

NOTICE

(To applicants for appointment to the post of Office Subordinate)

1. The applicants from the provisional merit list of Office Subordinates have been called for physical verification and verification of original certificates.
2. There have been complaints from Chairman, Dalith JAC, that many of the applicants have submitted fake 7th class certificates.
3. Some of the applicants have contended that some have passed 7th class before 2007 during which common Board examination was conducted and they have secured less marks and some have passed after 2007 where the schools have conducted examinations and more marks have been awarded to such candidates.
4. Taking into consideration all the above factors, the PROVISIONAL MERIT LIST DISPLAYED EARLIER IS KEPT IN ABEYANCE.
5. Dr. YSR University of Health Sciences has therefore, decided to conduct a competitive test (Computer Based Recruitment Test) for recruitment to the backlog (SC) posts of Office Subordinates (02 General & 01 Woman) notified vide this office notification No. 604/MII/2021, Dt. 28.08.2023.
6. THE TEST WILL BE CONDUCTED TENTATIVELY IN THE MONTH OF APRIL, 2024. The exact date of examination and other details pertaining to hall tickets etc., will be notified shortly.
7. The test will be conducted for 80 marks and the syllabus for the CBT will be that of 7th class standard which will consist of the following:

General Knowledge (40 Questions) : 40 M

(Specific emphasis on Andhra Pradesh)

- Indian Art, Culture, Dance & Music
- Indian History & Indian national movement
- Indian Geography
- Indian Polity
- Awards & Personalities
- Sports
- Current affairs – India & Andhra Pradesh

English Language (10 questions) : 10 M

- One word substitution
- Synonyms and Antonyms
- Spelling error
- Idioms and Phrases

Mental ability (30 questions) : 30 M

8. METHOD OF recruitment:

- a. The computer based examination will be of the standard, which will be consistent with the educational qualification prescribed for the post. The question paper of the computer based examination shall be objective type with multiple choice for 80 marks.
- b. The computer based examination will be conducted for 80 questions (40 questions — General Knowledge, 10 questions — General English and 30 questions- Mental Ability). Each question will carry one (01) mark. The duration of the examination will be 90 minutes. No negative marks.
- c. For the computer based examination in respect of General Knowledge and Mental Ability subjects, the question paper will be in English and Telugu languages. In case of ambiguity, the English version shall be treated as final.
- d. No person shall be eligible for appointment to the service by Direct Recruitment unless he/she satisfies the following conditions viz,
 - i. That he/she is of sound health, active habits and free from any bodily defects or infirmities rendering him/her unfit for the service.
 - ii. That his/her character and antecedents are such as to qualify him/her for such service; and
 - iii. He/she is a citizen of Andhra Pradesh.

9. Merit List

1. Merit list will be based on the marks obtained by the candidates in the computer based examination.
2. Where two or more candidates get equal number of marks in the Examination, the elder in age will be considered for provisional selection, in case of a tie in age also, the candidate with highest marks in the prescribed educational qualification would be considered.

10. Eligibility to appear at the Computer Based Recruitment Test (CBT):

1. The applicant (who have already applied) must have completed 18 years of age and must not have completed 47 years of age as on 01.07.2023 (as per G.O.Ms.No. 101, General Administration (Services-A) Department, Dt. 30.09.2022 and Rule No. 12 of A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules.
2. Must have passed 7th class examination or its equivalent examination.
3. Must belong to the Scheduled Caste Community.
4. Must possess live employment registration as on the date of notification i.e. 28.08.2023.

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NOTE:

- Candidates who have applied in response to this office notification dated 28.08.2023 and those who meet the above eligibility criteria can appear at the examination to be conducted by the University.
- No fresh application needs to be submitted.
- No fresh fee to be paid.
