PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION INTO MD/MS (AYURVEDA) COURSES

REGULATIONS:

The following are the regulations for admission into MD/MS (Ayurveda) courses available at the colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, A.P., Vijayawada for the academic year 2024-25.

1. NUMBER OF SEATS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA:

The number of seats available in MD/MS (Ayurveda) courses in each college for the academic year **2024-25** are as follows:

- a. The admission procedure as per G.O.Ms. No.13 and any other orders of Govt. from time to time.
- b. 15% of seats from each specialty and each college are surrendered to All India Quota from the above intake.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

THE CANDIDATES WHO FULFILL THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA ARE ELIGIBLE

2.1 As per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India the students who secured the below noted minimum marks or above in All India AYUSH Post Graduates Test (AIAPGET) 2024 and applied to the University are only eligible for admission into MD/MS (Ayurveda) courses 2024-25.

2.2 Eligibility criteria for admission in to Postgraduate programme shall be the following, namely:-

- (a) A graduate of Ayurvedacharya Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery from a recognized Institution;
- (b) Registered medical practitioner, registered in State or Union territory or Central register;
- (c) Qualified in Postgraduate National Entrance Test.
- 2.3 The candidates should have completed internship by $\underline{31.07.2024}$ and they shall submit a Certificate to that effect.
- 2.4. Candidates who are already admitted and studying MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses are not eligible for admission into MD/MS (Ayurveda) course unless they discontinue the course by remitting the bond amount and the stipend taken upto that date before submitting application form and such candidates shall submit the discontinuance certificate issued by the Head of the Institution along with the application.
- 2.5 Candidates who are already holding a Post Graduate Degree in Ayurveda in a subject shall not be eligible for admission into another PG Ayurveda Courses.
- 2.6. No Authority of Institution shall admit any candidate to the Postgraduate courses in contravention of the criteria of procedure in respect of admission, and any admissions made in contravention shall be cancelled by the NCISM/NCH.
- 2.7 Any admissions made beyond/over and above the intake capacity sanctioned/permitted by MARBISM/NCISM/MARBH/NCH/Goi for the said academic session shall not be approved.
- 2.8 NCISM shall not approve admissions made without the original documents of the candidates.
- 2.9 Admissions shall not be approved by any means after the cut-off date and time for admission as specified by NCISM/NCH.
- 2.10 No authority has the power to extend or modify the cut-off date of admission specified by NCISM/NCH and such admission shall not be approved.
- 2.11 No authority has the power to modify the intake capacity for admission into PG coruses in ASU&H colleges sanctioned by MARBISM/MARBH/NCISM/NCH.
- 2.12 For other eligibility conditions, registration fee, counselling rules and procedure to submit the online application please download and read the Prospectus and User Manual displayed on the University website.
- 2.13 Candidates are advised to visit the University website for all further notifications/latest updates/circulars/allotments on MD/MS (Ayurveda) Admissions till the closure of admissions. No individual communications will be sent

3. RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES:

Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in favour of the local candidates in relation to the local area as provided in A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974.

4. LOCAL AREA:

The part of the State comprising the Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam,
4.1 East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam shall be regarded as the local area in respect of the Andhra University and the Nagarjuna University area.

4.2 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Anantapur, Kurnool, Chittoor, Kadapa and Nellore shall be regarded as local area in respect of S.V. University area and the Sri Krishnadevaraya University area.

5. LOCAL CANDIDATES:

5.1

5.2

- A candidate for admission to any course of study shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area.
 - i) If he/she has studied in an educational institution(s) in such local area for a period of not less than four consecutive academic year ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination
 - A candidate for admission to any course of study who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub regulation 3 above in relation to any local area shall:
 - If he / she has studied in an educational institution in the state for a period of not less than seven (7) consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:
 - a) Such local area where he/she studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years;
 - b) Where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he /she studied last in such equal periods;

(or)

- If during the whole or any part of the 7 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, if he/she has not studied in the educational institution in any local area, but he/she has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of not less than four years be regarded as a local candidate in relation to
- a) Such local area where he/she resided for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years;
- b) Where the period of his/her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she resided last in such equal periods;

(or)

 Local status certificate issued by MRO for claiming as AP local as per Circular Nos.4136/SPF&MC/2015-5, dated.08.08.2016 and 4136/SPF&MC/2015-13, dt. 20.11.2017

5.3. EXPLANATIONS: For the Purpose of this regulation.

- i) "Educational Institutions" means a university or any educational institution recognized as such by the State Government, a University or other authority competent in that behalf:
- ii) "Relevant qualifying examination" in relation to admission to any course of study, means the examination, a pass in which the minimum educational qualification for admission to such course of study.
- **NOTE:** The relevant qualifying examination for admission to Doctor of Medicine (Ayurveda) being Bachelor of Ayurveda Medicine and Surgery examination, the question whether a candidate is a local candidate or not shall be determined with reference to his/her first appearance in the Bachelor of Ayurveda Medicine and Surgery examination.

