ADVISORY TO ASPIRANTS OF UG & PG MEDICAL / DENTAL ADMISSIONS – 2026
Beware of Fraudsters, Touts, Brokers and Fake Admission Claims

Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences (Dr. NTRUHS) has noticed that some individuals, agencies, consultants, brokers, YouTubers and social media groups are misleading students and parents by making false promises of securing Medical or Dental seats through unofficial means.

These persons may falsely claim that they have contacts with Government officials, political leaders, University authorities or employees and may even display contact numbers or forged documents to gain your confidence. **Such claims are completely false and intended only to cheat innocent candidates and parents.**

Candidates and parents are advised **not to trust any person or organization** claiming that they can secure admission through influence, payment or any other unfair means.

Admission Process

Admissions to all **UG and PG Medical and Dental courses under the State Quota** are conducted **only through the online counselling process** in accordance with the applicable Government rules and regulations.

Competent Authority (Convener) Quota

Seats are allotted strictly on the basis of:

- NEET Rank (Merit)
- Applicable Reservation Rules
- Web Options exercised by eligible candidates

Management Quota (B-Category & NRI Quota)

Seats are allotted strictly on the basis of:

- NEET Rank (Merit)
- Phase-wise Web Options exercised by eligible candidates under the respective quota

No person, consultant or agency can influence or alter this process.

Beware of False Promises

Some consultants, brokers, touts, YouTubers, WhatsApp groups and social media pages may claim that they can provide:

- Guaranteed Medical/Dental seats
- Direct admission
- Admission with low NEET rank or score
- Admission without NEET
- Seats at lower fees through unofficial channels

These claims are **false, misleading and fraudulent**. Believing such promises may result in financial loss and may also jeopardize your future.

Important Points to Remember

- **NEET qualification by securing equal or more than cutoff score is mandatory** for admission to Medical and Dental courses as per the regulations of the National Medical Commission (NMC).
- **University officials never demand cash or any personal payment** for allotment of seats.
- Do not believe any unofficial/unreliable advertisements, videos, WhatsApp messages or social media posts regarding admissions.
- Always verify admission-related information through the University's official website.
- The responsibility for verifying the authenticity of any information rests with the candidate and parent.

Warning Signs of Fake Admission Agencies

1. Promise of Guaranteed Admission

If anyone promises an MBBS or BDS seat without following the prescribed admission process or claims to secure a seat regardless of your NEET rank, it is a clear warning sign of fraud.

2. Demand for Advance Payment

Fraudsters often ask for advance payments, cash transactions or deposits into personal bank accounts before admission.

Never make any payment to any individual or private account for admission.

3. No Genuine Office or Identity

Many fake consultants operate only through social media, WhatsApp or phone calls without a registered office or verified address.

4. Fake Allotment Letters

Some fraudsters prepare forged allotment letters bearing fake seals or logos to mislead candidates.

Seat allotment letters are issued only through the official online counselling system of Dr. NTRUHS.

Always verify allotment details through the official University website.

If You Suspect Fraud

If you come across any fraudulent activity:

- Lodge a complaint with the nearest Police Station.
- Report the matter through the Cyber Crime Portal or the appropriate authorities.
- Inform the University, wherever necessary.
- Help create awareness by cautioning other students and parents.

Protect Your Login Credentials

Candidates should **never share** their:

- User ID
- Password
- OTP
- Login credentials
- Personal admission details

with any person, consultant or agency during the counselling process.

Important Advisory

There is **no need to approach any consultant, broker, middleman or agency** for admission.

Candidates are advised to carefully read the official Notification, Prospectus and counselling instructions released / displayed on the University Website from time to time and participate in the online counselling process accordingly.

All official notifications, schedules and allotment details will be made available only through the University's official website <https://drntr.uhsap.in>

Public Notice

It is once again clarified that **no individual—including current or former employees, agents, intermediaries, consultants, YouTubers or relatives of employees—has the authority to influence or secure admission outside the prescribed counselling process.**

Any person making such claims is attempting to mislead and defraud candidates.

Parents and students are strongly advised **not to pay money or offer any favour to anyone claiming to arrange admissions through unofficial means.**

Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences is committed to ensuring a **transparent, merit-based, fair and rule-bound admission process** for all eligible candidates.

Legal Consequences

The preparation, use or circulation of forged, fabricated or digitally altered admission documents is a punishable offence under the **Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023** and the **Information Technology Act, 2000**, in addition to any other applicable laws.

Final Message

Stay informed. Stay alert. Trust only the official communications issued by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences.

Do not allow fraudsters to mislead you or stand in the way of your dream of becoming a healthcare professional, otherwise candidates /parents are only responsible for any loss.

"There are no shortcuts to a genuine Medical or Dental admission. Every seat is allotted strictly on merit and in accordance with the prescribed rules."
