REGULATIONS:

The following are the Regulations for admissions into BAMS, BHMS and BUMS Courses in all the Ayurveda, Homoeopathy, Unani Medical Colleges under Competent Authority Quota seats i.e., the seats in Government Ayurveda, Homoeopathy & Unani Colleges and Competent Authority Seats in Private Un-aided Non-Minority Ayurveda and Homoeopathy Medical Colleges affiliated to Dr. YSR UHS for the academic year 2023-24.

1. NUMBER OF SEATS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA:

- 1.1** Total number of seats expected for the academic year 2023-24 in BAMS/BHMS and BUMS Courses at Government and Private Colleges affiliated to University under Competent Authority Quota i.e., the seats remaining after contributing 15% of seats to National Pool (AIQ) (including the Government of India Nominee seats) in Government Ayurveda and Homoeopathy Medical Colleges and Competent Authority Quota seats in Private Ayurveda and Homoeopathy Medical Colleges will be displayed before the counseling. However, the total number of seats in the affiliated colleges for the academic year 2023-24 are given Annexure-I in page No.30 (Revised on 18.10.2023). Fee structure “is” as fixed by Govt. of A.P. vide G.O.MS.No.141, HM & FW(C2) Dept. dt.31-08-2023.
- 1.2** In case any new colleges are affiliated / seats are enhanced by Ministry of AYUSH for the Academic Year 2023-24, those seats will also be filled up. NO FURTHER NOTIFICATION WILL BE ISSUED.

2. ELIGIBILITY:-

THE CANDIDATES WHO SECURED THE CUT OFF MARKS AND MORE IN THE NEET-UG, 2023 CONDUCTED BY NATIONAL TESTING AGENCY AND FULFILL THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA ARE ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION INTO **BAMS, BHMS & BUMS** COURSES HAVE TO SUBMIT THEIR ONLINE APPLICATION BY PAYING THE NON-REFUNDABLE APPLICATION AND PROCESSING FEE THROUGH ONLINE AND UPLOAD THE SCANED CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR **COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA**.

- i. The candidate must have passed intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination recognized by the concerned State Government and Education Board with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually.
- ii. Minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of General category.
- iii. 40% Marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes.
- iv. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years as on **31st December, 2023**. Further, there is no upper age limit.
- v. The other rules and regulations that are applicable for UG AYUSH course will be applicable to BHMS, BAMS & BUMS courses. For further information, check the University website for prospectus of UG AYUSH courses notified on **16.10.2023**.
- vi. In respect of persons with disability candidate specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination are as follows: a) In Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be 45% in the case of General Category. b) 40% in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes. (for PWD candidates only).

For PwD candidates, PwD certificate should be as per the Guidelines issued by Central Government and notified by the NCISM/NCH, (available on counseling website namely www.aaccc.gov.in under FAQs).

2.1 The candidates should secure the following cut-off scores in National Eligibility - cum- Entrance Test (NEET) UG -2023, conducted by NATIONAL TESTING AGENCY, New Delhi as per section (10) of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

2.2 The candidate should be an Indian National and should satisfy the Local or Non-local status in Andhra Pradesh (Residence requirement) as laid down in Andhra Pradesh Education Institutions (Regulations of Admissions) Order, 1974. Selection will be done as per the procedure laid down in the G.O.P.No.646, dated 10.07.1979 as amended in G.O.Ms.No.42, Higher Education (EC2) Department, dated. 18.05.2009.

2.3 FOR ADMISSION INTO **BAMS COURSES:**

The candidate must have passed intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination recognized by the concerned State Government and Education Board with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtained minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of general category and 40% marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes.

