ADMISSIONS INTO MBBS & BDS COURSE UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27

In modification to previous counselling procedure the Competent Authority for admissions, Dr.NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, A.P has decided to implement the following instructions on procedure of counselling for admission into MBBS & BDS courses under Management Quota for the academic year 2026-27 in line with MCC counseling scheme 2026 for AIQ duly considering upgradation upto Phase-III. **Competent Authority reserves rights to amend or modify any of the rules as per the instructions of the Govt. of India/State Govt.**

(1) Kinds of Management Quota Seats

- 1) Competent Authority (Self-Financing) seats in new Government Medical Colleges permitted from the academic Year 2023-24 onwards;
- 2) Category-B seats in Non-Minority Private Medical and Dental Colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR UHS. These seats are further categorised as follows as per G.O.Ms.No.253 HM&FW (C1) Dept, Dt: 11.10.2022.
 - a) Category-B1 -15% of B Category seats - Candidates from all over the country are eligible
 - b) Category-B2 – 85% of B Category seats - Local Candidates of Andhra Pradesh i.e., AU/SVU are only eligible.
- 3) Category-B seats in Minority Private Medical Colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR UHS

(2) ELIGIBILITY

- a) The candidates who secured the cut-off marks or more in the NEET-UG 2026 and fulfilled the following criteria for admission into MBBS/BDS courses under **MANAGEMENTQUOTA SEATS**.
- b) The candidates should secure the following cutoff scores in National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) UG -2026, conducted by NATIONAL TESTING AGENCY, New Delhi as per section (10) of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

- c) **Educational qualifications:** The candidate should have passed Intermediate (10+2 pattern) or its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology)/ Biotechnology and English.

- d) **Minimum Age:** The candidate should complete 17 years of age as on 31-12-2026. The candidates **who do not complete 17 years as on 31-12-2026 are not eligible.**

University Fee:

The selected candidates have to download the allotment order by paying the following University fee through Payment Gateway by using online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and report to the Principal of allotted college along with the allotment order and original certificates before the date specified in the allotment order and pay the prescribed tuition fee at college.

(5) WEB OPTIONS

- a. The eligible candidates present in the Provisional Final Merit list displayed in the Website should exercise prioritized web options as per the schedule notified
- b. A candidate has to exercise options for the interested medical colleges in the order of priority.**
- c. Candidates have to opt web options for each phase of counselling as per the schedules notified by the University before each phase.
- d. Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the web. One Time Password will be sent to the registered mobile and mail at the time of entering and submitting web options.
- e. The options once exercised are final. No request for change of options or order of college priorities will be entertained after closure of respective web options schedules.
- f. Once the eligible candidate exercised his option and if the seat is allotted under Management Quota of (Self-Financing / Category- B) as per his / her better option and availability of seat, it is deemed that the candidate is willing to join in that particular seat and also ready to pay tuition fee (Category – B) of seat as fixed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh. Hence, the candidates are advised to take calculated decision while exercising web options under Management Quota.
- g. Management Quota B seats in Minority Medical / Dental Colleges will be allotted to Muslim Minority Candidates only. If Muslim Minority Candidates are not available, the seats will be allotted to Non-Minority Candidates in Stray Counselling. Muslim Minority Candidates are also eligible for Management Quota seats in other Medical /Dental Colleges.
- h. Candidates are instructed to take the printout of the saved options for each Phase of counselling.
- i. Statutory reservations are not applicable to the Management Quota seats.

PRIORITISED WEB OPTIONS

- a) Candidates will be allowed to edit the options for any number of times till closure of the schedule for exercising options. Candidate has to select the button “SAVE” to save the options exercised. **Options which are not saved will be SAVED automatically and will be considered for allotment.**
- b) Candidate will receive OTP's, one before exercising options and another OTP at each time of editing the options till closure of schedule. At each time of editing the options, the candidate has to select the button “SAVE” to save the edited options. In such cases, last saved options will only be considered.
- c) **MBBS** – All the **candidates** can opt **for 27 colleges** (including minority) as per eligibility. **Opting all colleges is not compulsory.**
- d) **BDS** – The candidates can opt for **15 colleges** including Minority Dental College as per eligibility. **Opting all colleges is not compulsory.**
- e) **User manual** regarding the procedure on exercising options will be displayed on University website before issue of Notification for counselling.

