NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB OPTIONS FOR PHASE-II COUNSELING FOR ADMISSIONS INTO THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA SEATS OF POST-GRADUATE DENTAL DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES AVAILABLE IN THE GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE NON-MINORITY DENTAL COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO Dr. NTR UHS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27.

In continuation to this Office Notifications, dt.17-08-2026 and 02-09-2026, Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada hereby notifies the schedule for exercising Web Options for Phase-II of counselling for admissions into Competent Authority Quota (CQ) PG Dental Degree/Diploma courses available in the Government and Private Non-Minority Dental Colleges under Dr. NTR UHS for the academic year 2026-27.

UNIVERSITY FEE: Selected Candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.25,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates already paid in Phase-I need not pay again.

TUITION FEE: The Following is the Tuition fee structure for the academic year 2026-27 to be payable for the Competent Authority quota seats in Private Un-aided Dental Colleges as per G.O.Rt.No.786, HM & FW (C1) Dept., dt.29-08-2026 of Government of Andhra Pradesh, and subject to the outcome of W.P.Nos.32975, 33162 & 35090 of 2022.

Instructions to Candidates:

1	The vacancies after Phase-I counselling is annexed to this notification for information of the students. The List of Not Reported Candidates after Phase-I Counselling and the list of all the eligible candidates present in the CQ Provisional Final Merit list who are only eligible to opt for Phase-II are displayed in the University Website https://drntr.uhsap.in on 11-09-2026 and on 02-09-2026 respectively.
2	Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus (placed in the University website on 17-08-2026) and the Government Orders on Rules of PG admissions available before exercising web options. Candidates are also advised to go through the details about “MRC” concept which is exemplified below: Example: a) In a particular college MDS (Conservative Dentistry) seat is under “Open Category” in the seat matrix and a SC candidate is allotted that Open Category MD (Conservative Dentistry) seat in Open Round Counselling of Phase-I as per his/her web options and NEET -MDS Rank merit order of the candidate. Now this candidate is shown as Meritorious Reserved Candidate (MRC). b) The same SC2 candidate has slide to MD (Prosthodontics) SC2 category seat in the same college or another college during the Category Round of Phase-I Counselling conducted on the same day, then that MD(Conservative Dentistry) seat vacated by this MRC candidate shall be filled with the SC2 candidates only by merit amongst them. c) This type of MRC concept is to be followed for all BC/SC/ST categories in order to maintain 50 : 50 ratio of Open : Category Reservation d) G.Os governing MRC and other regulations: 1. 3	As per G.O.Ms.No.67. dt.21-04-2017, the candidates who have discontinued the course from the academic year 2023-24 irrespective of their admission batch will be debarred for this academic year i.e., 2026-27(List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
4	a) Candidates opting for Dental Degree/Diploma courses are informed that there is no limit on the number of choices for web options. They can select any number of specialties and colleges available, provided they meet the eligibility criteria and are interested in joining. b) The candidates are advised to exercise options for all the seats in all the colleges as per their priority irrespective of vacancy position of the seats. c) Candidates while giving options should note that the seats vacated by the candidates selected in Phase-I counselling and slid to other college/course during this Phase-II of counseling process (virtual vacancies) will be added & allotted simultaneously during this Phase of counselling itself. d) Candidates are encouraged to select courses they are genuinely interested in joining, allowing the next meritorious candidates a fair opportunity. e) Candidates getting upgraded in CQ Phase 2 Shall NOT have any claim on CQ Phase 1 seat. f) If upgraded in Phase 2, the candidate must join Phase 2 seat by reporting at the allotted college.