- a) In reckoning the consecutive academic years during which a candidate has studied any period of interruption of his/her study by a reason of his/her failure to pass any examination shall be disregarded.
 - b) Any period of his/her study in a State-wide University or a State-wide educational institution shall be disregarded
- iv) The question whether any candidate for admission into any course of study has resided in any local area shall be determined with reference to the places where the candidate actually resided and not with reference to the residence of his/her parent or guardian.
- **5.4.** If a local candidate in respect of a local area is not available to fill up any seat reserved or allotted in favour of local candidate in respect of that local area, such seat shall be filled as if it had not been reserved.

5.5. The following categories of candidates are eligible to apply for admission to the remaining 15% of AP Unreserved seats.

As per Memo No.2459247/C1/2024, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.20-07-2024 Govt. of A.P., it is hereby clarified that all the 15% of the Unreserved seats in Medical/ Dental colleges are now reserved exclusively for the Local candidates from the Andhra and Rayalaseema regions.

- i) All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates of two local areas of State of Andhra Pradesh.
- ii) Candidates, who have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State, or either of whose parents have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the state.
- iii) Candidates who are children of parents who are in employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions other similar quasi Public Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- iv) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, public sector corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or University or other Competent Authority and similar quasi Government Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh."
- **Note:** Relevant scanned original certificates must be uploaded along with application in respect of their claim for 15% Unreserved seats. In respect of proof of 10 years residence, the certificate should be obtained from the Revenue Authorities and the issuing Officer shall not be below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar.

6. Service Weightage:

6.1 The service candidate shall be awarded extra weightage of marks on length and type of service as follows as on <u>30.09.2024</u>.

Rural service - 8% per each year upto maximum of 3 years.

Tribal service - 10% per each year upto maximum of 3 years.

- 6.2. An in-service candidate is one who has put in a minimum of three years of regular Service in Rural & Tribal areas.
- 6.3. Those in-service candidates who are having the remaining service of a minimum of eight (8) years as on the date of admission are only eligible to apply for the said seats.
- 6.4 No upper age limit is specified for admission to MD/MS Ayurveda Courses.

7. RESERVATION:

7.1 Seats of Post Graduate MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses are reserved for SC, ST and BC and BC sub groups as detailed below, which are called vertical reservations.

7.2 CERTIFICATION OF CASTE CATEGORY:

- 7.2.1 Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Backward Class candidates shall in support of their claim, have to furnish latest Integrated Caste Certificate with Barcode obtained from Government of AP/Telangana in the prescribed form issued by the Concerned Authority. If the certificate is not in the prescribed form, candidates will not be considered for selection under the reserved quota.
- 7.2.2 Caste certificates of other States will not be accepted & in such cases the applied candidate will be considered under General category only.
- 7.2.3 The social status of the candidates who have applied for the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall be scrutinized in terms of G.O.Ms.No.58 SW (J) Dept, dated.12-5-1997.
- 7.2.4 In case of Minority candidates, the Minority certificate issued by Minorities Welfare Department, Government of AP to be furnished in support of their claim

7.3. RESERVATION FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTIONS (EWS):

The reservation of 10% in favour of Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates who are not covered under existing scheme of reservation for SC/ST & BCs will be made as per the procedure/ guidelines issued by the Government of AP in the Government Medical Colleges where additional seats are permitted by Govt. of India for the purpose. The persons seeking the benefit of reservation under EWS category shall obtain the Income & Asset Certificate for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) valid for the academic year 2024-25 issued by the Tahsildar on or after **01.04.2024**, who is the competent authority in state.

8. Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD):

- 8.1 Out of the available seats for admission by the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, 5% shall be reserved for the Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) in each categories of OC, SC, ST, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D and BC-E as per Government of India guidelines as per the availability of seats.
- 8.2 The candidates seeking the benefit of reservation under PwBD category should enclose a valid disability certificate issued not later than three months (03) prior to submitting his/her application.
- 8.3 The Medical Board constituted by the University will scrutinize/verify the disability certificates as per G.O. MS.No.31, Women development, Child welfare & disabled welfare (DW) department, dated.01.12.2009 and candidates claiming reservation under PwBD quota for conformation of eligibility and the decision of Medical Board specially constituted for the purpose is final and binding on the candidates.
- 8.4 The Medical Board constituted by the University will scrutinize/verify the disability certificates as per the NCISM/Ministry of Ayush, New Delhi Guidelines regarding admission of students with "Specified Disabilities" under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 with respect to admission in MD (AYURVEDA) Courses.