(7) PHASE-I COUNSELLING

1. All the candidates who are in the Final Merit list are eligible for Phase-I counselling as per the Notification.
2. Candidates have to exercise options for Self-Financing seats in Government Medical Colleges in order of priority of the colleges. Allotments will be made according to the order of preference in the web options exercised by the candidate and as per rules.
3. Candidates have to exercise options for category B in order of priority of the colleges for the seats available in private Medical Colleges. Allotments will be made according to the order of preference in the web options exercised by the candidate and as per rules.
4. **B1 seats** are to be filled **FIRST in a college** based on options by order of merit from the merit list displayed under these regulations - Candidates from all over the country and Andhra Pradesh are eligible.
5. **B2 seats** – Local Candidates of Andhra Pradesh are only eligible and to be filled after exhaustion of B1 Seats in a college as per prioritized options and by order of merit from the merit list displayed under these regulations. For detailed definitions please see Prospectus.
6. **B1 Category - Self Financing seats in Govt. Medical Colleges** - Local Candidates of Andhra Pradesh are only eligible.
7. The allotments shall be based on his/her priorities.

9. Management Quota B seats in Minority Medical / Dental Colleges will be allotted to Muslim Minority Candidates only under Phase-I Counselling
10. If a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I MQ then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Phase-II MQ counselling.
11. Selected candidates have to report to the Principal of the allotted college before the last date and time for joining as specified in the allotment order with all original

certificates and relevant bonds, if any, and pay the tuition fee to complete the process of admission. If the candidate fails to report before the reporting date and time, the admission will be cancelled automatically.

12. The Seats Matrix is given at Annexure- I & II.

(8) Reporting at the allotted College:

- a) Candidates will receive the message to their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if seat is allotted. The candidates are instructed to visit the **website:** <https://dntr.uhsap.in> for status of allotment after closure of web options.
- b) Candidates who have been allotted a seat shall report at the allotted college within the reporting schedule by downloading the allotment order on payment of University fee as specified. with all original certificates and pay the tuition fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will forfeit the admission.
- c) Verification of original certificates will be conducted at the college of admission and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated as per University regulations.
- d) **If not allotted any seat in Phase-I:**
Candidates who have not been allotted any seat in the Phase-I of counselling will be considered for available vacancies in Phase-II of counselling.
- e) **If not reported at the allotted College:**

The candidates who do not report at the allotted college in the Phase-I counselling, will be allowed to participate in the Phase-II counselling, provided that the candidates have no right to claim earlier allotted seat again under Phase-II counselling. However, that particular seats will not be allowed under Phase-II Counselling.

Free EXIT (RESIGN) from the Phase - I reported / joined college

- a) Reported/Joined candidates of Phase-I are permitted to exit from the reported seat as per the schedule notified by the University. Such candidates can participate in CQ (or) MQ Phase-II counselling of Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada as per rules, provided that the candidates have no right to claim earlier allotted seat under Phase-I of MQ counselling
- b) Candidates, who are willing to avail free exit facility, shall submit their written requests to the Principal concerned duly signed by both the candidate and Parent/Guardian.

- c) In that situation, the Principals will return original certificates and entire Tuition fee and other fees collected, if any, to the candidates immediately and shall freeze the latest data as per schedule notified.
- d) **After completion of notified schedule, no candidate will be permitted to Exit / withdraw from the joined seat under Phase-I Counselling.**
- e) Candidates who have resigned from the Phase-I reported / joined seat before the said date will be considered as “**not reported /not joined**” and such vacated seats will be filled in Phase-II counselling as per rules.
- f) Phase-I Reported candidates who have not opted to exit from the Phase-I reported seat will be eligible to participate in Phase-II of counselling with fresh prioritised web options and will be considered as a part of Phase-II and same rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-II of counselling.

