(CONVENER) QUOTA FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27**

NOTICE

It is hereby informed that the University shortly invite online applications from the UG NEET-2026 qualified candidates for counseling process for admission into MBBS & BDS courses under Competent Authority (Convener) Quota for the Academic year 2026-27. In order to avoid last minute rush and consequent delay in processing / verification of the online application, all the eligible candidates are advised to keep ready the following documents so as to upload the same through online soon after issue of admission notification by the University. **The original certificates are to be scanned and kept ready to upload.**