11. FEE STRUCTURE:

11.1 TUITION FEE:

The selected candidates have to pay tuition fee and other constituent fee, special fee and caution money deposits at the rates laid down for the purpose from time to time subject to the conditions laid therein at the time of admission. The regulations governing the same will be informed.

11.2 UNIVERSITY FEE:

All the selected candidates shall pay the following fee through payment Gateway by using online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking).

The fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

12. VERIFICATION OF CERTIFICATES:

12.1 The eligibility of a candidate will be verified basing on the uploaded copies of scanned certificates/ documents.

The candidates who are claiming reservation under Special Categories i.e., PwBD, have to watch the university website for further notifications, if any, for scrutiny of original certificates of respective special category.

Note: The candidature of the applicant will not be considered for admission into MD/MS (Ayurveda) courses if not submitted the online application by uploading the scanned copies of required certificates/documents as per regulations.

The eligibility and community verification will be done basing on the uploaded scanned original certificates.

13. MERIT LIST:

- 13.1 The merit position of the candidates applied shall be determined basing on AIAPGET-2024 Ranks and as per their eligibility
- 13.2 The University will release final merit position of the candidates eligible for exercising Web options, after completion of the verification of data and certificates uploaded by the candidates
- 13.3 Candidates who are included in the final merit list will only be eligible for exercising web options and the counseling for admissions will be held through online (web) mode only.

14. ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:

The procedure for Admissions/Selection/Seat Matrix is as per the Government Orders given below and subsequent amendments and any other orders that may be issued by the Govt. of A.P/Dr. NTR UHS from time to time for Non-service/In-service candidates wherever applicable:

As per G.O.Ms.No.603, HM &FW(R2) Dept. dt.23.12.2004 as amended in G.O.Ms.No.13,

HM&FW(F2) Dept., dt.05.02.2021.

- 14.1. The Vice-Chancellor shall constitute a Selection Committee.
- 14.2 Provisional Selection shall be made by the Selection Committee constituted by the University.
- 14.3 The Selection Committee shall provisionally select the candidates as per these regulations from among the candidates as per merit list from the candidates who exercised web options.
- 14.4 Candidates have to exercise the options in response to this University notification.
- 14.5 The Selection Committee shall have power to review the provisional selection in case of any errors, misrepresentation, fraud or glaring injustice. In all matters relating to selections and admissions, the decision of the selection committee shall be final and binding on the candidates and selections cannot be questioned after admissions are closed.
- 14.6 If a candidate after choosing the subject fails to pay fees or after paying the fees fails to submit the bond, his/her selection stands cancelled automatically.

• Further, the Orders, if any, as amended from time to time by the Government of Andhra Pradesh /National Commission for Ayurveda/Government of India are applicable.

15. ADMISSION RULES:

- **15.1** The last date for reporting by the selected candidates at the allotted college will be communicated in the allotment order.
- **15.2** Candidates joining courses shall execute a bond on non judicial stamp paper of value of Rs.100/- in the form specified in Annexure-I to complete the prescribed period of training or in default to pay Rs.59,000/-(Rupees Fifty Nine thousand only) Rs.50,000+Rs.9,000 including GST@18% to Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences and service candidates shall refund the stipend received up to that date to Government as notified by the University from time to time.

AS PER NCISM Regulations 2024

16. ATTENDANCE:

- **16.1** Candidates selected for the various courses shall be the whole-time students. Service candidates will have to apply for leave to prosecute their studies and are required to produce the leave sanction order not later than three months after reporting at the allotted college.
- **16.2** The candidate is required to put in a minimum of 80% attendance and total academic activities to become to become eligible for appearing in the University Examinations.
- **16.3** Acquiring requisite attendance shall be the responsibility of the Postgraduate students: Provided that, in case of deficiency of attendance, the duration of the course shall be extended proportionately.
- **16.4** There shall be no provision for vacation or preparatory holidays in Postgraduate Degree programme.
- **17. LEAVE:** The below provided Leave policy shall be applicable for Postgraduate scholars:
 - **17.1** Casual leaves up to 12 per academic year;
 - **17.2** Academic activites such as attending seminar, workshops, training programme, orientation programme, symposium including days of travelling shall be considered as 'on duty';
 - **17.3** Maternity, paternity and other leaves as per respective State Government or contract rules as applicable.
- **18. MATERNITY LEAVE:** Post Graduate students are eligible for maternity leave for the period as specified by the respective Councils/ Government of Andhra Pradesh from time to time. The study period will be extended to the extent of absence to the course.