PHASE II COUNSELLING

- a) Details of number of seats available for Phase-II Counselling will be displayed in the University website and fresh web options will be called for.
- b) **Options:** Phase – II counselling will be conducted to the candidates who participate in the counselling duly exercising prioritized web options as per the schedule notified.
- c) A candidate has to exercise options for the interested medical colleges in the order of priority. The options once exercised are final. No request for change of options or order of college priorities will be entertained after closure of above said web options schedule.
- d) Candidates who are satisfied with Phase-I reported seat need not participate in Phase-II counselling.
- e) Candidates who are willing to slide to other college only can participate in Phase-II counselling with fresh options.
- f) Priority of earlier joined seat will be displayed as last priority and if not slid under Phase-II, the candidate shall continue in the joined seat of Phase-I and default sliding from Category B2 to B1 will be allowed as per rules.
- g) Candidates are instructed to take the printout of the saved options.
- h) **Blocking of the candidates** will be done as per the guidelines/information to be provided by the MCC, DGHS/NMC/DCI before commencement of the counselling.
- i) In phase-II, the following seats are filled:
 - a) unfilled seats from phase-I, if any,
 - b) vacancies arising due to non-joining.
 - c) Resultant vacancies due to sliding of candidates from one college to another college during Phase-II counselling.
- j) **Who are eligible for Phase-II Counselling?**
 - a) Candidate who is holding a seat under Phase-I of Counselling under Management Quota.
 - b) Not reported candidates in Phase – I of Management Quota; however that particular Not Reported seat will not be allowed under Phase – II Counselling.
 - c) Not allotted candidate during Phase-I Counselling who are found in Final Merit List of MQ.
- k) Candidates who have joined in MBBS Course under Management Quota in earlier counselling of Dr. NTR UHS are eligible for exercising options in this Phase-II of counselling, if they wish to slide to other college or to another category.
- l) The allotments will be as per the prioritised options exercised by the candidates.
- m) B2 seats - Local Candidates of Andhra Pradesh are only eligible and will be filled after exhaustion of B1 Seats in a college as per prioritized options and by order of merit from the merit list displayed under these regulations.

- n) Self-Financing seats in Govt. Medical Colleges - Local Candidates of Andhra Pradesh are only eligible.
- o) If a candidate exercises options for both 'B and C' category in same college, allotment shall be based on his/her priorities.
- p) Default Sliding shall be allowed from B2 to B1 in the same college.
- q) Candidates have to exercise options for Self-Financing seats in new Government Medical Colleges, category - B seats in order of priority of the colleges. Allotments will be made according to the order of preference in the web options exercised by the candidate and as per rules.
- r) Management Quota Category-B seats in Minority Medical Colleges will be allotted to Muslim Minority Candidates only. If Muslim Minority Candidates are not available, the seats will be allotted to Non-Minority Candidates in the Stray Counselling. Muslim Minority Candidates are also eligible for Management Quota seats in other Medical Colleges.
- s) Selected candidates have to report to the Principal of the allotted college before the last date and time for joining as specified on the allotment order with all original certificates and relevant bonds, if any, and pay the tuition fee and college fee to complete the process of admission. If the candidate fails to report before the reporting date and time, the admission will be cancelled automatically.
- t) If the joined candidate of Phase-I slides to other college during Phase-II of counselling, the original certificates of such candidates will be sent to the newly allotted college by the previous college after closure of admissions. The candidate has to report at the re-allotted college with downloaded allotment order along with custodian certificate issued by the previous college under Dr. NTR UHS and to pay the tuition fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will forfeit the admission.
- u) The candidates who do not report at the allotted college in the Phase-I or Phase-II counselling, will be allowed to participate in the Phase-III counselling, provided that the candidates have no right to claim earlier allotted seat under Phase-I or Phase-II counselling and also that particular Phase-I and Phase-II not reported seats will not be allowed under Phase-III counselling.
- v) Students who have already paid the University fee in Phase – I, need not pay again if seat is allotted in Phase-II, but students should download the allotment order if there is a change of seat / college in Phase-II & report.
- w) Candidate slid in Phase-II of Counselling will NOT have any claim on previous allotments i.e. Phase-I seat as the vacancies resulting due to sliding are filled within this phase by the next eligible meritorious candidate in the merit list.
- x) Candidate who got fresh admission under Phase-II must report physically at the allotted college along with all relevant original certificates.

