I :B.Sc. (MLT) – NEW SCHEME & NEW REGULATIONS

1st Year:-	A)	All the 1 st year candidates who were admitted during the Academic year 2024-25.
	B)	All the 1 st year failed candidates during examinations held in August, 2025 and earlier.
2nd Year:-	A)	All the 2 nd year failed candidates during examinations held in August, 2025 and earlier.
	B)	All 1 st year passed and failed candidates who have completed 2 nd year study period.
3rd Year:-	A)	All 3 rd year failed candidates.
	B)	All 1 st & 2 nd year passed who have completed 3 rd year B.Sc., (MLT) study Period. The candidates should pass all the subjects of 1st & 2nd years before appearing for the 3rd year Examination.

NOTE:

As per the Notification (No.E8/2966/B.Sc.,(MLT)/ 2023, Dated: 25.09.2023) The candidates admitted into Paramedical technology courses including Medical Lab Technology prior to 2020-21 should complete their course in next three attempts of examinations, failing which they will be discharged from the course automatically.

Hence, all the candidates are informed to notice that the B.Sc.,(MLT) exam going students are already availed Two chances out of Three chances with August-2025 examinations and they have Only One chance can avail by them in ensuing examinations i.e., March-2026.

II: FULFILLMENT OF ATTENDANCE AND OTHER REGULATIONS OF B.Sc., (MLT) COURSE:

The candidates should have requisite attendance of 75% in each subject in Theory & Practical separately.

Only the candidates who fulfilled all the clauses of regulations of B.Sc. (MLT) course are eligible to appear at the examinations. **Therefore, the candidates are advised to check their eligibility before paying the fees.**

III. Minimum qualifying marks required to appear at the University External Examinations of Theory & Practical:

- A. The candidate should secure **minimum 35% marks in Internal Assessment of Theory and Internal Assessment of Practical in each subject** to appear for B.Sc. (MLT) exams in 1st year to Final year. In case of English examination of 1st B.Sc. (MLT) minimum marks required is 40%.
- B. **The Principal should verify the eligibility before freeze the data in Medhas Portal i.e.,** that the candidate has appeared and passed at the Internal Assessment Theory / Practical examinations separately.

IV. THE PRINCIPALS OF THE COLLEGES HAVE TO FORWARD EXAM FEE, OTHER EXAMINATION MATERIAL (i.e., ATTENDANCE, INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS) TO THE UNIVERSITY BEFORE THE DUE DATE.

V. THE PRINCIPAL IS INFORMED TO SUBMIT THE 1ST & 2ND YEAR PASSED MARKS MEMOS (LAST MARKS MEMO YEAR CLEARANCE) OF THE CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR FINAL YEAR ALONG WITH EXAMINATION MATERIAL.

VI. Additions:

1ST to Final Year B.Sc.(MLT) Course:-

If any candidate is eligible to appear for the examinations and whose name has not appeared in the online galley provided by the MEDHAS Portal, the Principals are requested to furnish the list of such candidates through mail to the University & MEDHAS, before the closing date (without fine) to the University along with required documents (i.e., readmission letter from the University, previous appearance marks memos) with justification for adding for each year separately.

VII. Deletions:

1ST to Final Year B.Sc.(MLT) Course:-

- A. The list of eligible candidates for 1st year will appear on MEDHAS Portal after college login for entering.
- B. If a candidate is not willing to appear for any subject(s) – enter NR to those subject(s) and circle with RED Ink in the Printout of Freeze copy.
- C. If any not eligible candidate's name appears in the portal, such candidate name may be rounded with RED Ink for deletion with remarks against it in the printout of freeze copy.


In this regard, the Principals are hereby informed that e - hall tickets will be issued for the 1st to final year B.Sc., (MLT) students.

VIII. GUIDELINES FOR SCANNING AND UPLOADING OF PHOTOGRAPH, SIGNATURE PHOTOGRAPH IMAGE:

Please find below the guidelines for submitting a photograph of the student.

- Photograph must be a recent passport size color picture.
- The photograph of the student should be taken in uniform.
- In full color and of high quality to avoid any visible pixels.
- A recent photo, taken within the last 6 months.
- Candidate's name, last name, and date on which photo was taken to be mentioned on the picture.
- Head positioned directly facing the camera, centered, should compose 80% of the image.
- The photo should capture the candidate from slightly above the top of the hair to the middle of the chest.

- Eyes open and looking at the camera. Glasses must not be tinted unless worn daily for medical purposes.
- A natural expression – smile allowed.
- Subject (candidate) is in clear focus and distinguishable from the background. Solid color backgrounds are best.
- Full face must be visible.
- Scan the photograph and save it as a jpg file.
- Allowed Photo Size – 3.5 cm x 4.5 cm (Width: 275pixels, Height: 354pixels)



- Size of file should be between 10 KB-20 KB

SIGNATURE IMAGE:

- The applicant has to sign on white paper with Black or Blue Ink/Gel pen.
- The signature must be signed only by the applicant and not by any other person.
- The signature will be used to put on the Hall Ticket, attendance sheet and wherever necessary.
- The Applicant's signature on the answer script, at the time of the examination should match the signature on the Hall Ticket.
- Dimensions 3.5 cm x 1.5cm (preferred) (Width: 275 pixels, Height: 118 pixels)
- Size of file should be between (5 KB to 10KB)

Ensure that the size of the scanned image is not more than 10KB.

XII: SUBMISSION OF INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS IN MEdHAS PORTAL:

All the Principals of affiliated B.Sc., (MLT) Colleges are directed to upload the data of 1st to Final year regular and referred students along with Internal Assessment Marks by 19.01.2026 without fail.

FRESH INTERNAL ASSESSMENT IS MANDATORY FOR REFERRED AND DETAINED STUDENTS. THE PREVIOUS INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED

The marks once submitted to the University through the MEdHAS Portal will not be altered under any circumstances. No request for change of marks once entered will be entertained.

XIII: EXAMINATION CENTERS:

The candidates have to appear at the examinations (both Theory and Practical) at the centers specified by the University. The candidates have to make their own arrangements to reach the examination centers well in advance at their own cost. The name of the examination center will be given in the e-Hall Tickets (in respect of theory examinations) issued by the University.

The name of the practical examination center will be informed through Principals of respective colleges of B.Sc (MLT).
