College has to fix an earlier date for collection of exam fee and complete the payment of fee on the Medhas Portal before the above last date.

# Note (Mode of Payment):

- 1. The Examination Fee shall pay online mode only by clicking the below link <a href="https://drysr.uhsap.in/epay">https://drysr.uhsap.in/epay</a> by entering the amount to be paid. No DD's will be accepted.
- 2. While doing the payment the respective one should fill all columns and brief about the payment in the remarks column.
- 3. The transaction receipt obtained after completion of the online payment should submit to the University along with the material without fail.
- 4. The payments paid after the due date shall not be accepted under any circumstances.



#### **INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS**

- 1. Final Year students have to pay Provisional Pass Certificate fee along with the Examination fee.
- 2. All the students have to pay Marks memo fee along with the Examination Fee.
- 3. If any candidate, though eligible under normal circumstances, but fails to register for any reason or is detained, it will be counted as an Attempt.
- 4. For the students admitted from the academic year 2016-17, as per Amended Regulations, dt.07.11.2016 :-
  Definition of a CHANCE: Appearance for University examination shall be treated as a CHANCE, however, the student shall complete I or II or IV BAMS course with maximum four chances within a period of maximum 3 years for each professional year of study.
- 5. Undergraduate curriculum to be implemented from October, 2023 i.e., in BAMS course, who admitted in the first year i.e., 2021-2022 batch and studying currently BAMS shall continue with the existing system.



#### **GUIDELINES TO THE PRINCIPALS**

- 1. In view of introduction of Digital Valuation, a single booklet with 52 pages OMR answer book with 48 writable pages will be issued to the candidates appearing for BAMS examinations and No additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all questions in the single answer book of 48 writable pages only.
- University has introduced E-Hall Tickets from <u>OCTOBER</u>, <u>2019</u> Examinations. This is only for the students admitted under NR Regulations (2016) in the affiliated colleges of Dr. YSRUHS. All exam going students particulars duly signed by Head of the Department and countersigned by the Principal and upload MEDHAS Portal on or before the last date.
- 3. Attendance particulars of all exam going students duly signed by Head of the Department and countersigned by the Principal alongwith scanned CD should be sent, so as to reach the University Office on or before the last date. (First to Final BAMS Course go through point 2 above).
- 4. If any candidate is not willing to appear for the Examinations or if any candidate is not eligible to appear for the examinations and whose name has appeared in the galley of BAMS Examinations on Medhas portal such candidates names shall be rounded with RED INK by drawing the round circle against the name. The information of list of deleted candidates should be furnished with final list of candidates eligible to appear for the examinations to the University before due date prescribed in the Notification.
- 5. If any candidate is eligible to appear for the examinations and whose name has not appeared in the galley of BAMS Examinations on Medhas portal the Principals are requested to furnish the list of such candidates with justification for adding for each year separately and mail to the University with certification before due date prescribed in the Notification.
- 6. The Attendance once sent to the University shall be final and no changes will be entertained later.
- 7. The student is not eligible to appear for the University exam if details of attendance are not received by this Office. In such case, the candidate will be detained and no changes will be entertained later on.
- 8. All the Candidates should attend 75% of total hours in Theory and 75% of total hours in Practical as prescribed by Dr. YSR UHS / CCIM.
- 9. The Principal should verify the eligibility of students and submit to the University on or before the last date. The Principal will be held solely responsible if any ineligible candidate's data submitted to the University or permitted to write examination.
- 10. The Principals of concerned colleges are requested to furnish the detailed information and remarks in respect of the candidates who filed writ Petition in the Court regarding their admissions, etc, if any. (THE CANDIDATES WHOSE ADMISSIONS ARE NOT APPROVED SHALL NOT BE ISSUED HALL TICKETS AND WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO APPEAR FOR THE EXAMS).
- 11. The Principals are advised to form a Committee with concerned Head of Departments under Chairmanship of Principal / Vice-Principal who shall be held responsible for forwarding examination applications and releasing hall tickets as per eligibility.
- 12. The Principals have to download the E-Hall Tickets from the Medhas Portal.



# In respect of students joined in AYUSH Courses in Telangana State before AP state bifurcation:

- **12.** The Colleges should not collect Examination Fee from the ineligible candidate such as who have shortage of attendance as per the Dr. YSRUHS /CCIM Rules.
- 13. Nominal Rolls Demand Forms (NRDF) (OU Area) in original provided by the University with provisional list of candidates eligible to appear at the examinations and other material with due certification by the Principals of respective colleges are to be submitted before the due date specified in the notification.
- 14. **The Principals of** OU Area should arrange to collect the **HALL TICKETS**, **etc.** from the University Office.

**15.** All the Applications for re-totalling of Answer Scripts will be accepted through online only on the Medhas portal. No offiline applications will be accepted.
