Notification is hereby issued for conduct of MD (Homoeo) Part -I (New Regulations) Regular Examinations commencing from **16th June 2026**. A detailed timetable is given in the enclosed appendix for registration of the eligible candidates to appear for the MD (Homoeo) Part -I.

Cut-off date for uploading the data through MEdHAS portal details is as follows:

1	Last date for uploading the attendance and internal assessment marks, examination fee payment details and other particulars without fine and freezing data on MEdHAS portal:	30.05.2026
2	Last date for Submission for examination material in the University:	01.06.2026

NOTE: - College has to fix an earlier date for collection of exam fee and complete the payment of fee on the MEdHAS Portal before the above last date and arrange to send the exam material to reach the University before the last date given above.

Mode of Payment

1. The Examination Fee payment shall strictly be through online mode by college only.
2. No Demand Drafts will be accepted.
3. Mention the remarks for which payment was done in the remark's column.
4. After completion of the online payment the transaction receipt should submit to the University along with the material without fail.
5. The payments paid after the due date shall not be accepted under any circumstances.

Eligibility criteria to appear for MD (Hom.) Part-I (NR) Regular examinations:

- a) The MD (Homoeo) candidates who are admitted by the DR.NTR UHS during the academic year **2024-25** whose admissions are approved by the University and completed study period with minimum 75% attendance and minimum 50% internal assessment marks are eligible to appear for the examinations in June, 2026 subject to the course regulations.
- b) The Cut-off date for calculation of attendance percentage of the candidates is up to **26.05.2026**.
- c) All post-graduate students shall complete a course in Basic Cardiac Life Support skills. No post-graduate student shall be permitted to appear in the M.D.(Homoeopathy) Part-I Examinations without the above certification.
- d) All post-graduate students shall complete a course in Bioethics including Good Clinical Practices. No post-graduate student shall be permitted to appear in the M.D. (Homoeopathy) Part-I Examinations without completing house job of one year duration.
- e) A Candidate not passing examination in a subject of Part-I M.D(H) Part-I Course shall reappear in all parts of that subject but only one chance to reappear in that subject of examination shall be provided failing which has to reappear in examination in all the subjects (in all parts) of MD(Homeopathy) part-I.

Digital valuation and providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet:

In view of introduction of Digital Valuation, a single 68 pages OMR answer book with 64 writable pages will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer book of 64 writable pages only.

MATERNITY LEAVE

- a) The Post graduate students can avail Maternity leave up to 120 days only once in a PG course of study and the study period will be extended to extent of the Maternity leave availed. The candidate shall not be eligible to appear in the University examination till the completion of study period as per Dr. NTR UHS Regulations.
- b) The duration of the study period of candidates is extendable in case of avilment of medical leave/Maternity Leave /Any other Leave/absence beyond 30 days in each year.

GUIDELINES TO THE PRINCIPALS

1. The principals of the colleges are required to furnish attendance certificate of all the candidates by calculating minimum 75% of attendance.
2. The principals of the colleges are required to compulsorily furnish the hard copies which were uploaded online in the University website with Principal signature and seal.

3. The principal should verify the eligibility of students before filling uploading data on MEDHAS Portal and submit the hard copies to the University on or before the specified dates. The principal will be held solely responsible if ineligible candidates are permitted to write examinations.
4. The principals are requested to furnish the number of practical answer books required and stock of answer books, if any, already available in the college and advance amount required, in the enclosed proforma. **(IF PREVIOUS ADVANCE IS NOT SETTLED, FRESH ADVANCE WILL NOT BE SANCTIONED).**
5. The following certificates are to enclosed with the exam material:
 - a) The principals of the colleges are required to furnish testimonials from two faculty members.
 - b) The candidate has to submit the certificate of having completed one year house job in Homoeopathic Hospital
 - c) The principals of the colleges should collect the exam fee from each eligible candidate by fixing earlier date and arrange to send a statement showing the details of Name of the candidates, register numbers, subject appearing etc., to reach in the University before the cut-off date fixed.
 - d) The attested copy of BHMS Degree certificate has to submit.
 - e) The candidates who are from outside the state appearing for the University examination for the first time should submit their migration certificate
 - f) The Candidate has to submit the certificate of completion a course in Basic Cardiac Life Support skills from recognised institute of the Central Government.
 - g) The Candidate has to submit a certificate or a certification form the institute that he/she has completed a course in Bioethics including Good Clinical Practices, to be conducted by the Institute themselves or by any other method.
6. All the communications issued by the university especially, examination notification, fee structure, time table etc., prominently on the notice boards of the institutions for the benefit of the students.
