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1) REGULATIONS:

The following are the Regulations for admission of students into MBBS / BDS Courses for the academic year 2026-27 applicable to the following categories:

- 1) **Competent Authority (Self-financing) seats in new Government Medical Colleges permitted from the academic Year 2023-24 onwards;**
- 2) **MANAGEMENT QUOTA (Category-B) seats only in Private Un-aided Non-Minority and Minority Medical Colleges and Dental Colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.**

As per the NMC (Erstwhile MCI)/DCI Rules, the admissions into these courses will be made through separate counsellings with common application.

2) NUMBER OF SEATS:

- i) The List of Medical & Dental Colleges and No. of Seats available under Competent Authority (Self-financing); Category-B1 & B2 is given in the Annexure - I.
- ii) The admissions into the colleges are subject to the permission by the Government of India / NMC/ NDC and granting of affiliation by Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences for the academic year 2026-27.
- iii) The candidates should have qualified in NEET UG - 2026 exam by securing cut off marks and more.
- iv) The Rank and Score in NEET UG - 2026 shall be the basis for the selection into MBBS and BDS Courses subject to these regulations.

3) SEAT SHARING:

1) Government Medical Colleges permitted from 2023-24 onwards

(i) As per G.O.Ms.No.107, HM & FW (C1) Department, dated.19.07.2023, **after allocation of 15% of seats to All India Quota** and out of the remaining seats, the Competent Authority (Self-Financing) category shall be as follows :-

Competent Authority (Self-financing):

35% of the seats shall be Competent Authority (Self-Financing) category

2) Un-aided Private Non-Minority Medical and Dental Colleges:

i) CATEGORY - B- 35% OF INTAKE

Category-B seats (35% of Intake) are further categorized as B1 and B2 as follows :-

a) B1 -15% of Category – B seats are open to the candidates from all over the Country and filled first by order of merit from the merit list of displayed under these regulations.

b) B2 -85% of Category – B seats shall be allotted to local candidates from Andhra Pradesh State only i.e. by order of merit from the merit list displayed under these regulations.

NOTE: In case of a fraction of 0.5 between Category-B1 and Category-B2 seats, the fraction is to be rounded up to the figure one and shall be rotated between 'B1' and 'B2' Category

seats in the alternate years starting from the academic year 2023-24 i.e. for the academic year 2023-24, if the seat due to fraction of 0.5 shall be meant for Category-B1 and for the academic year 2026-27, the said seat due to fraction of 0.5 shall be meant for Category-B2 by rotation and so on.

For Example:

For the academic year 2023-24, the seat due to fraction of 0.5 between the seats of Category-B1 and Category-B2, the same shall be allotted to Category-B1,

For the academic year 2024-25, the seat due to fraction of 0.5 between the seats of Category-B1 and Category-B2, the same shall be allotted to Category-B2, and

For the academic year 2025-26, the seat due to fraction of 0.5 between the seats of Category-B1 and Category-B2, the same shall be allotted to Category-B1, and

- The above provisions on fraction of 0.5 under Management Quota seats were issued by the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh vide following Government Orders:

G.O.Ms.No.58, HM & FW (C1) Dept., dt.28.04.2023 (Un-aided Minority Colleges)

G.O.Ms.No.59, HM & FW (C1) Dept., dt.28.04.2023 (Un-aided Non-Minority Colleges)

4) ELIGIBILITY:

i) CANDIDATES WHO SECURED THE CUT-OFF MARKS AND MORE IN THE NEET-UG 2026 AND FULFILLED THE FOLLOWING ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION INTO [MBBS / BDS](#) COURSES HAVE TO SUBMIT THEIR ONLINE APPLICATION BY PAYING THE NON-REFUNDABLE APPLICATION AND PROCESSING FEE INCLUDING VERIFICATION FEE THROUGH ONLINE AND UPLOAD THE SCANNED CERTIFICATES / DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION UNDER THESE REGULATIONS.

Candidates should secure the following cut-off scores and more in NEET UG-2026 conducted by NTA for the year 2026-27 to apply:

Under Graduate Medical and Dental courses:

NOTE: *LOWER PERCENTAGE / PERCENTILE OF MARKS FOR SC/ST/BC/OBC /PwBD IS ONLY FOR CUT OFF SCORE TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY.

ii) Candidates who got registered as Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) / Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Cardholders on or after 04.03.2021 are eligible for admission only against any Non-Resident Indian seat or any supernumerary seat; and shall not be eligible for admission against any seat reserved exclusively for Indian Citizens.

5) EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION :

Candidates should have passed Intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination, i.e. qualifying examination, securing not less than 50% of marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology) / Bio-technology, 40% marks in case of OBC/BC/SC/ST, are eligible for admission into MBBS/BDS Courses and they have to fulfill other relevant conditions laid down in these regulations as per NMC (erstwhile MCI)/ Dental Council of India guidelines.

***Lower percentile of marks for SC / ST / BC / PwBD is only for eligibility purpose and will not be applicable for reservation as there are no reservation quotas for these categories. Caste certificate issued by other state Governments will be considered for determining their eligibility for cut-off scores.**

6) MINIMUM AGE:

Candidate should complete 17 years of age by **31-12-2026**. Candidate who do not complete **17 years as on 31-12-2026** are not eligible and need not apply.

7) ELIGIBILITY TO “B1 -15%” OF CATEGORY – B SEATS:

Candidates from all over the country are eligible for admission into “Cat-B1” seats under Management Quota in MBBS and BDS Courses as per National Medical Commission (erstwhile MCI) / Dental Council of India / Dr. NTRUHS regulations and filled first by order of merit from the merit list displayed under these regulations.

8) ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETENT AUTHORITY (SELF-FINANCING) SEATS AVAILABLE IN NEW GOVERNMENT MEDICAL COLLEGES PERMITTED FROM 2023-24 ONWARDS:

- i) These seats shall be allotted to local candidates of two local areas of Andhra Pradesh State i.e. by order of merit from the merit list displayed under these regulations.
- ii) ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS IN RESPECT OF THE CANDIDATES WHOSE LOCAL STATUS IS ANDHRA PRADESH.

LOCAL CANDIDATE OF ANDHRA PRADESH MEANS

- a) Candidate who has studied 4 years in an educational institution preceding the qualifying examination in Andhra Pradesh.
(OR)
- b) Candidate who has studied the maximum period (4 years) in Andhra Pradesh out of 7 years of study period in educational institution preceding the qualifying examination.
(OR)
- c) If a candidate has not studied in educational institution but resided, then Candidate who has not studied in an educational institution but resided 4 years preceding the qualifying examination in Andhra Pradesh
(OR)
- d) Candidate who has not studied in educational institution but has resided in Andhra Pradesh the maximum period out of 7 years preceding the qualifying examination (of residence)

9) ELIGIBILITY TO “CATEGORY - B2 SEATS IN UN-AIDED PRIVATE NON-MINORITY MEDICAL COLLEGES AND DENTAL COLLEGES

- i) These seats shall be allotted to local candidates from Andhra Pradesh State only i.e. by order of merit from the merit list displayed under these regulations.
- ii) ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS IN RESPECT OF THE CANDIDATES WHOSE LOCAL STATUS IS ANDHRA PRADESH.

LOCAL CANDIDATE OF ANDHRA PRADESH MEANS

- a) Candidate who has studied 4 years in an educational institution preceding the qualifying examination in Andhra Pradesh.

(OR)

- b) Candidate who has studied the maximum period (4 years) in Andhra Pradesh out of 7 years of study period in educational institution preceding the qualifying examination.

(OR)

- c) If a candidate has not studied in educational institution but resided, then Candidate who has not studied in an educational institution but resided 4 years preceding the qualifying examination in Andhra Pradesh

(OR)

- d) Candidate who has not studied in educational institution but has resided in Andhra Pradesh the maximum period out of 7 years preceding the qualifying examination (of residence)

10) ELIGIBILITY TO “CATEGORY-B” SEATS IN UN-AIDED PRIVATE MINORITY MEDICAL COLLEGES DENTAL COLLEGES:

Management Quota “Category-B” seats in Minority Medical Colleges and Minority Dental Colleges will be allotted to Muslim Minority Candidates only. If Muslim Minority Candidates are not available, the seats will be allotted to Non-Muslim Minority Candidates in the Stray Phase of Counselling. Muslim Minority Candidates are also eligible for Management Quota seats in other Medical Colleges.

NOTE: Application and Processing Fee including Late Fee, if any once paid will not be refunded or adjusted to future date under any circumstances. Hence, candidates are advised to take a print out of the Prospectus / Instructions from the website <https://drntr.uhsap.in> and read carefully before proceeding to fill the online application form and upload the scanned certificates/documents.

