THIRD BNYS (NEW NR-2022)

- Similarly, candidates of 2nd BNYS who have passed all the subjects of 1st BNYS, but have failed in 2nd BNYS are permitted to carry over 3 failed subjects of 2nd BNYS to 3rd BNYS and can appear for 3rd BNYS examination concurrently along with failed subject of 2nd BNYS. However, these candidates have to pass all the subjects of 2nd BNYS to become eligible for promotion to 4th BNYS Course.
- Candidates should complete the required study period(12 months) and required requisite attendance, to become eligible for the examination as per regulations.

College has to fix an earlier date for collection of exam fee and complete the payment of fee on the Medhas Portal before the above last date.

Note (Mode of Payment):

1. The Examination Fee shall pay by college through online mode by the college only No DD's will be accepted.
2. While doing the payment the respective one should fill all columns and brief about the payment in the remarks column.
3. The transaction receipt obtained after completion of the online payment should submit to the University along with the material without fail.
4. The payments paid after the due date shall not be accepted under any circumstances.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS

1. Final Year students have to pay, Provisional Degree Certificate fee along with the Examination fee.
2. All the students have to pay Marks memo fee along with the Exam Fee.
3. If any candidate, though eligible under normal circumstances, but fails to register for any reason or is detained, it will be counted as an Attempt.
4. A single booklet with 52 pages OMR answer book with 48 writable pages will be issued to the candidates appearing for BNYS examinations and No additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all questions in the single answer book of 48 writable pages only.



GUIDELINES TO THE PRINCIPALS

1. University has introduced E-Hall Tickets from I BNYS, **OCTOBER, 2019** Examinations. This is only for the students admitted under **NR regulations(2012)** in the affiliated colleges of Dr. NTRUHS.
2. **All exam going students particulars duly signed by Head of the Department and countersigned by the Principal and upload MEDHAS Portal on or before the last date.**
3. If any candidate is not willing to appear for the Examinations or if any candidate is not eligible to appear for the examinations and whose name has appeared in the printed NRDF (Nominal Roll Demand Form) of BNYS Examinations provided by the University, such candidates shall be deleted from NRDF (Nominal Roll Demand Form) with **RED INK** by drawing the round circle against the name. The information of list of deleted candidates should be furnished in respective NRDF "D" Forms for each year separately with reasons in the remarks columns. The NRDF "D" Forms with final list of candidates eligible to appear for the examinations is to be forwarded to the University before due date prescribed in the Notification.
4. If any candidate is eligible to appear for the examinations and whose name has not appeared in the NRDF provided by the University, the Principals are requested to furnish the list of such candidates with justification for adding in remarks columns in respective NRDF ADD form for each year separately and to forward to the University with certification before due date prescribed in the Notification.
5. The Attendance once sent to the University shall be final and no changes will be entertained later.
6. **The student is not eligible to appear for the University exam if details of attendance are not received by this Office. In such case the candidate will be detained and no changes will be entertained later on.**
7. **All the Candidates should attend 75% of total hours in theory and 75% of total hours in Practical as prescribed by Dr. NTR UHS / CCH.**
8. **The Principal should verify the eligibility of students and submit to the University on or before the last date. The Principal will be held solely responsible if any ineligible candidate's data submitted to the University or permitted to write examination.**
9. **The Principals of concerned colleges are requested to furnish the detailed information and remarks in respect of the candidates who filed writ Petition in the Court regarding their admissions etc, if any. (THE CANDIDATES WHOSE ADMISSIONS ARE NOT APPROVED SHALL NOT BE ISSUED HALL TICKETS AND WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO APPEAR FOR THE EXAMS).**
10. **The Principals are advised to form a Committee with concerned Head of Departments under Chairmanship of Principal / Vice-Principal who shall be responsible for forwarding examination applications and releasing hall tickets as per eligibility.**
11. The Colleges should not collect Examination Fee from the Ineligible candidate such as who have shortage of attendance as per the Dr. NTRUHS /CCH Rules.
12. **The Principals have to download the E-Hall Tickets from Medhas Portal.**



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13. a) Nominal Rolls Demand Forms (NRDF) in original provided by the University with provisional list of candidates eligible to appear at the examinations and other material with due certification by the Principals of respective colleges are to be submitted on the due date specified in the notification.
- b) **The Principals of OU Area should arrange to collect the HALL TICKETS, etc. from the University Office.**
- c) **Regarding the referred students of OU Region colleges should submit the attendance and any other particulars as usual as per the existing procedure.**
