Admissions into All India Quota seats in Private Un-aided non-minority BHMS Colleges for the Academic year – 2025-26

Re-Inviting Online application forms and uploading of scanned documents for verification.

- 1) In Continuation of the earlier Notification dated 11.09.2025, Applications are re-invited from the candidates who fulfilled the eligibility criteria from NEET UG-2025 for admission into Under Graduate Homoeopathy Course under All India Quota seats in Private Un-aided Non-Minority BHMS Colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR UHS for the academic year 2025-26.

a. Candidates whose names are found in the Final list of In-eligible candidates notified by AACCC, New Delhi, Vide Ref. 1/1/2025-AACCC, dt.17.10.2025 , 08.11.2025 & 20.11.2025 and if any, notified before allotments of SVR-I are not eligible to participate under this notification & further Phases of UG AYUSH Counselling.

b. Candidates who have already submitted Online applications for this academic year 2025-26 and whose names are present in the AIQ Final Merit list displayed on 15.10.2025 University website need not apply again and they will be considered for remaining rounds of counselling as per Rules.

c. Fresh registrations will be considered for remaining rounds of counselling for the available vacancies only.

d. Last date of admissions – 10.12.2025.

e. The other conditions notified in the earlier notifications/Prospectus, dt. 11.09.2025 will remain same.
