Notification for Free EXIT from the Phase - I reported / joined college

Admission into MBBS Course, 2023-24 under the following categories

- 1) **Competent Authority (Self-financing) seats and Competent Authority (NRI Category) seats in new Government Medical Colleges permitted from the academic Year 2023-24 onwards,**
- 2) **Management Quota [(Category-B1, B2 and Category-C(NRI)] seats in Private Un-aided Non-Minority and Minority Medical Colleges and Dental Colleges affiliated to Dr. YSRUHS**
- 3) **NRI Category seats in Sri Padmavathi Medical College for Women (Under SVIMS), Tirupati.**

- a. In continuation to this office earlier notification dated.30.08.2023, Reported/Joined candidates of Phase-I under the above category of seats are permitted to exit from the reported seat on or before 03.00 P.M. on 10.09.2023 and shall submit their requests to the Principal concerned. Such candidates will not be eligible for further rounds of counselling.
- b. In that situation, the Principals shall return original certificates and entire Tuition fee and other fees, if any to the candidates immediately and **shall freeze the latest data by 04.00 PM on 10.09.2023.**
- c. **Thereafter, no candidate will be permitted to withdraw from the seat under Management Quota till the closure of admissions.**
- d. Instructions will be issued separately regarding Reported/Joined candidates of Phase-I under the above category of seats and later, if any candidate allotted seat under Phase-II of Competent Authority Quota (Convenor) of Dr. YSR UHS.
- e. Candidates who have resigned from the Phase-I reported/joined seat under this notification before the said date will be considered as not reported/not joined and such vacated seats will be filled in Phase-II counselling as per rules.
- f. After the said date, all Phase-I reported/joined candidates will be considered as a part of Phase-II and the Phase-II rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-II of counselling and cannot resign the seat.
- g. Phase-I Reported candidates who have not opted to free exit from the Phase-I reported seat will be considered for Phase-II of counselling and will be treated as a part of Phase-II and same rules will apply on them as applicable for Phase-II of counselling and cannot resign the seat.
- h. "Once a candidate secures admission to a particular college / course based on his / her option in the 1st counseling, such candidate shall be allowed for sliding for admission into other college / course in the 2nd counseling. No more claims to admission into other colleges / course be entertained after 2nd counseling during that academic year". (G.O.Ms.No.71, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated 15.07.2019 & G.O.Ms.No.72, HM&FW(C1) Dept., dated 15.07.2019 of Govt. of Andhra Pradesh).

2. Discontinuation from the Course:

- a. Reported Candidates who have not utilised the free exit facility as per the schedule cannot resign the seat during the course of admissions i.e from Phase-II counselling to till closure of admissions.
- b. As per G.O.Ms.No.72, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.15-07-2019 if any candidate wants to withdraw from the course after the closure of admissions in the middle of the course such candidate has to submit his/her request through the Principal of the college concerned along with course discontinuation fee Rs.3,00,000/- for MBBS plus GST as applicable to the University by way of demand draft.
- c. The requests received directly from the candidates for withdrawal from MBBS course will not be entertained under any circumstances. Any request shall be routed through Principal concerned only as per the G.O.Ms.No.72, HM & FW (C1) Dept, dated.15-07-2019.
- d. Dr. YSR University of Health Sciences does not entertain or support seat blocking/ cancellation of MBBS seats.
- e. In case any student is found involved in seat blocking, legal action will be initiated against such candidate as per rules.
