Notification for exercising web options for 1st Phase of web-based counseling for admission into **BHMS, BAMS & BUMS Courses** under Competent Authority Quota Seats in Government, Private Un-aided Non-Minority, Aided **BHMS, BAMS & BUMS** colleges under Dr. NTR UHS for the academic year 2024-25.

In continuation of earlier notification dated 09.10.2024, the University hereby notifies the **1st Phase** of web-based counselling for **BHMS, BAMS & BUMS Courses** available under Competent Authority Quota seats including Special Categories if applicable in Government, Private Un-aided Non-Minority, Aided BHMS/BAMS/ BUMS colleges (under Dr. NTR UHS) for the academic year 2024-25 in the state of Andhra Pradesh.

All the eligible candidates who are present in the Merit list notified in the website on **30.10.2024** only eligible to exercise their options as per the seat matrix displayed on the website <https://drntr.uhsap.in>

The seat allocation will be as per the Procedure given in G.O.P.No.646, Education (w) dept. Dt.10-07-1979 as amended in G.O.Ms.No.42, Higher Education dept., Dt.18-05-2009 G.O.M.S.No.111, DATED: 13.08.2019 and as per the G.O. Ms No.131 HM&FW (R2) Dept., dt:25.04.2008 as amended in G.O.Ms.No.8, HM & FW (F2) Dept., dt.29.01.2021.

UNIVERSITY FEE: Candidates who are allotted a seat, have to pay **Rs. 8,600/-** obtaining allotment letter through payment Gateway by using Online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking).

TUITION FEE: The selected candidates have to pay tuition fee of **Rs.24,500/-** per year for admission into **BHMS, BAMS & BUMS Courses** as per orders of Government of Andhra Pradesh G.O.Ms.No.141 HM & FW(C2) Dept., dt.31.08.2023 & G.O.Ms.No.193 HM & FW(F2) Dept., dt.31.10.2023.

Instructions to the Candidates:

1. Candidates whose names are found in the Final list of In-eligible candidates for AACCC/State/UT AYUSH UG counselling 2024-25 notified by AACCC, New Delhi, Vide Ref. No. AA-11013/1/2024-EP-I, dt.17.10.2024 are not eligible to participate under this notification.
2. Names of the candidates shared by AACCC, New Delhi are also not eligible to participate under this notification.
3. If it is found that an ineligible candidate has opted, candidate of such candidates will not be considered for allotments.
4. Area wise Seat Matrix is displayed on University Website for the information of the students to exercise their options.
5. **Allotments under Special categories:**
 - a) The seats reserved under special category i.e. CAP will also be filled in this phase.
 - b) The seats reserved under special category i.e. NCC will be filled as and when the prioritized merit list is received from the authorities concerned.
 - c) The unallotted seats under special categories will be added to respective categories, since the seats under special categories are Horizontal Reservations.

