal No.8037/2022 with Civil Appeal No.8038/2022 of Hon'ble Supreme court of India, there is no provision for revaluation of answer scripts as the procedure adopted by the University in Digital evaluation of answer scripts is upheld by the Apex Court.
- 20. It is hereby notified that in view of introduction of online mode of payment of fee by the University all the applications for retotaling of answer scripts will be accepted through online portal http://drntr.uhsap.in/epay/retotal
- 21. As informed vide 3rd cited, there shall be no grace marks for passing in an examinations
