INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS

1. All the students of FIRST PROFESSIONAL MBBS shall abide by the Regulations of Competency Based Curriculum of the Medical Graduate Programme as prescribed by National Medical Commission, New Delhi. Vide its Gazette Notification dt.04-11-2019.
2. **Passing in FIRST PROFESSIONAL is compulsory before proceeding to PHASE- II training. As prescribed in the Medical Council of India Regulations on Graduate Medical education, 1997, clause 8 passing in First Professional is compulsory before proceeding to Second MBBS training. It is to inform all the students that unless the students pass successfully in the First MBBS examination they will not be promoted to Second MBBS.**

Moreover, if a candidate has failed to pass in the supplementary examination he/she will have to repeat the 1st MBBS course curriculum and appear for the University examination of 1st MBBS with the new batch.

3. **As per the NMC, New Delhi, Regulations under Rule No.11.2.7 For 2019 & 2020 Admitted Batch onwards, no more than four attempts shall be allowed for the candidate to pass FIRST PROFESSIONAL examinations. The total period for successful completion of First Professional course shall not exceed four (4) years. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt. A learner shall not be entitled to Graduate later than ten (10) years of her/his joining the first MBBS course.**

THEREFORE, STUDENTS ADMITTED DURING 2022-23 AND APPEARING FOR THE FOURTH TIME (FOUR PERMISSIBLE ATTEMPT), ARE HEREBY INFORMED THAT THIS WILL BE THEIR LAST CHANCE FOR COMPLETION/PASSING FIRST MBBS PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATIONS

4. All the students have to pay Marks memo fee along with the Examination Fee.
5. Candidates who pass this examination will be continued with the main batch. Failed candidates have to appear for examination with next regular batch (2024-25)



INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PRINCIPALS

1. **Digital Valuation of MBBS Theory Answer Scripts is being implemented from July/August, 2017 Examination onwards.** For further details College Principals, faculty and students concerned are requested to refer University Circular dated 27/07/2019 which is also available on the University website
http://ntruhs.ap.nic.in/notification/Exam_Notification/digital_evaluation.pdf
2. Internal Assessment marks and Attendance particulars uploaded for AUGUST, 2024 examinations will be considered in respect of failed candidates and absentees only.
3. **The Internal Assessment Marks and Attendance once uploaded/submitted and freezed shall be final and no changes will be entertained later.**
4. The student is not eligible to appear for the University exam if he/she does not appear for Internal assessment exams or if the Internal assessment exam marks & attendance percentage are not uploaded/submitted on or before **01-10-2024**. In such case the candidate will be detained and no changes will be entertained later on.
5. All the candidates appearing for First Professional MBBS (NS) shall have attendance at least 75% of the total No. of classes in theory and 80% in Practical/Clinical, jointly become eligible to appear for the exam in that subject/subjects as prescribed by NMC/Dr.NTR UHS
6. **The INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS uploaded/submitted after the last date will not be considered for declaration of result for which the Principal is solely held responsible.**
7. The Principal should verify all the filled data submitted/uploaded into the **MEdHAS PORTAL** for eligibility of students and submit to the Controller of Examinations on or before the specified dates. The Principal will be held solely responsible, if any ineligible candidates are permitted to write examination.
8. The Principals of concerned colleges are requested to furnish the detailed information and remarks in respect of the candidates who filed writ Petition in the Court regarding their admissions etc, if any. **(The candidates whose admissions are not approved shall not be issued Hall Tickets and will not be permitted to appear for the exams).**
9. **The Principals are advised to form a Committee with concerned Head of Departments under Chairmanship of Principal/Vice-Principal who shall be responsible for forwarding examination applications and releasing Hall Tickets as per eligibility.**
10. Instructions/directions as issued previously by the University and Team MEdHAS for uploading of Internal Assessment, Attendance, Practical & Orals are to be adhered to scrupulously.
11. **While uploading the candidates details the Principal has to take care to see that the scanning of the Photo & Signature of the candidate is done in the given space visibly. The Signature of the student should be visible and legible. The signature should be done with black ink pen in the given space and size of the box only, so as to avoid the delay or last minute issue of Hall Tickets.**

18. ***It is to notify that as per the Judgement dated 04-11-2022 in Civil Appeal No.8037/2022 with Civil Appeal No.8038/2022 of Hon'ble Supreme court of India, there is no provision for revaluation of answer scripts as the procedure adopted by the University in Digital evaluation of answer scripts is upheld by the Apex Court.***