2.4 FOR ADMISSION INTO **BHMS COURSES:**

- 1) The candidate must have passed in the intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination recognized by the concerned State Government and Education Board with subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English and individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology at the qualifying Examinations mentioned above for OC candidates and 40% marks in respect of SC/ST/BCs;
(or)
- 2) The intermediate examination in science of an Indian University or Board or other recognized examining body with Physics, Chemistry and Biology which shall include a practical test in these subjects and also English as a compulsory subject;
(or)
- 3) the pre-professional or pre-medical examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology, after passing either the higher secondary school examination, or the pre-university or an equivalent Examination, which shall include a practical test in Physics, Chemistry and Biology and also English as a compulsory subject;
(or)
- 4) the first year of the three years' degree course of a recognized University, with Physics, Chemistry and Biology including a practical test in these subjects provided the examination is a University Examination and candidate has passed 10+2 with English at a level not less than a core course;
(or)

- 5) any other examination which, in scope and standard is found to be equivalent to the intermediate science examination of an Indian University or Board, taking Physics, Chemistry and Biology including practical test in each of these subjects and English as a compulsory subject.

2.5 FOR ADMISSION INTO BUMS COURSE:

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION AS PER REGULATIONS of National Commission of Indian system of Medicine, F.No.11-76/2021-BUMS (Unani- UG-Regln.) dated 28.02.2022.

- a) **Admissions to Kamil-E-TIB-Wa-Jarahat course:** A candidate seeking admission to main **Kamil-E-Tib-Wa-Jarahat** (Bachelor of Unani Medicine and Surgery –B.U.M.S.) Course must have passed.
- b) The candidate shall have pass Intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination from any recognized by the concerned State Government and Education Board with subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtained minimum 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of general category and 40% marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes:
- c) Candidate shall have passed Urdu or Arabic or Persian language as on the subject in the 10th standard or in 12th standard.
- d) Candidate who is not covered under clause (b) shall have to study Urdu language along with Arabic and Mantiq Wa-Falsafa (Logic and Philosophy) as a subject during the First professional B.U.M.S session.
- e) The syllabus is applicable to the students admitted in the academic year session 2021-22 on wards 5 years or until further notification by NCISM, whichever is earlier (Ref.11-79/2020-Unani (U. G. Syllabus) dt.29.03.2021.

Provided that in respect of Persons with Disability (PwD) candidates specified under the rights of persons with disabilities act, 2016 (49 of 2016) the minimum qualifying marks in the said examinations shall be 45% in the case general category and 40% in the case of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes.

2.6 AGE:

1. The candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on 31-12-2023.
2. The candidates **who do not complete 17 years as on 31-12-2023 are not eligible.**

2.7 ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS IN RESPECT OF CANDIDATES WHOSE DOMICILE OF ANDHRA PRADESH / TELANGANA

2.7.1 The candidate shall satisfy Local / Non local status as per GO.No.646 Edn. (W1) department dated 10-07-1979 and Presidential order. The procedure indicated in the above G.O. for selection of candidates as amended in G.O.Ms.No.42, Higher Education (EC2) Dept., dated 18-05-2009 shall be followed.

The Non local candidates are eligible for 15% unreserved seats only. The local candidates are also eligible for 15% unreserved seats.

2.7.2 The verification fee and registration fee once paid will not be refunded or not adjusted to a future date. Therefore, candidates are advised to check eligibility conditions thoroughly before applying for Competent Authority seats.

3. RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES:

3.1 Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in favour of the local candidates in relation to the local area as provided in A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974 for Non-State-Wide courses as given in Annexure-III of GO (P) No. 646, Edu. (W1) Department, dt.10-7-1979.

