NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB OPTIONS FOR PHASE-II COUNSELLING OF MANAGEMENT QUOTA SEATS (S1, S2 & S3) FOR ADMISSIONS INTO THE POST GRADUATE MEDICAL DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES AVAILABLE IN THE PRIVATE NON-MINORITY AND MINORITY MEDICAL COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO Dr. NTR UHS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26

In continuation to this Office Notification, dt.18-11-2025 & 05-12-2025 Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada hereby notifies the schedule for exercising Web Options for Phase-II counselling for admissions into Management Quota seats of PG Medical Degree/Diploma courses in Private Un-aided Non-minority and Minority Colleges for the academic year 2025-26 under the following category of Seats:

- **Competent Authority (Self-financing) seats and Competent Authority (NRI Category) seats in five (5) new Government Medical Colleges permitted from the academic Year 2023-24 onwards,**

All the eligible candidates whose names are in the provisional final Merit Position notified in the University Website are only eligible to exercise web options as per the above dates and according to the Seat Matrix displayed in the website <http://drntr.uhsap.in>

UNIVERSITY FEE: Selected Candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.49,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates already paid in Phase-I need not pay again.

TUITION FEE: The following is the Tuition fee structure for the academic year 2025-26 to be payable for the Management Quota seats in Private Un-aided Medical Colleges as per G.O.RT.No.777, HM & FW (C1) Department, dated 09-11-2025 of Government of Andhra Pradesh subject to the outcome of the W.P.Nos.32975, 33162 & 35090 of 2022.

Distribution of seats is as detailed below:

- 1) As per G.O.Ms.No.57, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated 28-04-2023 (Non-Minority Colleges):
 - a) Management Quota-Subcategory- 1(S1): 25% of the sanctioned intake of seats, course wise, in each institution shall be filled by the candidates in General Merit based on the NEET PG-2025 ranking.
 - b) Management Quota-Subcategory-2(S2): 15% seats out of total intake capacity, course wise, in each institution shall be filled by foreign students/ NRI/NRI sponsored candidates on the basis of inter-se-merit among the applicants qualified in NEET PG-2025.
 - c) Management Quota-Subcategory-3(S3): 10% seats out of total intake capacity, course wise, in each Institution shall be Institutional preference/In- service management quota seats filled on the basis of inter-se-merit among the applicants qualified in NEET PG-2025.
- 2) As per G.O.Ms.No.102, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated 15-07-2023:
 - a) 15% of Subcategory-1 seats only are open to the candidates from all over the Country – S1A
 - b) For the Remaining 85% of Subcategory-1 seats only Local Candidates of Andhra Pradesh i.e., AU/SVU are only eligible – S1B
- 3) As G.O.Ms.No.163, HM & FW (C1) Department, dated 05.12.2025.
 - a) **Competent Authority (Self-financing):** 35% of the seats shall be Competent Authority (self-financing) category and the same shall be filled with local candidates of two local areas of Andhra Pradesh.
 - b) **Competent Authority (NRI Category):** 15% of the seats shall be Competent Authority (NRI Category).

Instructions to Candidates:

1	Seat Matrix for Enhanced/Newly permitted Seats in Private and New Govt. Medical Colleges of Phase-II is displayed in the University Website https://drntr.uhsap.in for information of the students. All the eligible candidates present in the Final Merit list displayed on 05-12-2025 and subsequent corrigendum if any are eligible to opt for Phase-II.
2	Newly sanctioned/enhanced seats as per NMC Notice, if any will be filled in Phase-III (Mop Up) counselling subject to receipt of Affiliation orders.
3	As per the year 2024-25 Notifications for Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling, candidates who participated in Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling conducted for the year 2024-25 and allotted seats but not reported/joined are debarred for admissions into CQ/MQ counselling for the year 2025-26 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
4	As per G.O.Ms.No.67. dt.21-04-2017, the candidates who have discontinued the course from the academic year 2022-23 irrespective of their admission batch will be debarred for this academic year i.e., 2025-26 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
5	Candidates opting for Medical Degree/Diploma courses are informed that, there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web options. Candidates can exercise any number of options for any number of specialities and colleges available.