- i) Candidates who have already applied for Competent Authority Quota Seats in response to this University earlier notification are also eligible for the seats notified under these regulations [Govt. (Self-Financing) and Management Quota (Category- B1, B2)], **but they have to submit separate online application** duly uploading the required scanned original certificates through <https://drntr.uhsap.in>
- ii) The Application submitted only for Competent Authority Quota seats will not be considered for Management Quota seats.
- iii) **The candidate should fill the online application form available in the Website with the data required-for and upload the scanned Certificates/Documents in support of their claim through internet.**
- iv) The online application form can be filled through any computer with internet connection (home/internet cafe/net centre). The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after reading the Prospectus by keeping all the Certificates ready to enter the correct data and uploading of the scanned Original Certificates/ Documents, Photo and Signature after payment of fee through online.
- v) **The candidate should furnish correct information in the online application form and upload scanned original certificates. The applications with incorrect information, invisible documents will not be considered and automatically rejected. If it is found that the candidate has furnished false information or uploaded fake or forged documents at any stage of admission or after closure of admissions, the University will take action that deems fit as per rules against such candidate including cancellation of seat/ admission, in case already admitted, without any notice and action will be taken legally. Further action against such candidate will be taken by the University.**
- vi) **Candidates possessing qualification of the University / Board of an institution outside INDIA should submit Eligibility / Equivalence certificate issued by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi and also Equivalence certificate issued by the Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh, to the effect that the qualification possessed is equivalent to or higher than the Intermediate examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education of Andhra Pradesh, at the time of admission in the college.**

12) PROCEDURE TO FILL ONLINE APPLICATION:

1. The candidates are advised to take a print out of the Prospectus / User manual from the website <https://drntr.uhsap.in> and read carefully before proceeding to fill the application form.
2. Visit website <https://drntr.uhsap.in> through Internet to fill up the application form.

13) VERIFICATION OF CERTIFICATES:

- i) The eligibility of a candidate will be verified basing on the uploaded copies of scanned certificates / documents.
- ii) **The candidature of the applicant will not be considered** for admission to MBBS/BDS courses, if online application is submitted **without uploading the scanned copies of required certificates/ documents as per regulations.**
- iii) The process of application and certificate verification will be done through online mode. The following Certificates are required to complete the application process. The certificates are to be scanned and kept ready to upload. Application fee has to be paid through online.
- iv) The Registration number sent to the registered mobile after entering the basic details should be noted for further use. The Registration number should be kept confidentially and not to disclose or share with others.
- v) The candidate should sign at the declaration area in the print out of the online application form.
The candidates need not submit or send the Printout of Application to the university.
- vi) The candidate should submit the Seat Allotment Order, Print-out of filled-in online application form, downloaded Provisional Verification form along with original certificates/ documents at the time of admission at the allotted college.

14) MERIT LISTS:

The Provisional Merit Position of the candidates those who have applied through online in response to the notification issued by Dr. NTRUHS for Management Quota seats into MBBS/BDS Course shall be determined by NEET UG-2026 scores after verification of uploaded certificates by the University and officials of concerned departments as per eligibility rules/ regulations. The Provisional Merit Position will be placed on University website <https://drntr.uhsap.in> duly calling for objections, if any.

THE UNIVERSITY WILL RELEASE FINAL MERIT POSITION OF ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES FOR EXERCISING WEB OPTIONS.

15) WEB COUNSELING:-

The notifications for exercising web options for admission into MBBS/BDS courses will be issued separately and placed on the website <https://drntr.uhsap.in> from time to time. No individual intimations will be sent.

16) COLLECTION OF SECURITY DEPOSIT AMOUNT:

It is decided to collect a Refundable Security Deposit Amount as follows through online mode from the candidates who wishes to participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) and subsequent Phases of Counselling including Special Stray Rounds, if any to avoid seat blocking. Other details will be notified in the Web Option notification of that Phase.

RULES FOR REFUND/FORFEITURE

- Refundable Security Deposit of candidates who do not join the seats allotted to them in Phase-III or Stray Vacancy Round(s) or subsequent rounds, if any, will be forfeited.
- If the candidate joins the allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate after closure of admissions.
- If the candidate is not allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate after closure of admissions.
- Also, the Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason. e.g. in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission (within stipulated time).

NOTE: List of eligible and not eligible for refund of Security Deposit will be displayed in the University website after closure of Admissions.

17) ADMISSION RULES:

University Fee:

i) The selected candidates have to download the allotment order by paying the following University fee through Payment Gateway by using online payment method. iii) If it is found at the time of admission or later that he/she has furnished incorrect information or uploaded fake or forged documents, the University takes action that deems fit as per rules against the candidate including cancellation of seat / admission without any notice.