3.2 LOCAL AREA:

3.2.1 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam shall be regarded as the local area for the purpose of admission to the Andhra University, **(Nagarjuna University) and to any other education institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

3.2.2 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Adilabad, Hyderabad, Rangareddy, Karimnagar, Khammam, Mahbubnagar, Medak, Nalgonda, Nizamabad and Warangal shall be regarded as local area for the purpose of admission to the Osmania University, ** (the Kakatiya University) and to any other educational institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

3.2.3 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Anantapur, Kadapa, Kurnool, Chittoor and Nellore shall be regarded as local area for the purpose of admission to Sri Venkateswara University and to any other educational institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

3.3 LOCAL CANDIDATES:

3.3.1 A Candidate for admission shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area.

i) If he/she studied in an Educational Institution or Educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination. (or)

ii) Where during the whole or any part of the 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in Educational Institutions, if he/she had resided in that local area for a period of not less than 4 years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination, in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared. (or)

iii) Local Status Certificate issued by MRO for claiming as AP local as per Circular Nos. 4136/SPF&MC/2015-5, dated.08.08.2016, 4136/SPF&MC/2015-13, dated. 20.11.2017 & G.O.Ms.No.129, dt: 28-10-2019 of General Administration Dept.

3.3.2 A candidate who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub-regulation (3.4.1) Above in relation to any local area shall.

i) If he/she has studied in educational institutions **in the State for a period of not less than 7 consecutive academic years ending with academic years** in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as local candidate in relation to:

a) Such local area where he/she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.

b) Where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has last studied in such equal periods. (or)

ii) If during the whole or any part of the seven consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in the educational institution in any local area, but he/she has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of

7 years be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:

- a) Such local area where he/she has resided for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.
- (or)
- b) Where the period of his/her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has resided last in such equal periods.

3.4 The following categories of candidates are eligible under 15% of the available seats, i.e., Un-reserved, in terms of the Presidential order:

(i) All local candidates defined in the Presidential order.

(ii) Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside -the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the State;(Annexure III (a) – for student) & Annexure – III(b) -Parent Resident).

(iii) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporation Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-Public Institution within the State; and (Annexure – III (c)).

(iv) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies Universities and educational institutions recognized by the Government or a University or Other competent authority and similar other quasi-Government institutions within the State. (Annexure – III (c)).

N.B.: The Scanned copies of relevant certificates must be uploaded for verification along with online application. In respect of residence certificate, the certificate should be obtained from the Revenue authorities clearly specifying the years.

4. RESERVATIONS:

Reservation for Scheduled Castes (S.C) and Scheduled Tribes (S.T):

A) Out of the seats available for admission by the University, 15% seats shall be reserved for candidates belonging to SC, 6% of seats shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes in each local area.

- i) In the event that if any seats reserved for S.T. not being filled up, they will be open to the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and vice-versa.
- ii) In the event of the candidates from the SC and ST are not being available, these seats shall be allotted to the candidates under open competition.
- iii) Candidates of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes belonging to the State of Andhra Pradesh only which are specified by the Govt. of A.P from time to time shall be considered

B) RESERVATION FOR BACKWARD CLASSES (B.C):

29% of the available seats for admission in each local area by the University for shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Backward Classes as follows:

BC-A -7%, BC-B-10%, BC-C-1%, BC-D-7% & BC-E*-4% (* Subject to further orders of the Government of A.P. / High Court).

If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Class of particular group are not available, the leftover seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them the left-over seats shall be treated as Open Competition seats and shall be filled up with candidates by merit.

Note :- The Social Reservation provided for BC's, SC's, ST's in the ratio of 29%, 15% and 6% respectively shall be vertical reservation.

C) RESERVATION FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTIONS (EWS):

The reservation of 10% in favour of Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates who are not covered under existing scheme of reservation for SC/ST & BCs will be made as per the procedure/ guidelines issued by the Government of AP in the Government Ayurveda & Homoeo. Medical Colleges where additional seats are permitted by AYUSH/ Govt. of India for the purpose. The persons seeking the benefit of reservation under EWS category shall obtain the Income & Asset Certificate for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) valid for the year 2023-24 issued by the Tahsildar on or after 01.04.2023 pertaining to AP- Non State wide Institutions and Tahsildars of AP & Telangana pertaining to State wide Institutions.

D) RESERVATION FOR WOMEN CANDIDATES: 33 1/3% of seats are reserved for women candidates which are horizontal reservation.

