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The Notification is issued for registration of candidates to appear for Super Specialty Supplementary Theory Examinations scheduled to be held from **29.06.2026** onwards.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA TO APPEAR FOR SUPER SPECIALITY THEORY EXAMINATIONS, JUNE/JULY, 2026:

1. The Super Specialty students who are admitted into the Medical Colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh, whose admissions are approved by the Dr. NTR UHS during the academic year 2022-23 and also backlog students who have failed, detained and not registered for the said examinations conducted earlier, who have completed three years of study period including period of examinations are eligible candidates to appear for the Super Specialty examinations in June/July, 2026. A student with **80% Attendance of working days for three years course by 30.05.2026 is eligible for appearing in the examination.** However, period of training will be extended by the same number of days for which maternity/paternity/any other leaves and total excess casual leave have been availed in three years. The Principal concerned should submit study period completion certificate of the students.
2. The attendance certificate in respect of each candidate duly signed by the HOD and counter-signed by the Principal indicating the Academic Year / Batch of Admission, Date of Admission (Date of Joining), details of leave availed, total number of leave days availed, attendance percentage, date of completion of study period must be furnished in the prescribed standard proforma along with the uploaded frozen copy of students' data in the University Medhas Portal. A model copy of the attendance certificate is enclosed herewith. **No other format is to be used.**

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3. Dissertations of Super Specialty Students should be approved by two external examiners and to get eligibility to appear for examinations. Hall Tickets will not be issued to those students whose dissertations are not approved by the external examiners. The student cannot be prevented from appearing in the examination if he/she has not obtained the approval of dissertation / thesis from the HOD.
4. Thesis submission certificate is also to be enclosed. The candidates of Super Specialty Examination must submit two testimonial certificates duly issued by two Professors, separately, in the prescribed standard proforma duly enclosed.
5. **As per NMC Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 2023, Under 5.2 (x):**

A Post Graduate student of a degree course in broad specialty/Super Specialty degree student will do at least **any one** of the following to make him/her eligible to appear for final examination:

- a. Poster Presentation at a National/Zonal/State conference of his/her Specialty;
- b. Podium presentation at a National/Zonal/State conference of his/her specialty;
- c. Have one research paper published/accepted for publication in journal of his/her specialty as first author.

6. DIGITAL VALUATION:

In view of Digital Valuation in Super Specialty examinations, a single 68 pages OMR answer book with 64 writable pages will be issued to the candidate appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer book of 64 writable pages only.

7. VALUATION:

As per PGMER-2023, the criteria for Evaluation of Super Specialty Courses:

All the answer scripts shall be subjected for two valuations by the concerned University. The average of the total marks awarded by the two valuations for the paper, which is rounded off to the nearest integer (whole number), shall be considered for computation of the results. All the answer scripts, where the difference between two valuations is 15% and more of the total marks prescribed for the paper, shall be subjected to third valuation. The average of the best two total marks, awarded by the three evaluators for the paper, rounded off to the nearest integer (whole number), shall be considered for final computation of the results.

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8. Criteria for evaluation Super Speciality courses as per NMC Regulations:

- ▶ The candidate shall secure not less than 50% marks in each head of passing which shall include.
- ▶ Theory – aggregate 50% (In addition, in each Theory paper a candidate has to secure minimum of 40%)
- ▶ Practical/Clinical and Viva voce – aggregate 50%
- ▶ Practical/Clinical marks - 300 & Viva Voce marks-100.
- ▶ Passing minimum for Practical/Clinical including Viva voce - 200/400
- ▶ If any candidate fails even under one head, he/she has to re-appear for both Theory and Practical/Clinical & Viva voce examinations.
- ▶ Five percent marks of total marks of Clinical/Practical + Viva Voce marks (i.e. 20 marks) will be of dissertation/thesis and it will be part of clinical/practical examination marks. External examiner outside the state will evaluate dissertation/thesis and take viva voce on it and marks will be given on quality of dissertation / thesis and performance on its viva voce.
- ▶ **No grace mark is permitted in Super Specialty examination either for theory or for practical.**
- ▶ **After the computation and declaration of the results, under no circumstances, revaluation is permitted.**

9. PAYMENT OF EXAMINATION FEE:

The fee to appear for Super Specialty Examinations is as follows: -

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10. "The Principals of Medical Colleges are informed to upload the details of the students who are eligible for appearing for Super Specialty Examinations, June/July, 2026 in MEDHAS Portal i.e., http://drntruhs.nic.in/medhas_institution on or before **12.06.2026** for processing for issue of E-Hall Tickets."
11. The Principals are advised to collect and remit the Examinations fee through online payment mode on the University website on or before **12.06.2026** and send the same to the University along with all exam material (student details, fee payment transaction receipts, attendance statement, Principal signed printout copy of data freezed on the portal etc.) to reach in the University office by **15.06.2026**.

INSTURCTIONS TO THE PRINCIPALS: -

1. The Principals are informed to verify the eligibility of the students before submitting the data on the Portal.
2. If any ineligible student details furnished on the Medhas Portal, the Principal is solely held responsible for that.

The following copies of certificates shall be enclosed by the candidates along with the student data printed format.

- a) Print copy of uploaded student data.
- b) Dissertation submission certificate.
- c) Two Testimonials from any two Lecturers of the college concerned.
- d) Attendance Certificate from the Principal.
- e) Copy of PG Original Degree (Attested xerox copy only).
- f) A copy of Poster Presentation and Research Paper published.
- g) Super Speciality period of Course Completion Certificate.

- 1. Unless these above certificates are enclosed with the printed student data, the applicant will not be considered and there will not be any further correspondence in this regard.**
- 2. Application with incomplete details/photo & signature will not be accepted.**
- 3. The referred candidates have to enclose a copy of their previous Exam's Hall Ticket and also copy of their PG permanent Degree certificate once again without fail.**

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Details of Practical answer books and temporary advance required are to be furnished for conducting theory/practical exams. **It must be noted that if the previously sanctioned temporary advance was not settled, no fresh advance shall be sanctioned.**

The above information should be **circulated** to all the students and staff concerned immediately. The students have **“To collect Marks Memorandum and Provisional Pass Certificate from the college”** after announcement of result. The Provisional Pass Certificates/Marks Memorandum will be sent to the colleges along with the result copy through online.
