The Notification is issued for registration of candidates to appear for Medical PG Degree (MD/MS/One Year Exemption) and PG Diploma Theory Examinations scheduled to be held from **22.09.2026**.

I. Eligibility criteria to appear for the PG Medical Degree & Diploma Examinations:

- ❖ The PG Degree students of the academic year **2023-24** whose admissions are approved by Dr. NTR UHS and also backlog students who failed/ detained/ not registered for the earlier examinations are eligible to appear for the examinations.
- ❖ As per NMC regulation, the candidates have to complete three years of study period (**36 months**) including period of examinations to become eligible to appear for the examinations.
- ❖ The students with **80% Attendance of total working days (i.e., 751 days of 939 days) for PG Degree Course are eligible for appearing the examination.** However, period of training will be extended by the same number of days for which maternity/paternity/any other leaves and total excess casual leave have been availed in three years.
- ❖ The PG Diploma students of the academic year **2024-25** whose admissions are approved by Dr. NTR UHS and also backlog students who failed/ detained/ not registered for the earlier examinations who have completed two years of study period (**24 months**) including period of examinations are eligible to appear for the examinations.
- ❖ The candidates admitted in P.G Degree for the academic year **2024-25** with one year exemption (those who have completed P.G Diploma course) are also eligible to write the examinations. The students should put **80% Attendance of working days (i.e., 501 days of 730 days) for two years course are eligible for appearing in the examination.** However, period of training will

be extended by the same number of days for which maternity /paternity/any other leaves and excess casual leave have been availed in two years.

- ❖ Cut- off date for calculation of attendance percentage of the candidates for both PG Degree and Diploma candidates, is **10-08-2026**
- ❖ The Principal concerned should submit Study Period Completion Certificate of the students.
- ❖ The attendance certificate should be in the prescribed format (copy attached)duly indicating the Academic Year / Batch of Admission, Date of Admission (Date of Joining), Details of leaves availed, total number of leaves availed, year-wise percentage of attendance, date of completion of study period with signature of the HOD and counter-signed by the Principal of the college.
- ❖ Approval of Dissertations by two external examiners is essential to get eligibility to appear for examinations. Hall Tickets will not be issued to those students whose dissertations are not approved by the external examiners.
- ❖ Dissertation submission certificate is also to be enclosed. The candidates of PG Degree Examination must submit two testimonial certificates duly issued by two Professors, separately, in the prescribed standard proforma duly enclosed.

II. As per NMC Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 2023,Under 5.2 (x):

(i) A Post Graduate student of a degree course in broad specialty will do at least one of the following to make him/her eligible to appear for final examination:

- a. Poster Presentation at a National/Zonal/State conference of his/her Specialty;
- b. Podium presentation at a National/Zonal/State conference of his/her specialty;
- c. Have one research paper published/accepted for publication in journal of his/her specialty as first author.

(ii) Course in Research Methodology:

All Post Graduate students shall complete Online Course in **Research Methodology** which is a mandatory requirement to be eligible to appear for the Final Examination of the respective Postgraduation course. The candidates should submit Online Course Completion Certificate in Research Methodology.

(iii) **Course in Ethics:**

All Post Graduate students shall complete course in **ethics** and should submit the course completion certificate. No Postgraduate student shall permit to appear the examination without the certificate.

(iv) **Course in Cardiac Life Support:**

All Post Graduate students shall complete a course in **Basic Cardiac Life Support (BCLS)** and **Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS)** and should submit the said courses completion certificate. No post graduate student shall permit to appear the examination without the certificate.

(v) **District Residency Programme (DRP):**

All the Post Graduate students shall submit satisfactory completion certificate of **District Residency Programme (DRP)** which shall be an essential condition before the candidate is allowed to appear in the final examination of the respective Post Graduate course.

III. Digital Valuation:

In view of Digital Valuation of PG Degree/Diploma answer scripts a single 68 pages OMR answer book with 64 writable pages will be issued to the candidates appearing for Examinations and no additional answer books will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer book of 64 writable pages only.

Further it is to inform that the Digital (ONLINE) Valuation will be done with one internal and one External Examiners as per the Orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh in WP.No.15499 of 2023 and as per the EC resolution dated 18.07.2023. Hence, the same should be circulated to the Students and Staff and also to display in the notice boards of colleges & hospitals concerned.