5. SOCIAL STATUS CERTIFICATE:

The candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall furnish a certificate in the prescribed proforma in support of their claims. The social status of Schedule Castes,

Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes candidates shall be Scrutinized in terms of G.O.M.s.No.58, SW (J) Dept. Dt. 12-05-1997.

The candidates are informed that they will not be considered for the caste claimed by them unless they upload the latest **Integrated Community Certificate with barcode**, prescribed by the Government and issued by the Revenue Authorities (Vide G.O.Ms.No.58, Social Welfare (J) Department, dated. 12-05-1997) with barcode. (Annexure-II).

6. RESERVATIONS UNDER THE SPECIAL CATEGORIES, i.e. CAP/NCC/PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED (PwD) FOR ADMISSION INTO AYUSH (BAMS, BHMS & BUMS) COURSES

6.1 Seats shall be reserved in each course and in each category for the following to the extent indicated against them:

S.No.	Category	% of reservation	Authority for Scrutiny and confirmation
1.	CAP (Army)	1 %	Director, Sainik Welfare Dept., AP.
2.	National Cadet Corps	1 %	Director of NCC, AP.
3.	Physically Challenged (PwD)	5 %	Medical Board constituted by the competent Authority.

6.2 The reservation for Special categories mentioned above shall be provided on the basis of compartmentalized horizontal reservation for each category of OC, BC, SC and ST's as per the G.O.Ms.No.131, Health Medical and Family Welfare (R.2) Department, dated 25.04.2008.

NOTE:

- a) The reservation of seats under above special category are subject to the availability of seats in each category as the number of available seats in the BAMS, BHMS, BUMS Courses are very less.
- b) The Reservation for Special categories mentioned above shall be provided on the basis of compartmentalized horizontal reservation for each category of OC, BC, SC and ST's.
- c) The Reservations and priorities in respect of the above categories will be as per the Government orders and subsequent amendments issued from time to time in the respective categories.
- d) The guidelines of Govt. of India and Regulations of Ministry of AYUSH/NCISM/NCH shall be observed in making admissions of persons with disabilities (PwD) candidates.
- e) The Medical Board constituted by the Competent Authority will examine and assess the percentage of disability of differently abled candidates, who have applied seeking admission under PwD quota. The report of the Medical Board is final for considering a candidate under PwD quota as per rules.
- f) The genuineness of the Original Certificates of the candidates claiming reservation under Special Category i.e. CAP & NCC will be scrutinized and confirmed by the officials of the concerned Departments after Certificates Verification. The Merit list / Priority wise list submitted by the Concerned Authorities after Scrutiny and Confirmation is final, basing on which the selections into UG AYUSH Courses under the Special Categories will be made by the University.

7. APPLICATIONS THROUGH ONLINE:

7.1 The on-line application form for determining merit position for Competent Authority Quota seats using NEET UG-2023 scores will be available on the website <https://ugayushcq.ysruhs.com> from **11.00 AM on 17-10-2023 to upto 05.00 PM on 21.10.2023.**

Note: The candidates are advised to take a print out of the Prospectus / Instructions from the website <https://drysr.uhsap.in> or <https://ugayushcq.ysruhs.com> and verify the Eligibility under Local/ Non-local category for Competent Authority Quota Seats before proceeding to fill the application form.

7.2 The candidate should fill the online application form available in the Website with the data required-for and upload the scanned Certificates/Documents in support of their claim through internet. The online application form can be filled through any computer with internet connection (home/internet cafe/net center).

The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after going through the Prospectus by keeping all the Certificates ready to enter the correct data and uploading of the scanned copies of certificates/documents, photo and signature after payment of fee through online.

2. University Fee:

All the selected candidates have to pay the University fee of Rs.8,600/- at the time of downloading allotment order through Online. **University Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.**

The counseling for admission will be made to the colleges affiliated for the year 2023-24 and subject to receipt of fee structure G.O. from the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh.

