Notification is hereby issued for conduct of MD (Hom.) Part-I & Part-II Theory Supplementary Examinations from **22nd December 2025** as per the schedule given in the enclosed Annexure and **cut-off date for uploading the data through MEdHAS portal details is as follows:**

1	Last date for uploading the attendance and examination fee payment details and other particulars without fine and freezing data on MEdHAS portal:	05.12.2025
2	Last date for Submission for examination <u>material in the University:</u>	08.12.2025

NOTE: - College has to fix an earlier date for collection of exam fee and complete the payment of fee on the MEdHAS Portal before the above last date and arrange to send the exam material to reach the University before the last date given above.

Mode of Payment

1. The Examination Fee payment shall strictly be through online mode by college only.
2. No Demand Drafts will be accepted.
3. Mention the remarks for which payment was done in the remark's column.
4. After completion of the online payment the transaction receipt should submit to the University along with the material without fail.
5. The payments paid after the due date shall not be accepted under any circumstances.

Eligibility criteria for appearing in MD (Hom.) Part-I examinations:

1. The following candidates are eligible to write Part- I MD (Hom.) Examinations in December, 2025 Examinations affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health sciences, vja:

a	The failed candidates who have appeared for Part-I MD (Hom.) Examinations held in May/June, 2025 (The candidates who admitted for the academic year 2023-24).
b	Those who failed to pass the examinations admitted for the academic year prior to 2023-24 are eligible to apply for all the failed subjects (As per section 7(VI) of MD(H) Regulation, 2016)

2. There shall be minimum of 80% attendance to become eligible for appearing in M.D. (Hom) Part – I examinations.

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3. **As per section 7(VI) of MD(H) Regulation, 2016, "A Candidate not passing examination in a subject of Part-I M.D(H) Course shall reappear in all parts of that subject but only ONE CHANCE TO REAPPEAR IN THAT SUBJECT OF EXAMINATION SHALL BE PROVIDED FAILING WHICH HAS TO REAPPEAR IN EXAMINATION IN ALL THE SUBJECTS (IN ALL PARTS) OF M.D(H) PART-I."**

Eligibility criteria for appearing in MD (Hom.) Part-II examinations:

1. The following candidates are eligible to write Part- II MD (Hom.) Examinations in December, 2025 Examinations affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health sciences, vja:

a	The candidates who have complete their Three (03) years (36 Months) study period and passed all the subjects of MD (Hom.) Part-I are eligible to apply. Hence, the Principals are directed to verify the cutoff date before upload the data in MEDHAS Portal and not to forward the application of ineligible candidates to the University.
b	Those who failed to pass the examinations held during earlier examinations are eligible to appear for these examinations.
c	The candidate shall be allowed to appear for the Part II examination after the examiners accept the dissertation.
d	There shall be minimum of 80% attendance to become eligible for appearing in M.D.(Hom) Part-II examination.

A candidate shall complete the course of M.D.(Hom) in a speciality subject within the duration of six years from the date of his admission.

Note: Hall Tickets to the candidates for MD(H) Part- II will be issued only if their dissertations are approved.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS

1. Final year candidates are required to pay the provisional pass certificate fee along with the examination fee.
2. All the candidates have to pay marks memo fee along with the examination fee.
3. If any candidate, though eligible under normal circumstances, but fails to register for any reason or detained, it will be counted as an Attempted.
4. The attested copy of BHMS Degree certificate has to submit by the candidate.
5. The candidate has to submit the certificate of having completed one year house job in Homoeopathic Hospital.
6. Provided that the candidate, whose dissertation has not been approved should resubmit the same with in a period of 6 months not more than One year after rejection.
7. The part-II candidates have to submit part-I passed Examination issued by the University.
8. The candidates who are from outside the state appearing for the University examination for the first time should submit their migration certificate.
9. **In view of introduction of Digital Valuation, a single 68 pages OMR answer book with 64 writable pages will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer book of 64 writable pages only.**

MATERNITY LEAVE

- a) The Post graduate students can avail Maternity leave up to 120 days only once in a PG course of study and the study period will be extended to extent of the Maternity leave availed. The candidate shall not be eligible to appear in the University examination till the completion of study period as per Dr. NTR UHS Regulations.

- b) The duration of the study period of candidates is extendable in case of availment of medical leave/Maternity Leave /Any other Leave/absence beyond 30 days in each year.

GUIDELINES TO THE PRINCIPALS

1. The principals of the colleges are required to furnish attendance certificate of all the candidates by calculating minimum 80% of attendance.
2. The principals of the colleges are required to compulsorily furnish the hard copies which were uploaded online in the University website with Principal signature and seal.
3. The principal should verify the eligibility of students before filling uploading data on MEDHAS Portal and submit the hard copies to the University on or before the specified dates. The principal will be held solely responsible if ineligible candidates are permitted to write examinations.
4. The principals are requested to furnish the number of practical answer books required and stock of answer books, if any, already available in the college and advance amount required, in the enclosed proforma. **(IF PREVIOUS ADVANCE IS NOT SETTLED, FRESH ADVANCE WILL NOT BE SANCTIONED).**
5. All the communications issued by the university especially, examination notification, fee structure, time table etc., prominently on the notice boards of the institutions for the benefit of the students.
6. The following certificates are to enclosed with the exam material:
 - a) The principals of the colleges are required to furnish testimonials from two faculty members.
 - b) The candidate has to submit the certificate of having completed one year house job in Homoeopathic Hospital
 - c) A certificate from the Principal or Head of the Institution/College (where course is imparted) about the completion of the course of studies in the subject in which the candidate seeks admission to the examination.
 - d) The principals of the colleges should collect the exam fee from each eligible candidate by fixing earlier date and arrange to send a statement showing the details of Name of the candidates, register numbers, subject appearing etc., to reach in the University before the cut-off date fixed.
 - e) The attested copy of BHMS Degree certificate has to submit.
 - f) If a Candidate fails in Part-I examination, he/she shall have to pass before appearing in the final examination.
 - g) The candidates who are from outside the state appearing for the University examination for the first time should submit their migration certificate
7. The notification is circulated to all the students and staff concerned.