IV. Valuation:

As per PGMER-2023, the criteria for Evaluation of PG Medical Degree / Diploma Courses:

All the answer scripts shall be subjected for two valuations by the concerned University. The average of the total marks awarded by the two valuers for the paper, which is rounded off to the nearest integer (whole number), shall be considered for computation of the results. All the answer scripts, where the difference between two valuations is 15% and more of the total marks prescribed for the paper, shall be subjected to third valuation. The average of the best two total marks, awarded by the three evaluators for the paper, rounded off to the nearest integer (whole number), shall be considered for final computation of the results.

V. Criteria for Evaluation of PG Degree & Diploma Courses:

As per NMC Regulations (MCI) the minimum pass marks in theory is as follows:

- 40% marks to secure in each theory paper separately i.e., 40/100
- 50% marks aggregate in all the four papers for degree exam and three papers in diploma exam i.e., Degree Exam 200/400 Diploma Exam 150/300.
- **Degree** Practical/Clinical marks for 300 & Viva Voce marks for 100, passing minimum for Practical / Clinical including Viva voce 200/400 and **Diploma** Practical/Clinical marks 200 & Viva Voce marks 100 passing minimum for Practical / Clinical including Viva voce 150/300
- If any candidate fails even under one head (i.e. either in theory or in particulars) he/she has to re-appear for both theory and practical/clinical and viva-voce examinations.
- Five percent of marks of total marks of clinical/practical and viva voce marks (20 marks) will be of dissertation/thesis and it will be part of clinical/practical examination marks. External examiner outside the state will evaluate dissertation/thesis and take viva voce on it and marks will be given on quality of dissertation/thesis and performance on its viva voce.
- **No grace mark is permitted in post-graduate examination either for theory or for practical.**
- **After computation and declaration of results, under no circumstances, revaluation is permitted.**

Note:

- 1. The Principal is informed to fix an earlier date for collection of exam fee entering data in portal well in advance before cut-off date given above.**
- 2. The receipt obtained after completion of the online payment should be submitted to the University along with the material without fail.**

The Principals of Medical Colleges are informed to upload the details of the students who are eligible for appearing for PG Degree/ Diploma Examinations September, 2026 in MEDHAS Portal i.e., http://drntruhs.nic.in/medhas_institution on or before **20.08.2026** for issue of E-Hall Tickets.”

Therefore, the Principals are advised to collect and remit the Examinations fee through online payment mode at <https://drntr.uhsap.in/epay/> by **20.08.2026** and send the same to the University along with exam material (student details, fee, attendance statement, freeze copy etc.) and printout of data which is uploaded in Medhas Portal to reach by **22.08.2026**.

VIII. INSTURCTIONS TO THE PRINCIPALS: -

1. The Principals are informed to verify the eligibility of the students before submitting the data on the Portal.
2. If any ineligible student details furnished on the Medhas Portal, the Principal is solely held responsible for that.

IX. The following copies of certificates shall be enclosed along with printed hard copy of uploaded data:-

- a) Printed copy of uploaded student data
- b) Two Testimonials and Thesis submission from the college concerned.
- c) Attendance Certificate from the Principal of the college.
- d) Copy of MBBS Original Degree (Attested Xerox copy only).
- e) A copy of Poster Presentation / Podium presentation / Research paper published
- f) Completion of Course Certificate in Research Methodology.
- g) Completion of Course Certificate in Ethics.
- h) Completion of Course Certificate in Cardiac Life Support Skills.
- i) DRP Completion certificate from the competent authority.

1. Unless these certificates are enclosed with the application, the application will not be considered and there will not be any further correspondence with the candidate.
2. Application with incomplete details/photo & signature will not be accepted.
3. The referred candidates have to enclose a copy of their previous Exam's Hall Ticket and also copies of their PG Degree permanent certificates once again, without fail.

Necessary details of Practical answer books required and the amount of Temporary advance required for conducting the Examination are to be furnished **by combining the requirement** for PG Degree, PG Diploma Theory / Practical / Clinicals / Viva Exams. **It must be noted that if previously sanctioned advance is not yet been settled, no fresh sanction of temporary advance shall be accorded. Further no stationery shall be sent without requisition from the colleges.**

Further, it is to inform that as per the Judgment dated 04.11.2022 in Civil Appeal No. 8037/2022 Which Civil Appeal No. 8038/2022 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi. There is no provision for revaluation of answer scripts and the procedure adopted by the University in digital evaluation of answer scripts is upheld by the Apex Court.

The above information should be **circulated** to all the students and staff concerned immediately. The students have **"To collect Marks Memorandum and Provisional Pass Certificate from the college"** after announcement of result. The Provisional Pass Certificates/Marks Memorandum will be sent to the colleges along with the result copy through online.