- y) The original certificates will be verified at the college and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated as per university regulations.

Free EXIT(RESIGN) from the Phase-I / Phase -II reported / joined college

- a) SCHEDULE: As notified by the University
- b) Reported/Joined candidates of Phase-I / Phase – II are permitted to exit from the reported seat as per the schedule notified by the University. Such candidates can participate in MQ Phase-III counselling of Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada, provided that the candidates have no right to claim earlier allotted seat(s) again under Phase-I / Phase-II counselling and also that particular Phase-I/Phase-II not reported seats will not be allowed under Phase-III counselling.
- c) Procedure will be the same as explained under Phase-I of counselling.
- d) **After completion of notified schedule, no candidate will be permitted to withdraw from the joined seat upto / under Phase-II Counselling and cannot resign the seat.**
- e) Candidates who have resigned from the Phase-II reported/joined seat before the said date will be considered as “**not reported /not joined**” and such vacated seats will be filled in Phase-III counselling as per rules.
- f) After the completion of Free Exit process, under Phase-II, the candidates holding seats upto / under Phase-II will be considered as a part of Phase-III and the Phase-III rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-III of counselling and cannot resign the seat.
- g) Reported Candidates who have not utilised the free exit facility as per the schedule notified after Phase-II of counselling cannot resign the seat during the course of admissions i.e from Phase-III counselling to till closure of admissions.

PHASE-III (MOP-UP ROUND) COUNSELLING

a) SECURITY DEPOSIT AMOUNT:

It is decided to collect a Refundable Security Deposit Amount as follows through online mode from the candidates who wishes to participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) and subsequent Phases of Counselling including Special Stray Rounds, if any to avoid seat blocking. Other details will be notified in the Web Option notification of that Phase.

b) RULES FOR REFUND / FORFEITURE

- i. Refundable Security Deposit of candidates who do not join the seats allotted to them in Phase-III or Stray Vacancy Round(s) or subsequent rounds, if any, will be forfeited.
- ii. If the candidate joins the allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate after closure of admissions.
- iii. If the candidate is not allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate after closure of admissions.
- iv. Also, the Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason. e.g. in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission (within stipulated time).

NOTE: List of eligible and not eligible for refund of Security Deposit will be displayed in the University website after closure of Admissions only.

- c) **Options:** Subject to payment of security deposit amount, candidates who are aspiring to join under Management Quota under this phase have to exercise prioritised web options as per the schedule notified.
- d) The Phase- III (Mop-up Round) of counselling will be conducted for the following seats
- i) Unfilled seats after Phase-II under Management Quota, if any
 - ii) Vacancies which are available due to non-joining of allotted candidates in Phase-II and exit after Phase-II. Vacancies will be notified in the University website.
 - iv) Resultant vacancies due to sliding of candidates from one college to another college during Phase-III counselling.

e) Who are eligible for Phase-III (Mop-Up) of Counselling?

- a) All the Candidates who are found in the Final Merit Position under Management Quota are eligible to exercise web options under Phase-III of Counselling. But, the particular not reported seats of Phase-I/Phase-II will not be allowed to respective candidates under Phase-III counselling.
- b) Candidate holding a seat after completion of Free Exit facility under Phase-II of Counselling under Management Quota.

f) Who are not eligible for Phase-III Counselling?

