Admission into MBBS Course under Competent Authority Quota Seats
for the academic year 2023-24

1. Notification for Free EXIT from the Phase - I reported / joined college

- a. In continuation to this office earlier notification dated.23.08.2023, Reported/Joined candidates of Phase-I are permitted to exit from the reported seat on or before **3.00 P.M. on 10.09.2023** and shall submit their requests to the Principal concerned. Such candidates will not be eligible for further rounds of counselling.
- b. In that situation, the Principals shall return original certificates and entire Tuition fee and other fees, if any to the candidates immediately and shall freeze the latest data by 4.00 PM on 10.09.2023.
- c. **Thereafter, no candidate will be permitted to withdraw from the seat till the closure of admissions.**
- d. Candidates who have resigned from the Phase-I reported/joined seat before the said date will be considered as not reported/not joined and such vacated seats will be filled in Phase-II counselling as per rules.
- e. After the said date, all Phase-I reported/joined candidates will be considered as a part of Phase-II and the Phase-II rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-II of counselling and cannot resign the seat.
- f. Phase-I Reported candidates who have not opted to exit from the Phase-I reported seat will be considered for Phase-II of counselling for upgradation/sliding as per the one-time options already exercised and will be considered as a part of Phase-II and same rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-II of counselling and cannot resign the seat.
- g. As per the orders dated.22.07.2022 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Contempt Petition (C) No.289 of 2022, the joined candidates up to round 2 of AIQ or State Quota shall not be eligible to participate in the further rounds for All India Quota or for State Quota from the academic year 2022-23 onwards.

2. Discontinuation from the Course:

- a. Reported Candidates who have not utilised the free exit facility as per the schedule cannot resign the seat during the course of admissions i.e from Phase-II counselling to till closure of admissions.
- b. As already notified, "Once a candidate secures admission to a particular college / course based on his / her option in the 1st counseling, such candidate shall be allowed for sliding for admission into other college / course in the 2nd counseling. No more claims to admission into other colleges / course be entertained after 2nd counseling during that academic year". (G.O.Ms.No.71, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated 15.07.2019 & G.O.Ms.No.72, HM&FW(C1) Dept., dated 15.07.2019 of Govt. of Andhra Pradesh).