8.2 The candidate should sign at the declaration area in the printout of the only application form and submit at the time of joining at the allotted college. **The candidates need not submit printout of application by post/by hand to the university.**

THE REGULATIONS FOR RE-ADMISSION AFTER BREAK OF STUDY FOR ALL THE UNDERGRADUATE AND POST GRADUATE DEGREE / DIPLOMA COURSES IN MEDICAL, DENTAL, INDIAN MEDICINE AND HOMOEOPATHY AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES OFFERED BY Dr. YSR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, VIJAYAWADA.

The regulation is subject to modification from time to time. In Annexure - II.

DEFINITIONS:

Break of study means any absence more than 3 months during the course of study.

- i. 3 months for this purpose is a period of 90 days (ninety days) to be recorded from the date of absence irrespective of the number of days in one calendar month.
- ii. For all practical purpose only two types of break of study is allowed.
 - a. Less than 3 months of break (as per definition)
 - b. More than 3 months of break but less than the twice the number of years of study of a particular course.
Ex: For MBBS/BDS twice the number of years of study is 9 years
For B.Sc. (Nursing) / Physiotherapy is 8 years.
- iii. If the candidate is on Break of study for two spells in an academic year of a particular course the candidate is deemed to have been discharged from the course of study. **One cannot apply for condonation of the break.**
- iv. **Only two spells of break of study** for the entire duration of the course is permitted. During second spell of break of study, even if the break of study is less than **90** days, permission must be obtained from the university and that spell of Break shall also be counted as second spell of break.
- v. For less than three months of break, the Principal/ Dean of the college can permit to rejoin in to the course under intimation to the university.
- vi. If the break of study is more than three months the candidate has to apply to the university through the Principal/Dean of the college. The University can give permission to the candidate to complete the course within **twice the years of the study** of the particular course.

Example 1: B.Sc. Nursing student discontinues after 2 years of study and wants to join. The course after 2 years of absence from study may be permitted to rejoin into the course since the candidate has 2 years of study to complete. If the candidate discontinues the course after 2 years of the study and wants to continue after 5 years of absence the candidate will not be permitted to continue the course since student will be finishing only after twice the number of years of the course (2 years of study + 5years of absence + remaining 2 years of the study) makes the student study for 9 years whereas according to the regulation students should not exceed twice the number of years of study in 8 years.

Example 2: MBBS. Student discontinue after 3 years of study want to join the course after 3 years of absence from study may be permitted to join into the course since the candidate have 1½year of study to complete. If the candidate discontinues the course after the 3 years of the study wants to continue after 5 years absence, the candidate will not be permitted to continue the course since, will be finishing only after twice the number of years of the course.

PROCEDURE FOR REJOINING:

(i) The candidate having a break of study for more than three months but less than twice the years of the course shall apply for re-admission into the course in the prescribed form as in **Annexure III** by remitting the stipulated fee for condonation of Break of Study to the University Request to readmission: -

The Principal shall forward the application with specific remarks about the absence period and with an undertaking from the student that he/she is not involved in criminal cases during the absence period.

If any candidate is permitted by the Dean / Principal of the college concerned without the prior permission from this university, the re-admission to the course after **the break of study the period of such study shall not be considered as a recognized study and the candidate shall not be permitted to write the university examination based on such study Period.**

When the candidate is readmitted into the course and shall after fulfillment of the Regulations of this university to the course concerned be admitted to the examinations.

- ii) The period of break of study of the candidate for rejoining into the course shall be calculated from the date of first discontinuance of the course.
- iii) Only two spells of break of study will be allowed for the entire duration of the course.
- iv) If the name of the candidate has been registered in this University on the particular course of study but the candidate has not appeared for the university examination and subsequently if the candidate has entered on Break of Study for more than two years the candidate shall start the course afresh as Dr. YSR UHS regulations.
- v) If the candidate has not completed the course beyond twice the year of duration of course of study shall be discharged from the course immediately. This is applicable for all the years of study of Under graduate degree courses.