- i. Candidates who have availed retain option and did not exit in the Competent Authority Quota after Phase-I / Phase-II of Counselling.
 - ii. Candidate who is allotted seat in Phase-III of Counselling under Competent Authority Quota.
 - iii. Candidates allotted under round-3 of All India Quota and found in the list shared by Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), DGHS, New Delhi are not eligible for Phase-III (Mop-up round) counselling under Dr. NTR UHS.
- g) Candidates who are allotted seat in Phase-III (Mop-up round) of counselling have to report to the allotted college **compulsorily** with all original certificates, provisional allotment order and copy of final application, and pay the tuition fee and college fee. Such candidate cannot resign the seat allotted.
 - h) Candidates slid in Phase-III of Counselling will NOT have any claim on previous allotments i.e. Phase-I seat or Phase-II seat as the vacancies resulting from sliding are filled within this phase by the next eligible meritorious candidate.
 - i) Any candidate allotted a seat under Phase-III (Mop-up) of Counselling is not eligible to participate in Stray Vacancy Round of Counselling.
 - j) Candidate slid in Phase-III (Mop-up round) of Dr. NTRUHS must take relieving from previous college and report physically in the allotted college of Phase-III (Mop-Up round) seat along with Custodian (only under Dr. NTRUHS) certificate of originals.
 - k) Candidate who got fresh admission under Phase-III (Mop-up Round) must report physically at the allotted college along with all relevant original certificates.
 - l) The original certificates will be verified at the college and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated as per university regulations.
 - m) **No candidate is permitted to withdraw from the course till closure of the admissions.**
 - n) **There is no sliding after Phase-III of counselling.**

STRAY VACANCY ROUND

1. SECURITY DEPOSIT AMOUNT:

Candidates who are participating under Stray Vacancy Round have to pay Security Deposit Amount as notified before exercising web options. Candidates those who have already paid but not allotted seat during Phase-III (Mop-Up) under Management Quota are need not pay Security Deposit Amount again and will be allowed to exercise web option under this phase. Other details will be notified in the Web Option notification of that Phase

2. Subject to availability of seats, if any, Stray Vacancy Round of Counselling will be conducted as per the schedule notified by the University. Vacancies, if any will be notified in the University website.
3. All the available seats against Stray Vacancy Round will be filled through online mode only.
4. Depending up on the vacancies, Stray Vacancy Round can be completed in Multiple Runs duly adhering to MCC schedule.
5. Subject to availability of seats, University will issue Notification for calling of applications through online mode only. Decision of the Competent Authority is final in this regard.

6. Who are eligible candidates against Stray Vacancy Round?

- i. Candidates who are not holding seat under Management Quota of Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada / All India Quota / KNR University of Health Sciences, Warangal.
- ii. Candidates allotted seat under Phase-I or Phase-II under Management Quota of Dr. NTRUHS but not holding any seat after Phase-III of Dr. NTRUHS. (other than seats allotted in Phase-I or Phase-II)
- iii. Candidates who have availed FREE EXIT after Phase-II of Competent Authority Quota of Dr. NTRUHS and found in MQ merit list.
- iv. Candidates who were not allotted seat under Phase-III of Competent Authority Quota of Dr. NTRUHS-/ Phase-III of Management Quota of Dr. NTRUHS and must present in Management Quota merit list.
- v. A List of eligible candidates for Stray Vacancy will be placed in the University Website.

7. Who are not eligible against Stray Vacancy Round?

- i. Candidate joined / holding any seat after Phase-III under Dr NTR University of Health Sciences / All India Quota / KNR University of Health Sciences / Other States are not eligible for Stray Vacancy Round.
- ii. Allotted candidates of All India Quota Round-3 are not eligible for Stray Vacancy Round.

- iii. Allotted candidates of All India Quota Stray Vacancy Round are not eligible for Stray Vacancy Round of Dr. NTRUHS.
 - iv. Candidates allotted seat under Phase-III of Competent Authority Quota of Dr. NTRUHS / Phase-III of Management Quota of Dr. NTRUHS are not eligible for Stray Vacancy Round of Dr. NTRUHS.
 - v. Candidates found in the list shared by Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) after Round-3 and Stray in either Centre or State will not be eligible against Stray Vacancy Round.
 - vi. If it is found that an ineligible candidate has opted, candidature of such candidates will not be considered for allotments. Application fee paid if any, will not be refunded.
8. **Options:** Eligible candidates have to exercise web options for Stray Vacancy Round as per the Schedule notified as per their priorities Category-wise (Self-Financing / Cat-B) and College-wise. The allotments will be as per the prioritized options exercised by the candidates.
9. Candidates will receive the message regarding allotment of seats, if seat is allotted.
10. Candidates who are allotted seat against Stray Vacancy Round of counselling have to report to the allotted college **COMPULSORILY** with all original certificates, provisional allotment order, and copy of final application and pay the tuition fee, college fee such candidate cannot resign the seat allotted.
- 11. No candidate is permitted to withdraw from the course till closure of the admissions.**
- 12. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded / adjusted to future date under any circumstances.**
- 13. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences does not entertain or support seat blocking / cancellation of MBBS seats.**
- 14. In case any student is involved in seat blocking, legal action will be initiated against such candidate as per rules. However, the University will take all the necessary precautionary steps to control the Seat Blocking.**
- 15. Decision of the Competent Authority is Final in all aspects.**

