Admission into MBBS Course under Management Quota Seats of Private Un-aided, Non-Minority and Minority Medical Colleges affiliated to Dr. YSR UHS including NRI seat in Sri Padmavathi Medical College for Women, Tirupati for the academic year 2022-23

1. Notification for Free EXIT from the Phase - I reported / joined college under Management Quota

- a. Reported/Joined candidates of Phase-I under Management Quota are permitted to exit from the reported seat on or before **4.00 P.M. on 28.11.2022** and shall submit their requests to the Principal concerned. Such candidates will not be eligible for further rounds of counselling.
- b. Reported/Joined candidates of Phase-I under Management Quota are further informed that, if any candidate allotted seat under Phase-II of Competent Authority Quota of Dr. YSR UHS should get relieved first under Management Quota along with originals on or before **4.00 P.M. on 28.11.2022** and then only should report at the allotted college of Phase-II under Competent Authority Quota as per schedule notified in the Provisional allotment order.
- c. In that situation, the Principals shall return original certificates and entire Tuition fee and other fees, if any to the candidates immediately and **shall freeze the latest data by 5.00 PM on 28.11.2022.**
- d. **Thereafter, no candidate will be permitted to withdraw from the seat under Management Quota till the closure of admissions.**
- e. Candidates who have resigned from the Phase-I reported/joined seat under Management Quota before the said date will be considered as not reported/not joined and such vacated seats will be filled in Phase-II counselling as per rules.
- f. After the said date, all Phase-I reported/joined candidates will be considered as a part of Phase-II and the Phase-II rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-II of counselling and cannot resign the seat.
- g. Phase-I Reported candidates who have not opted to free exit from the Phase-I reported seat will be considered for Phase-II of counselling and will be treated as a part of Phase-II and same rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-II of counselling and cannot resign the seat.
- h. As per the Notice 12021/01/2022-MEC, dt.12-07-2022 of DGHS, HM&FW Govt. of India, New Delhi, the joined candidates up to round 2 of AIQ or State Quota shall not be eligible to participate in the further rounds for All India Quota or for State Quota from the academic year 2022-23 onwards.

2. Discontinuation from the Course:

- a. Reported Candidates who have not utilised the free exit facility as per the schedule cannot resign the seat during the course of admissions i.e from Phase-II counselling to till closure of admissions.
- b. As per G.O.Ms.No.72, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.15-07-2019 if any candidate wants to withdraw from the course after the closure of admissions in the middle of the course such candidate has to submit his/her request through the Principal of the college concerned along with course discontinuation fee Rs.3,00,000/- for MBBS plus GST as applicable to the University by way of demand draft.
- c. The requests received directly from the candidates for withdrawal from MBBS course will not be entertained under any circumstances. Any request shall be routed through Principal concerned only as per the G.O.Ms.No.72, HM & FW (C1) Dept, dated.15-07-2019.
- d. Dr. YSR University of Health Sciences does not entertain or support seat blocking/cancellation of MBBS seats.
- e. In case any student is found involved in seat blocking, legal action will be initiated against such candidate as per rules.