6. Candidate can give options on the web either from home or any other place having internet facility.
 - a. One Time Password will be sent to the registered mobile at the time of registration and also at the time of saving Web options.
 - b. The password consists of **SIX** letters code with English capitals A to Z.
7. A candidate can exercise any number of options. The students have to opt clearly for the course in which they are desirous to join.
8. Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the Web and take the print out of the saved options.
9. **Reporting at the allotted College:**
 - a) Candidates will receive the message to their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if seat is allotted. The candidates are instructed to visit the website: <https://apuhs-ugadmissions.aptonline.in/UGAYUSH/Home/Home> for status of allotment after closure of web options.
 - b) Candidates who have been allotted a seat shall report at the allotted college within the reporting schedule by downloading the allotment order on payment of University fee of **Rs. 8,600/-**.
 - c) Candidates shall check their final allotment, take print out of allotment letter from the web and report to the respective colleges on or before the date specified on the allotment letter with all original certificates and pay the tuition fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will forfeit the admission.
 - d) Verification of original certificates will be conducted at the college of admission and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated as per University regulations.
 - e) If not allotted any seat in Phase-I: Candidates who have not been allotted any seat in the Phase-I of counselling will be considered for available vacancies in Phase-II of counselling with fresh Options.
 - f) If not reported at the allotted college: The candidates who do not report at the allotted college in the Phase-I counselling, will be allowed to participate in the Phase-II counselling with fresh options, provided that the candidates have no right to claim earlier Phase-I allotted seat again under Phase-II counselling.
 - g) If the joined candidates of Phase-I slides to other college during Phase-II of counselling, the Original Certificates of such candidates will be sent to the newly allotted college by the previous college after closure of admissions. The candidate has to report at the re-allotted college with downloaded allotment order along with Custodian Certificate issued by the previous college under Dr. NTR UHS and to pay the Tuition Fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will forfeit the admission.
 - h) Candidates getting upgraded in Phase-II of Counselling will not have any claim on previous allotments, i.e., Phase-I seat as the vacancies resulting from upgradation are filled within this phase by the next candidate in the merit list with rules of reservation as applicable.
10. **FOR BUMS:** As per F.No.11-76/2021-BUMS (Unani-UG Regl.) dated.28-02-2022 the following is the regulation on Eligibility for admission into BUMS course which is applicable from the academic year 2021-22:
 - a. The candidate shall have passed 10+2 or its equivalent examination from any recognised Board with physics, Chemistry and Biology and shall have obtained a minimum of 50%. Marks taken together in Physics, chemistry and Biology in the case of General Category and 40% marks in the case of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward classes: -

Provided that in respect of persons with disability candidate specified under the rights of persons with disabilities act, 2016 (49 of 2016) the minimum qualifying marks in the said examinations shall be 45% in the case general category and 40% in the case of Scheduled Casts, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes.

- b. Candidate shall have passed Urdu or Arabic or Persian language as on the subject in the 10th standard or in 12th standard.
- c. Candidate who is not covered under clause(b) shall have to study Urdu language along with Arabic and Mantiq Wa Falsafa (Logic and Philosophy) as a subject during the First professional B.U.M.S. session.
- d. The syllabus is applicable to the students admitted in the academic year session 2021-22 on wards 5 years or until further notification by NCISM, whichever is earlier (Ref.11-76/2020-Unani (U.G Syllabus) dt.29-03-2021).
- 11.** Next Phase of counselling will be conducted with fresh options for the following seats after completion of counselling for AIQ Private Un-aided non-minority seats.
- a. Unfilled seats in Phase-I
- b. Not reported seats in Phase-I

12. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

3. Allotments under Special categories:

- b) The seats reserved under special category i.e., NCC will be filled as and when the prioritized merit list is received from the authorities concerned. Therefore, the candidates claiming reservations under special category reservation is informed to exercise their options for all colleges as per their order of college priorities NOW only.
- c) The unallotted seats under special categories will be added to respective categories, since the seats under special categories are Horizontal Reservations.

6. Reporting at the allotted College:

- a) Candidates will receive the message to their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if seat is allotted. The candidates are instructed to visit the website: <https://ugcq.ylsruhs.com> for status of allotment after closure of web options.
- b) Candidates who have been allotted a seat shall report at the allotted college within the reporting schedule by downloading the allotment order on payment of University fee of Rs.10,600/-.
- c) Candidates shall check their final allotment, take print out of allotment letter from the web and report to the respective colleges on or before the date specified on the allotment letter with all original certificates and pay the tuition fee to complete the admission process, failing which the candidate will forfeit the admission.
- d) Verification of original certificates will be conducted at the college of admission and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated as per University regulations.

13. Discontinuation from the Course:

A) Reported Candidates who have not utilised the free exit facility as per the schedule (to be notified) cannot resign the seat during the course of admissions i.e from Phase-II counselling to till closure of admissions.

B) As per G.O.Ms.No.72, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.15-07-2019 if any candidate wants to withdraw from the course after the closure of admissions in the middle of the course such candidate has to submit his/her request through the Principal of the college concerned along with course discontinuation fee of Rs.3,00,000/- for MBBS plus GST as applicable to the University by way of demand draft.

14. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

15. Separate instructions will be notified regarding the procedure to be followed in order to retain in the reported seat or to exit from the reported seat of Phase-I counselling. Hence, candidates should stay in touch with the website for latest updates.