GENERAL CONVERSION PROCEDURE

MINORITY SEATS:

At first Minority seats will be exposed to Minority candidates during Stray Vacancy Round and if no eligible Minority candidates are available, then the unfilled minority seats will be converted and filled with eligible Non-Minority candidates by order of Merit and prioritized options.

Discontinuation Fee (Only after closure of admissions)

- i. Reported Candidates holding seats and who do not utilize the free exit facility after Phase-II as per the schedule notified, cannot resign the seat during the course of admissions i.e from Phase-III counselling to till closure of admissions.
- ii. As per G.O.Ms.No.72, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.15-07-2019, if any candidate wants to withdraw from the course after the closure of admissions or in the middle of the course, such candidate has to submit his/her request through the Principal of the college concerned along with course discontinuation fee online transaction receipt as follows.

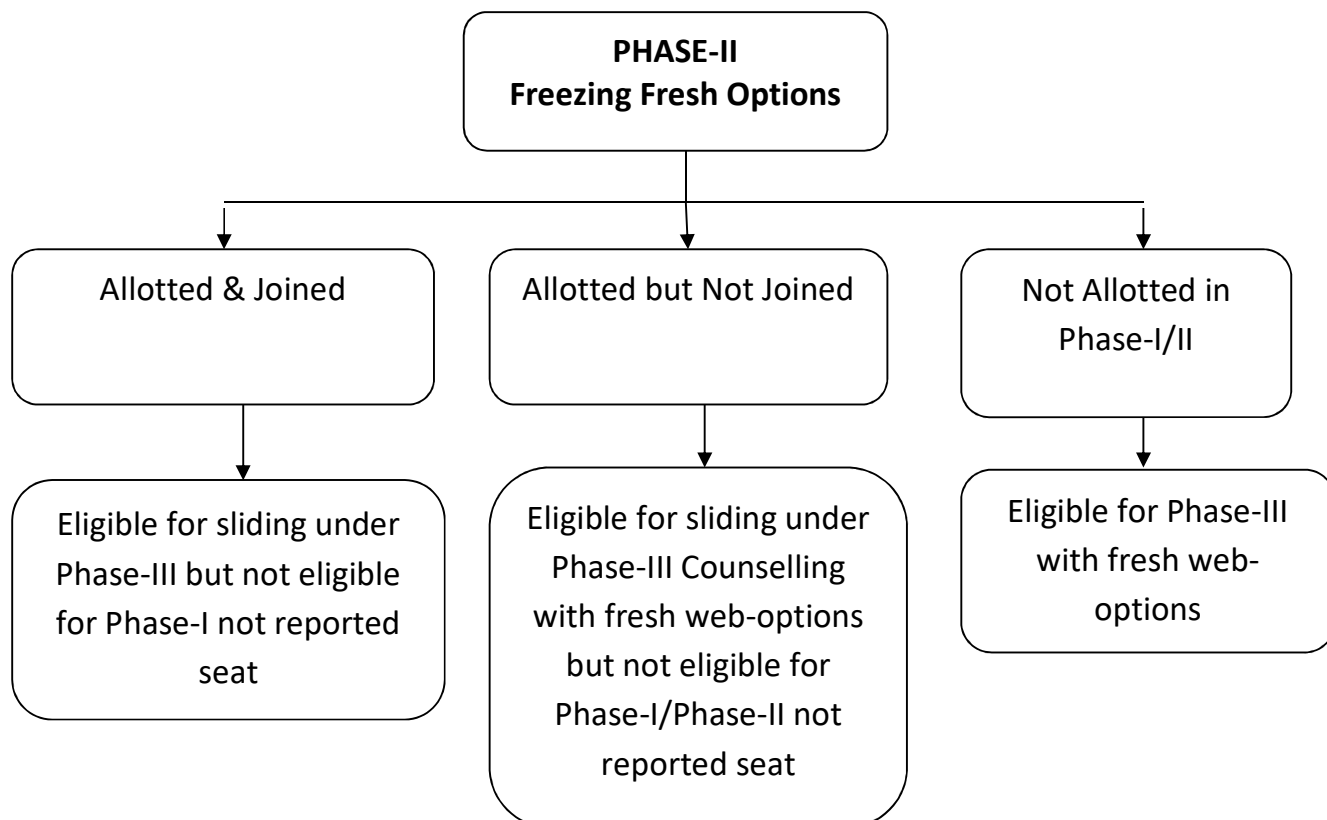
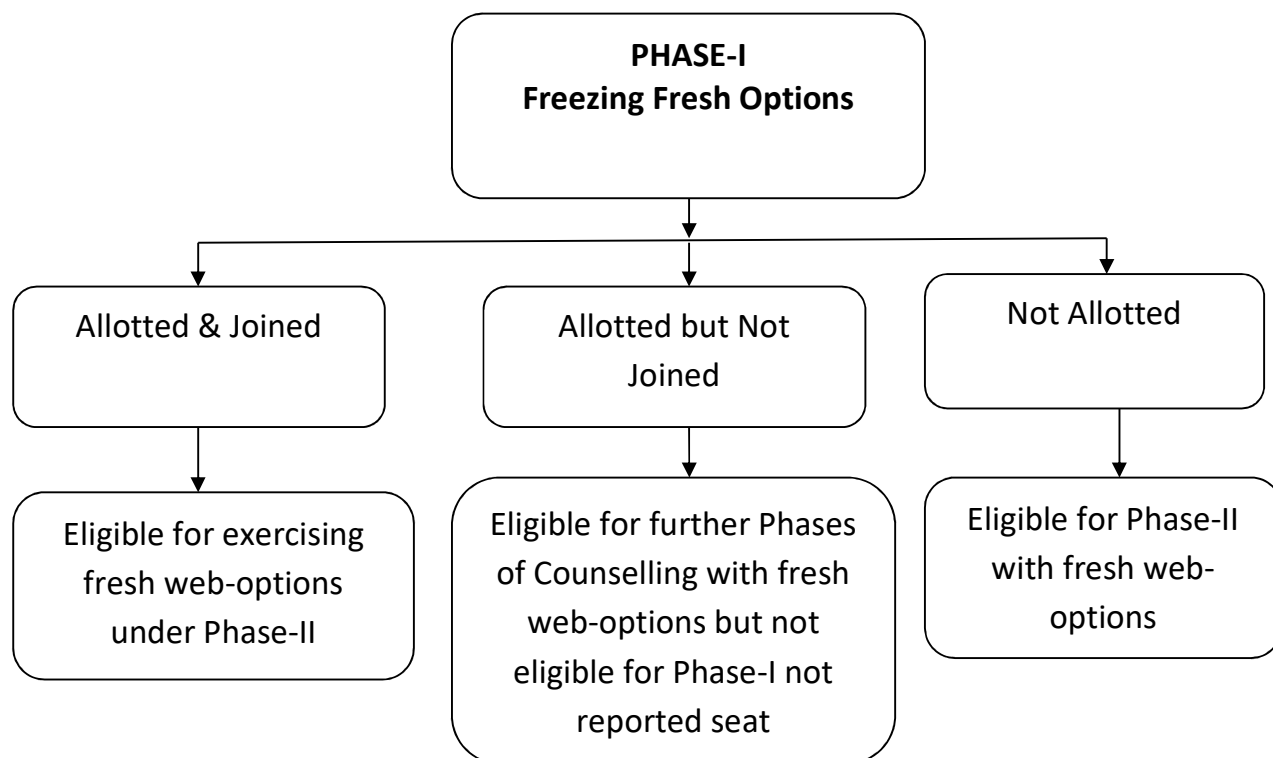

