In continuation to this Office Notifications, dt.27-09-2024, 05-11-2024, & 06-01-2025 Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada hereby notifies the schedule for exercising Web Options for Phase-III/MoP UP counselling for admissions into Management Quota seats of PG Medical Degree/Diploma courses in Private Un-aided Non-minority and Minority Colleges for the academic year 2024-25:

## SCHEDULE

#### (Candidates have to login to exercise web options )

All the eligible candidates whose names are in the Consolidated final Merit Position notified in the University Website on 03-02-2025 are only eligible to exercise web options as per the above dates and according to the Seat Matrix displayed on 23-11-2024 in the website <u>http://drntr.uhsap.in</u>

#### UNIVERSITY FEE: Selected Candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.49,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates already paid in Phase-I/Phase-II need not pay again.

TUITION FEE: The following is the Tuition fee structure for the academic year 2024-25 to be payable for the Competent Authority Quota seats in Private Un-aided Medical Colleges as per G.O.Rt.No.504, HM & FW (C1) Department, dated 06-08-2024 of Government of Andhra Pradesh subject to the outcome of the W.P.Nos.32975, 33162 & 35090 of 2022.

#### Distribution of seats is as detailed below:

- 1) As per G.O.Ms.No.57, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated 28-04-2023 (Non-Minority Colleges):
- a) Management Quota-Subcategory- 1(S1): 25% of the sanctioned intake of seats, course wise, in each institution shall be filled by the candidates in General Merit based on the NEET PG-2024 ranking.
- b) Management Quota-Subcategory-2(S2): 15% seats out of total intake capacity, course wise, in each institution shall be filled by foreign students/ NRI/NRI sponsored candidates on the basis of inter-se-merit among the applicants qualified in NEET PG-2024.
- c) Management Quota-Subcategory-3(S3): 10% seats out of total intake capacity, course wise, in each Institution shall be Institutional preference/In- service management quota seats filled on the basis of inter-se-merit among the applicants qualified in NEET PG-2024.
- 2) As per G.O.Ms.No.102, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated 15-07-2023:
  - a) 15% of Subcategory-1 seats only are open to the candidates from all over the Country S1A
  - b) For the Remaining 85% of Subcategory-1 seats only Local Candidates of Andhra Pradesh i.e., AU/SVU are only eligible S1B

## **Instructions to Candidates:**

1	Seat Matrix is displayed in the University Website <u>https://drntr.uhsap.in</u> for information of the students. All the eligible candidates present in the Consolidated Final Merit list displayed on 03-02-2025 are eligible to opt for Phase-III/MoP UP.
2	As per the year 2023-24 Notifications for Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling, candidates who participated in Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling conducted for the year 2023-24 and allotted seats but not reported/joined are debarred for admissions into CQ/MQ counselling for the year 2024-25 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
3	As per G.O.Ms.No.67. dt.21-04-2017, the candidates who have discontinued the course from the academic year 2021-22 irrespective of their admission batch will be debarred for this academic year i.e., 2024-25(List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
4	Candidates opting for Medical Degree/Diploma courses are informed that, there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web options. Candidates can exercise any number of options for any number of specialities and colleges available.
5	In respect of S1B seats, preference will be given to local candidates of Andhra Pradesh and if eligible candidates from Andhra Pradesh are not available, the same will be allotted to S1A candidates based on Merit list, options and subject to availability of seats.
5	Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the Web and take the print out of the saved options. Candidates are advised to exercise options in Courses and colleges in which they are genuinely interested. If they are not interested to join any speciality or college then they are advised not exercise options for the same.
6	a) The candidate can login at any point of time after submission of web options for rearranging the priority list before the cutoff date.
	b) Options which are not saved will be saved automatically and will be considered for allotments.
7	The selected candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.49,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and report to the Principal of the Allotted College on or before the date specified in the allotment letter. University fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.

	The selected candidates shall produce all the Original certificates, pay the Tuition fee, furnish necessary bonds etc., and complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfil the criteria as per regulations to complete the admission process in the specified dates of admission, their admission will be cancelled automatically.		
9	The verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission in the respective College and in case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated. If the candidate slides to other college (i.e., affiliated colleges of Dr.NTR UHS) during subsequent Phases of counselling the tuition fee will be sent to the slided college by the concerned college where the amount is held.		
10	Eligibility for Exercising web options in Phase-III (MoP Up) Counselling

	b) All the candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling.		
	c) All candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I/Phase-II		
	but not reported/not joined at the allotted colleges.		
	> Joined but resigned from the allotted seat as per University Notifications for free exit.		
	However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I/ Phase-II or resigned from the joined seat of Phase-I/Phase-II, then that particular seat		
	shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Phase-III/Mop Up counselling.		
	d) Phase-I/II joined/reported seat shall be the default last option.		
	e) The Joined candidates who are holding a seat in Phase-I or Phase-II or Phase-III (Mop Up) Counselling are <b>not eligible</b> for Stray or any further rounds.

12	Eligibility for Exercising web options for Stray Counselling:				
	<ul> <li>a) The candidates who have not been allotted in Phase 1, Phase 2, Phase 3 of counselling.</li> <li>b) The candidates who have been allotted, but not joined in Phase 1, Phase 2 of State Quota and All India Quota are eligible to participate in this counselling. However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I/Phase-II then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Stray Vacancy counselling.</li> </ul>				
	c) Candidates not allotted or not holding any seat in Phase-I, Phase-II, and candidates not allotted any seat in Phase-III of (AIQ/State/Deemed) are only eligible for State Stray vacancy round counselling.

	<ul> <li>a) The candidates who are holding PG Medical seat in Phase 1, Phase 2 and Phase 3 (Mop Up) of State Counselling are not eligible to participate in Stray round of counselling.</li> <li>b) The candidate who is holding a seat allotted in Round 1 &amp; Round 2 and Round 3 in All India Quota/Deemed universities(conducted by MCC/DGHS).</li> </ul>

13	As per G.O.Ms.No.67, dt.21-04-2017 in the final phase of final counselling, A candidate who exercised web options and joined in an allotted seat shall not be permitted to withdraw from the seat. In case any candidate withdraws from the allotted seat, the candidate shall be debarred for a period of three years for admission into Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma courses at the colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh besides payment of Rs. 3,54,000/- (including 18% GST).				
14	The University fee and other fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
