NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB OPTIONS FOR PHASE-II COUNSELING FOR ADMISSIONS INTO THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA SEATS OF POST-GRADUATE DENTAL DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES AVAILABLE IN THE GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE NON-MINORITY DENTAL COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO Dr. NTR UHS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-25.

In continuation to this Office Notification, dt.29-07-2024, Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada hereby notifies the schedule for exercising Web Options for Phase-II of counselling for admissions into Competent Authority Quota (CQ) PG Dental Degree/Diploma courses available in the Government and Private Non-Minority Dental Colleges under Dr. NTR UHS for the academic year 2024-25 for the seats available in the following colleges:

UNIVERSITY FEE: Selected Candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.23,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates already paid in Phase-I need not to pay again.

TUITION FEE: The following is the Tuition fee structure for the academic year 2024-25 to be payable for the Competent Authority Quota seats in Private Un-aided Dental Colleges as per G.O.Rt.No.504, HM & FW (C1) Department, dated 06-08-2024 of Government of Andhra Pradesh subject to the outcome of the W.P.Nos.32975, 33162 & 35090 of 2022.

Instructions to Candidates:

1	Seat Matrix is displayed in the University Website <u>https://drntr.uhsap.in</u> for information of the students. All the eligible candidates present in the Final Merit list displayed on 29-07-2024 are eligible to opt for Phase-II.	
2	Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus (placed in the University website on 20-07-2024) and the Government Orders on Rules of PG admissions available before exercising web options. Candidates are also advised to go through the details about "MRC" concept which is exemplified below: Example:	
	 a) In a particular college MDS (Conservative Dentistry) seat is under "Open Category" in the seat matrix and a SC candidate is allotted that Open Category MD (Conservative Dentistry) seat in Open Round Counselling of Phase-I as per his/her web options and NEET -MDS Rank merit order of the candidate. Now this candidate is shown as Meritorious Reserved Candidate (MRC). 	
	b) The same SC candidate has slided to MD (Prostho) SC category seat in the same college or another college during the Category Round of Phase-I Counselling conducted on the same day , then that MD(Conservative Dentistry) seat vacated by this MRC candidate shall be filled with the SC candidates only by merit amongst them.	
	c) This type of MRC concept is to be followed for all BC/SC/ST categories in order to maintain 50 : 50 ratio of Open : Category Reservation

3	As per G.O.Ms.No.86, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.20-07-2024, the Govt. of A.P. issued orders to	
	de-notify Government Dental College & Hospital, Vijayawada as a statewide Institution and reclassify it as a Non-Statewide Institution from the academic year 2024-25 and to fall under the jurisdiction of Andhra University (AU).	
4	As per the year 2023-24 Notifications for Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling, candidates who participated in Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling conducted for the year 2023-24 and allotted seats but not reported/joined are debarred for admissions into CQ/MQ counselling for the year 2024-25 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).	
5	As per G.O.Ms.No.67. dt.21-04-2017, the candidates who have discontinued the course from the academic year 2021-22 irrespective of their admission batch will be debarred for this academic year i.e., 2024-25(List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).	
6	a) Candidates opting for Dental Degree/Diploma courses are informed that there is no limit on the number of choices for web options. They can select any number of specialties and colleges available, provided they meet the eligibility criteria and are interested in joining.	
	b) The candidates are advised to exercise options for all the seats in all the colleges as per their priority incorporting of measures position of the seats (i.e., Phasel not allotted and	
	<u>their priority irrespective of vacancy position of the seats (i.e., Phase1 not allotted and not reported seats) shown in the seat matrix.</u>	
	c) Candidates while giving options should note that the seats vacated by the candidates	
	selected in Phase-I counselling and slid to other college/course during this Phase-II of counseling process (virtual vacancies) will be added & allotted simultaneously during this Phase of counselling itself.	
	d) <u>Candidates are encouraged to select courses they are genuinely interested in joining,</u> <u>allowing the next meritorious candidates a fair opportunity.</u>	
	 e) Candidates getting upgraded in Phase 2 Shall NOT have any claim on Phase 1 seat. f) If upgraded in Phase 2, the candidate must join Phase 2 seat by reporting at the allotted college. 	