18.1 SANCTION OF LEAVE OF ABSENCE BEYOND 3 MONTHS AND TERMINATION OF STUDENTSHIP:

- **19. BREAK OF STUDY AND RE-ADMISSION**: If a student is absent continuously for a period of 91 days or more and seeks permission to attend the course, his / her application in prescribed format vide Annexures II & III by paying requisite fee in favour of Registrar, Dr NTR University of Health Sciences payable at Vijayawada shall be forwarded to the Registrar, Dr.NTR University of Health Sciences with the recommendation of the Dean/Principal. The candidates are advised to refer the regulations before submitting the application and paying the fee. If they fulfill the conditions, they may submit applications through the Dean/Principal of the College by paying the fee. A maximum of two spells of break of study is allowed during the entire period of course.
 - **19.1. Maximum Duration to complete the Course:** The regulations on 1st October, 2024 shall apply to students admitted in Post-Graduate Degree Course-Doctor of Medicine in Ayurveda regulations 2024. As per NCISM/Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi regulations of 2024 under clause 20 (4) points as follows:
 - The maximum duration for completion of the course shall not exceed six years from the date of commencement of the academic course as per the academic calendar issued by the commission for that particular batch.

20. PRIVATE PRACTICE:

No Post Graduate is allowed to do any private practice or consultation and should not accept any part time employment in any State or Central or Quasi Government or Private organizations during the period of Post Graduation study. The Principal has to take appropriate action after giving opportunity for explanation, if any student violates this rule.

21. COLLEGE REGULATIONS:

Candidates are required to follow the rules and regulations of the college and should also abide by the regulations of the University. Under any circumstances candidates should not make any correspondence with the higher authorities of Government/Dr. NTR UHS directly without routing through proper channel.

22. STIPENDS:

- 22.1 Students who are regular in attendance and show good progress every month in their academic pursuits. The total period during which the stipends may be paid to the students shall not exceed thirty-six months for the course. No candidate will be eligible to draw the stipend for more than 36 months during the entire PG study period.
- 22.2 Service candidates shall not be paid stipend if they draw leave salary or salary.

23. COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:

The course shall normally commence as per the date mentioned in the provisional allotment order. The duration of the course shall be calculated from this date of commencement of the course and shall be uniform for all the candidates irrespective of their individual dates of admission.

24. CLOSURE OF ADMISSIONS:

- 24.1. Admissions shall be closed on the date as notified by the University as per NCISM/Ministry of Ayush New Delhi regulations.
- 24.2. Any vacancy as on the day of closure of admissions or that arises after closure of admissions shall not be filled up.

25. DURATION OF COURSE:

The period of training of Doctor of Medicine in Ayurveda shall be of 3 years duration in the department concerned.

26. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

English shall be the medium of instruction and examination.

27. POWERS OF THE PRINCIPAL:

Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations, the Principal, Govt. Ayurvedic Colleges having PG Courses, may at any time before completion of the PG course either on his own motion or on the application of any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks time from the date of the receipt of the show cause notice to submit written application and or on a personal hearing, order the cancellation of admission to the PG course if in his opinion such candidates had furnished false or incorrect information in the application form or in the documents attached, certificates enclosed thereto or in the statements made either before the authority in charge of admissions or the Principal or in any other fraudulent manner, obtained admission into such course. Against any such order of the principal an appeal shall lie to the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Andhra Pradesh. Vijayawada.

28. POWER OF DR.NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES:

- 28.1 The Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences shall have the power to add or to delete or amend or alter these regulations from time to time
- 28.2 The University may either suomoto or on an application made to them, call for and examine records relating to any selection or admission or cancellation thereof made by the authority in charge of selection or admission for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the legality or regularity of such selection or admission orders in relation thereto, as they deem fit including

cancellation of the selections already published or admissions already made provided that the University may before cancelling such selection or admission give an opportunity to the authority in charge of selection or admission and to the person effected to show cause against such cancellation.

29. FINALITY OF SELECTION:

All selections under these Regulations shall be subject to any general regulations or order that may be made by University from time to time.

30. ANTI RAGGING ACT:

Ragging is prohibited in the Educational Institutions in the state of AP vide Act.No.26 of 1997, dt.21-08-1997.The Anti Ragging Act is placed on the Website of the University for information.