5	Candidates are advised to exercise caution when selecting options online and to print out the saved options for their records. Candidates are encouraged to exercise options in Courses and colleges in which they are genuinely interested. If candidates are not interested in joining a particular specialty or college, they are advised not to select options for those.
6	The selected candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.25,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and report to the Principal of the Allotted College on or before the date specified in the allotment letter. University fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances. Candidates who have already paid the University fee of ₹.25,600/- do not need to pay again for downloading the Allotment Order.
7	The selected candidates shall produce all the Original certificates, pay the Tuition fee, furnish necessary bonds etc., and complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfil the criteria as per regulations to complete the admission process in the specified dates of admission, their admission will be cancelled automatically.
8	The verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission in the respective College and in case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated. If the candidate slides to other college (i.e., affiliated colleges of Dr. NTR UHS) during subsequent Phases of counselling the tuition fee will be sent to the slid college by the college concerned where the amount is held.
9	Candidates who have reported the allotted seat of Phase-I and/or Phase-II can opt for free exit as per the schedule which will be notified.
10	Eligibility for Exercising web options in Phase-II Counselling: The following candidates are eligible: a) All the candidates who have been allotted and reported to the Phase-I seat. b) All the candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Phase-I counselling. c) All candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I but not reported/not joined at the allotted colleges. However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Phase-II counselling. d) Phase-I joined/reported seat shall be the default last option e) The Joined candidates of Phase-I/Phase-II Counselling are eligible for upgradation up to Phase-III (Mop Up) round only.
11	Eligibility for Exercising web options in Phase-III (Mop Up) Counselling The following candidates are eligible: a) The Competent Authority has decided to collect a Refundable Security Deposit Amount of ₹.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) through online mode from the candidates who wishes to participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) and subsequent Phases of Counselling to avoid seat blocking. Other details will be notified in the Web Option notification of that Phase. b) All the candidates who have been allotted and reported to the Phase-I/Phase-II seat. c) All the candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling. d) All candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I/Phase-II ➤ but not reported/not joined at the allotted colleges. ➤ Joined but resigned from the allotted seat as per University Notifications for free exit. However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I/Phase-II or resigned from the joined seat of Phase-I/Phase-II, then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Phase-III/Mop Up counselling. e) Phase-I /II joined/reported seat shall be the default last option. f) The Joined candidates who are holding a seat in Phase-I or Phase-II or Phase-III(Mop Up) Counselling are not eligible for Stray or any further rounds. g) Candidates allotted a seat in Phase III (Mop-Up) cannot participate in subsequent rounds of State Counselling including Management Quota Counselling, regardless of whether they report to the allotted college.

	h) All the joined candidates of AIQ up to Round 3 counselling will be blocked for State Phase-III/Mop UP and Stray counselling of both CQ & MQ even if they have exercised web options. i) Candidates allotted/upgraded in CQ Phase-III irrespective of their reporting status will be blocked from participating in MQ Phase-III counselling, even though if they have exercised web options. j) A candidate holding a MQ seat if allotted a seat under CQ in Phase-III, they must compulsorily report. The previously held MQ seat (if any) from Phase-I/Phase-II will automatically be vacated, regardless of whether the candidate reports to the new CQ seat in Phase-III. The vacated MQ seat will be made available for allocation during MQ Phase-III Counselling. k) If a candidate is allotted a seat in Phase-III, he/she has to compulsorily report & join the allotted seat/college else the Security Deposit amount of ₹.50,000/- will be forfeited and he/she cannot participate in further rounds of counselling. l) Candidates allotted/upgraded under CQ in Phase-III shall not have any claim on the seat held in Phase-I/Phase-II either in CQ or MQ. m) PwBD Conversions will be done as per rules in Phase-III Counselling (G.O.Ms.No.44 dated 25.02.2005). n) General Conversions will be done as per rules. o) MCC of DGHS will share the data of joined candidates in Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 counsellings with all the participating States. Similarly, the participating States will also share the data of joined candidates. Candidates who have joined up to Round 3 of MCC counselling and also the allotted candidates of Stray Vacancy round of MCC counselling will be filtered and weeded out before processing for Stray Vacancy round of counselling of AP State. p) As per MCC counselling Scheme 2026, the joined candidates up to Round 3 of MCC counselling cannot upgrade or resign after Round 3. If any candidate is allotted seat in Round 3 of AIQ/Deemed/Central Quota such candidates cannot participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) or subsequent phases of State Counseling.
12	If any candidate joins allotted seat of Phase-I/II of Competent Authority Quota (CQ) seat in A.P State can slide to a seat allotted in Phase-I of Management Quota seat in AP State and in such case, the tuition fee already paid for the CQ will be returned to the candidate by the concerned college and vice versa.
13	As per G.O.Ms.No.67, dt.21-04-2017 in the final phase (Mop Up) of counselling, A candidate who exercised web options and joined in an allotted seat shall not be permitted to withdraw from the seat. Discontinuation from the course shall be permitted only after completion/closure of the counselling process as per the schedule notified by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC). In case any candidate withdraws from the allotted seat, the candidate shall be debarred for a period of three years for admission into Post Graduate Dental Degree/Diploma courses at the colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh besides payment of Rs. 3,00,000/-.
14	University fee for CQ Counselling has to paid only once initially for downloading the allotment order. The University fee and other fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