6	Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the Web and take the print out of the saved options. Candidates are advised to exercise options in Courses and colleges in which they are genuinely interested. If they are not interested to join any speciality or college then they are advised not exercise options for the same.
7	Candidates reported/allotted a particular specialty in a college during CQ Phase-I/Phase-II will not be considered for the same specialty in the same college under MQ , irrespective of their web options. This rule is implemented to maintain fairness in the admission process and to avoid seat blocking.
8	a) The candidate can login at any point of time after submission of web options for rearranging the priority list before the cutoff date. b) Options which are not saved will be saved automatically and will be considered for allotments.
9	The selected candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.49,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and report to the Principal of the Allotted College on or before the date specified in the allotment letter. University fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.
10	The selected candidates shall produce all the Original certificates, pay the Tuition fee, furnish necessary bonds etc., and complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfil the criteria as per regulations to complete the admission process in the specified dates of admission, their admission will be cancelled automatically.
11	The verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission in the respective College and in case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated. If the candidate slides to other college (i.e., affiliated colleges of Dr. NTR UHS) during subsequent Phases of counselling the tuition fee will be sent to the slided college by the concerned college where the amount is held.
12	Candidates who have reported the allotted seat of Phase-I and/or Phase-II can opt for free exit as per the schedule which will be notified.
13	Eligibility for Exercising web options in Phase-II Counselling: The following candidates are eligible: - All the candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I and reported. - All the candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Phase-I counselling. - All candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I but not reported/not joined at the allotted colleges. However, if a candidate has not joined/resigned in Phase-I then that particular seat allotted in Phase-I shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Phase-II counselling. - Phase-I joined/reported seat shall be the default last option. - The Joined candidates of Phase-I/Phase-II Counselling are eligible for upgradation up to Phase-III (Mop Up) round only.
14	Eligibility for Exercising web options in Phase-III (MoP Up) Counselling The following candidates are eligible: - It is decided to collect a Refundable Security Deposit Amount of ₹.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakh only) through online mode from the candidates who wishes to participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) and subsequent Phases of Counselling to avoid seat blocking. Other details will be notified in the Web Option notification of that Phase. - All the candidates who have been allotted and reported to the Phase-I/Phase-II seat. - All the candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling. - All candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I/Phase-II - but not reported/not joined at the allotted colleges. - Joined but resigned from the allotted seat as per University Notifications for free exit. However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I/Phase-II or resigned from the joined seat of Phase-I/Phase-II, then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Phase-III/Mop Up counselling. - Phase-I /II joined/reported seat shall be the default last option. - Candidates getting upgraded in Phase-III Shall NOT have any claim on Phase-I/Phase-II seat of CQ & MQ. - The Joined candidates who are holding a seat in Phase-I or Phase-II or Phase-III(Mop Up) Counselling are not eligible for Stray or any further rounds. Candidates allotted a seat in Phase III (Mop-Up) cannot participate in subsequent rounds of State Counselling including Management Quota Counselling, regardless of whether they report to the allotted college. All the joined candidates of AIQ Round 3 counselling will be blocked for State Phase-III/Mop UP and Stray counselling of both CQ & MQ even if they have exercised web options.

	j) Candidates allotted/upgraded in CQ Phase-III irrespective of their reporting status will be blocked from participating in MQ Phase-III counselling, even though if they have exercised web options. k) If a candidate is allotted a seat under CQ in Phase-III, they must compulsorily report. The previously held MQ seat (if any) from Phase-I/Phase-II will automatically be vacated, regardless of whether the candidate reports to the new CQ seat in Phase-III. The vacated MQ seat will be made available for allocation during MQ Phase-III Counselling. l) If a candidate is allotted a seat in Phase-III, he/she has to compulsorily report & join the allotted seat/college else the Security Deposit amount of ₹3,00,000/- will be forfeited and he/she cannot participate in further rounds of counselling. m) Candidates allotted/upgraded under CQ in Phase-III shall not have any claim on the seat held in Phase-I/Phase-II either in CQ or MQ. n) In respect of S1B seats, preference will be given to local candidates of Andhra Pradesh and if eligible candidates from Andhra Pradesh are not available, the same will be allotted to S1A candidates based on Merit list, options and subject to availability of seats. o) MCC of DGHS will share the data of joined candidates in Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 counselling with all the participating States. Similarly, the participating States will also share the data of joined candidates. Candidates who have joined up to Round 3 of MCC counselling and also the allotted candidates of Stray Vacancy round of MCC counselling will be filtered and weeded out before processing for Stray Vacancy round of counselling of AP State. p) As per MCC counselling Scheme 2025, the joined candidates up to Round 3 of MCC counselling cannot upgrade or resign after Round 3. If any candidate is allotted seat in Round 3 of AIQ/Deemed/Central Quota such candidates cannot participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) or subsequent phases of State Counselling.
15	As per G.O.Ms.No.67, dt.21-04-2017 in the final phase of final counselling, A candidate who exercised web options and joined in an allotted seat shall not be permitted to withdraw from the seat. In case any candidate withdraws from the allotted seat, the candidate shall be debarred for a period of three years for admission into Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma courses at the colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh besides payment of Rs. 3,00,000/-.
16	If any candidate joins allotted seat of Phase-I of Competent Authority Quota (CQ) seat in A.P. State can slide to a better/priority seat allotted in this Phase-II of Management Quota seat in AP State and in such case, the tuition fee already paid for the CQ will be returned to the candidate by the concerned college. The candidate has to get relieving letter from the previous reported college to join in the Phase-II allotted college.
17	An allotted candidate can report at any one college/course either in CQ or MQ in case the candidate gets seat in both CQ & MQ of Phase-II counselling. Candidates shall decide in choosing the allotted seat of admission for reporting. There shall not be any dual reporting of any candidate in CQ & MQ at different/same colleges.
18	The University fee and other fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