7	Candidates are advised to exercise caution when selecting options online and to print out the
	saved options for their records. Candidates are encouraged to exercise options in Courses and colleges in which they are genuinely interested. If candidates are not interested in joining a particular specialty or college, they are advised not to select options for those.
8	The selected candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.23,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and report to the Principal of the Allotted College on or before the date specified in the allotment letter. University fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.
	Candidates who have already paid the University fee of $₹.23,600/-$ do not need to pay again for downloading the Allotment Order.
9	The selected candidates shall produce all the Original certificates, pay the Tuition fee, furnish necessary bonds etc., and complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfil the criteria as per regulations to complete the admission process in the specified dates of admission, their admission will be cancelled automatically.
10	The verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission in the respective College and in case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated. If the candidate slides to other college (i.e., affiliated colleges of Dr.NTR UHS) during subsequent Phases of counselling the tuition fee will be sent to the slid college by the college concerned where the amount is held.
11	Candidates who have reported the allotted seat of Phase-I and/or Phase-II can opt for free exit as per the schedule which will be notified.
12	Eligibility for Exercising web options in Phase-II Counselling:
	The following candidates are eligible: a) All the candidates who have been allotted and reported to the Phase-I seat.
	b) All the candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Phase-I counselling.
	c) All candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I but not reported/not joined at the
	allotted colleges. <mark>However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat</mark> of Phase-I then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to
	exercise web options in Phase-II counselling.
	d) The Joined candidates of Phase-I/Phase-II Counselling are eligible for upgradation up to Phase-III (Mop Up) round only.
13	Eligibility for Exercising web options in Phase-III (Mop Up) Counselling
	The following candidates are eligible: a) All the candidates who have been allotted and reported to the Phase-I/Phase-II seat.
	b) All the candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling.
	c) All candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I/Phase-II but not reported/not joined at the allotted colleges. However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I/Phase-II then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Phase-III/Mop Up counselling.
	d) The Joined candidates who are holding a seat in Phase-I or Phase-II or Phase-III(Mop Up) Counselling are not eligible for Stray or any further rounds.
	e) If any candidate does not join Phase-III seat cannot participate in further rounds of counselling conducted by State.
	f) MCC of DGHS will share the data of joined candidates in Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 counsellings with all the participating States. Similarly, the participating States will also share the data of joined candidates. Candidates who have joined up to Round 3 of MCC counselling and also the allotted candidates of Stray Vacancy round of MCC counselling will be filtered and weeded out before processing for Stray Vacancy round of counselling of AP State.
	e) As per MCC counselling Scheme 2024, the joined candidates up to Round 3 of MCC counselling cannot upgrade or resign after Round 3. If any candidate is allotted seat in Round 3 of AIQ/Deemed/Central Quota and also allotted a seat in Phase-III/ Mop Up counselling of the AP State, later found that the candidate has joined in Round 3 of AIQ/Deemed/Central Quota, in such cases the seat allotted in Phase-III/ Mop Up counselling of the AP State shall be automatically cancelled at any stage, without any prior notice. Vacancies arising due to such cancellation will be filled up in Stray Vacancy round. Hence, candidates are advised to exercise caution while taking a decision to join in either Round 3 of AIQ or Phase-III (Mop Up) of State Counseling.

14	If any candidate joins allotted seat of Phase-I of Competent Authority Quota (CQ) seat in A.P State		
	can slide to a seat allotted in Phase-II of Management Quota seat in AP State and in such case,		
	the tuition fee already paid for the CQ will be returned to the candidate by the concerned college		
	and vice versa.		
15	As per G.O.Ms.No.67, dt.21-04-2017 in the final phase of final counselling, A candidate who		
	exercised web options and joined in an allotted seat shall not be permitted to withdraw from the		
	seat. In case any candidate withdraws from the allotted seat, the candidate shall be debarred for		
	a period of three years for admission into Post Graduate Dental Degree/Diploma courses at the		
	colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh besides payment of Rs. 3,54,000/- (including 18% GST).		
16	The University fee and other fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.		
10	The Oniversity lee and other lee once paid shan not be refunded under any circumstances.
