**Admissions into All India Quota seats in Private Un-aided Non-Minority BHMS & BAMS Colleges Affiliated to Dr. NTR UHS., Vijayawada for the Academic year-2024-25 in the state of A.P.**

Online applications are invited from the candidates who fulfill the eligibility criteria for admission into Under Graduate Homoeopathy & Ayurveda Courses under AIQ (All India Quota) seats in Private Un-aided Non-Minority Ayurveda (BAMS) & Homoeopathy (BHMS) Colleges Affiliated to Dr. NTR UHS for the academic year 2024-25.

1. The candidates should secure the following cutoff scores in National Eligibility - cum - Entrance Test NEET UG -2024.

**2. Minimum Age: -**

- Candidates should have completed the age of 17 years as on the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024.**
- Candidates who do not complete 17 years as on 31.12.2024 are not eligible.**
- Age shall be calculated on the basis of date of birth as Indicated in the Board of Secondary School Certificate Examination (SSC) or Equivalent Examination.**
- No upper age limit.**

**3) EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:**

Passing marks for eligibility in admission to ASU&H-UG courses should be as per the ASU&H-UG regulations and should be followed strictly. The details of qualifications for different categories are as follows:

- For Ayurveda – BAMS:** - Candidate must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the 10+2 or equivalent examination in the case of General category and 40% Marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes.
- For Homeopathy – BHMS:** - Candidate must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology at the 10+2 or equivalent examination in the case of general category and 40% Marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes.
- In respect of persons with disability candidate specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination are as follows: a) In Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be 45% in the case of General Category. b) 40% in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes. (for PWD candidates only).

- d) \*Lower percentile of marks for SC / ST / BC / PwD is only for eligibility purpose and will not be applicable for reservation as there are no reservation quotas for these categories. Caste certificate issued by other state Governments will be considered for determining their eligibility for cut-off scores.
- 4) The other rules and regulations that are applicable for UG AYUSH course will be applicable to BHMS & BAMS courses. For further information, check the University website for prospectus of UG AYUSH course notified on **10.10.2024**.
- 5) In respect of persons with disability candidate specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination are as follows: a) In Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be 45% in the case of General Category. b) 40% in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes. (for PWD candidates only).

- 7) **SELECTION PROCEDURE:** All seats are in open in nature and there is no requirement for any domicile certificate as per the directions issued by the Ministry of AYUSH, vide Lr. No. NCISM/COE/NEET-UG/2024, dt.22-08-2024.
- 8) **As per the Notice, dated 17.10.2024 notified by the AACCC, Ministry of AYUSH, the candidates admitted under Round (1) & (2) and allotted under Round (3) of All India Quota seats are not allowed to participate in State counselling for admission to UG courses for the academic year 2024-25. Therefore, any such candidates found in the "List of In-eligible candidates for All AYUSH counselling (Central/State/UT/Central Pool Quota) shall not apply under Dr. NTR UHS., Vijayawada for the academic year 2024-25.**

#### 9) Instructions to the candidates: -

- a) The candidates are advised to download and read the Prospectus of the course and instructions for filling Online Application available in the University Website: <https://apuhs-ugadmissions.aptonline.in/UGAYUSHAIQ/Home/StudentLogin> before filling the online Application.
- b) Scrutiny of uploaded data shall be done by the University and concerned Departmental Officials. After scrutiny of certificates, provisional merit list will be released and final merit list will be released later, after obtaining grievances from the candidates if any.

**Note:** The process of admissions into BHMS, BAMS Courses will be in accordance with the Orders issued from time to time by NCISM/NCH/Government of India and Ministry of Ayush, New Delhi.

- c) The On-line application form with the following lacunae will be rejected automatically. No communication will be sent in this regard.
  - a. Applications with incomplete details/photo and signature.
  - b. If any of the uploaded certificates are invisible/not properly uploaded.
  - c. If the certificates are not properly scanned due to which the eligibility criteria cannot be determined.

The certificates verification will be done basing on the uploaded scanned certificates. No separate notification will be given for verification of Original Certificates. Verification of Original Certificates will be done by the colleges where seat is allotted.

**Hence, the candidates should register and upload all the certificates without fail and verify once again before submission of online application.**

- d) The candidate should submit the Printout of the filled in Online application form, all Original Certificates along with One set of self- attested Copies to the Principal of allotted college at the time of joining for final verification. In case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment order will be cancelled without any notice. **The candidates are informed not to send the print out of application form to the University.**

- 10) Candidates admission is strictly provisional. The mere fact that the Merit position issued to him/her does not imply that his/her candidature is accepted by the University and it does not mean that the entries made by him/her in the online application are accepted as true and correct. The candidate eligibility for admission into **BHMS & BAMS Courses** for the academic year 2024-25 will be examined by the University officials and officials of the concerned department only basing on the uploaded scanned original certificates.

**An in-eligible candidate obtaining Merit position does not make him/her eligible for admission.**

- 11) If the information furnished by candidate in the application is incorrect, his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled and further action that deems fit will be taken. If the certificates produced by any candidate are found to be fake/false/forged at any stage of verification or admission, the University has every right to cancel the seat/admission of such candidate without any notice.
- 12) In case of discrepancy in the downloaded provisional verification form, the same shall be brought to the notice of the University immediately.
- 13) **Subsequent notifications with regard to web counseling will be notified on the University website only. Please visit the university website: <https://apuhs-ugadmissions.aptonline.in/UGAYUSHAIQ/Home/StudentLogin> regularly for subsequent notifications/ instructions till the completion of admission process.**
- 14) **The counseling for admission into above courses will be made to the colleges affiliated for the year 2024-25 and fee fixed by Govt. of AP and Ministry of Ayush, New Delhi.**