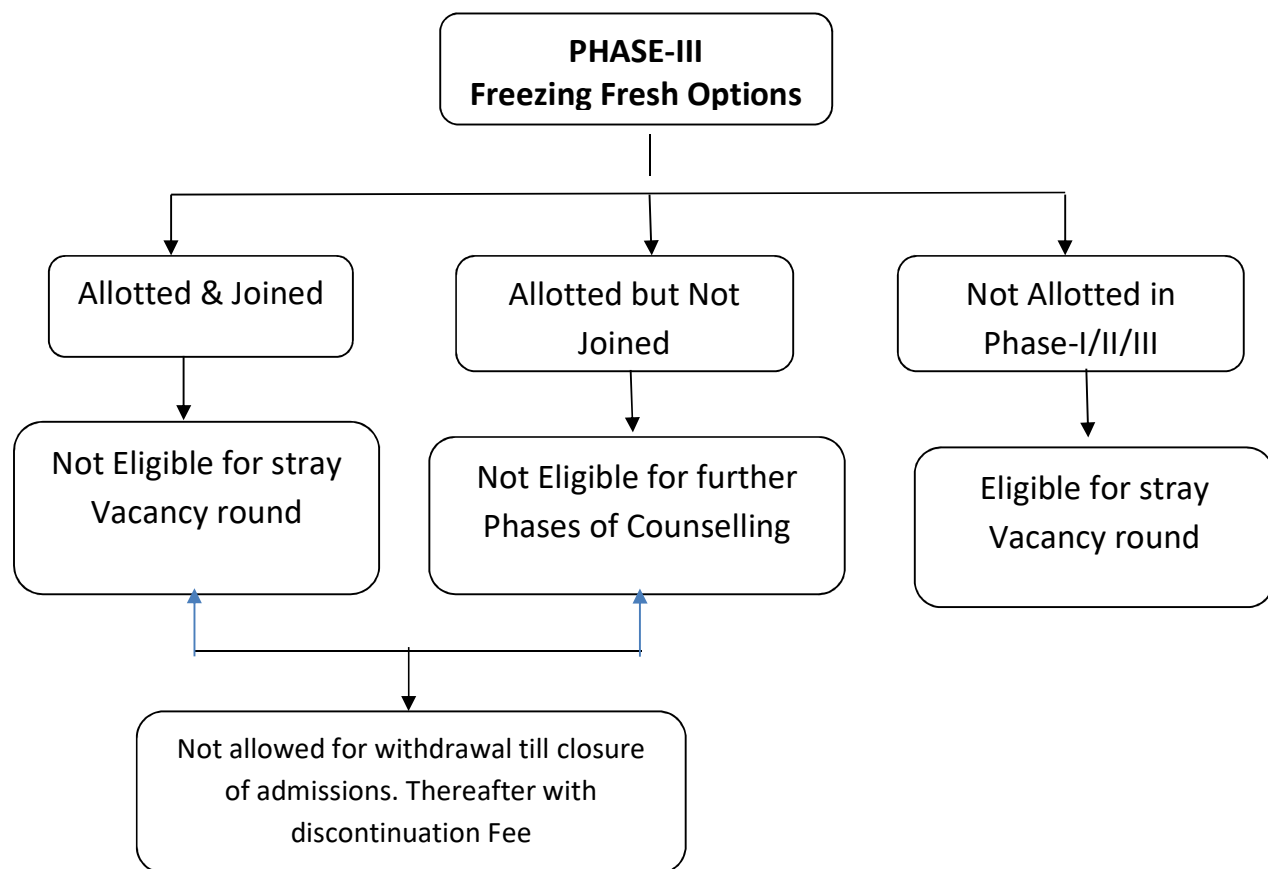
